ONE TRUE GIFT

Last week, we finished our reflections in Mark's gospel and concluded the first part of ENGAGE. ENGAGE will continue in the new year when we will begin looking at 1 Peter together, a letter all about how we ENGAGE with the world around us.

We also thought last week about how we might make the most of Christmas, to see the good news of Jesus proclaimed amongst those we know and love.

If you created some plans as a Small Group, do continue to talk together about them and how you are going to put them into action. Christmas is a wonderful opportunity to invite people into our homes, to share our lives and the message of Christmas. Do also continue to pray about those you hope to bring to some of our Christmas events.

This week is the first of two extra sessions that some Small Groups might like to use this Advent. Each 'Christmas Extra' picks up themes from Philippians Chapter 2 as we use the 'One True Gift' resource.

This first session follows the introductory video from last Sunday and helps us think about what might make us joyful this Christmas. Why not pray together now before you dive into Philippians.

COMPLETE

Introductory Question: Christmas is said to be a time of 'comfort and joy'. What different things can bring us joy at Christmas?

Now read Philippians 2:1-11

BEING LIKE MINDED Question: In verses 2-5 Paul challenges and encourages the church in Philippi to think about their life together. List out the different commands and encouragements.

Question: Now think about our church. In what ways do we display this life in our church/small groups? Spend some time thinking about some specific examples.

Question: Now think about our church some more. In what ways might we be able to display this life more and more in our church/small groups? Can you think of specific examples of how we could grow like this?

As you have reflected on our church, I imagine you have thought of lots of things that are encouraging and praiseworthy about our life together. There are many ways in which we have the 'mindset of Christ Jesus' (v.5). I imagine you have also thought of a number of ways we could do better or grow, these verses are also very challenging. Helpfully, our passage doesn't just give us a list of things we need to do better. It also gives us the motivation to live them out. Let's turn to look at those motivations now...

REASONS FOR Joy Question: In verse 5 we are told to have the mindset of Jesus. How is Jesus' mindset described in verses 6-11? How does that encourage us as we seek to live like him?

Question: In verses 1-2 we are given even more encouragements to live this way. List each one of them out. Now reflect on each in turn. How might each one encourage us as we seek to have the mindset of Jesus?

Question: We started by thinking about things that bring us joy at Christmas. In verse 2 Paul says the thing that completes his joy is when the church has the mindset of Jesus. How might we know more of this joy in our lives this Christmas?

DRAWING TOGETHER It is time to bring our thoughts together. Given all we have seen, maybe finally think of one thing to praise God for (in the life of our church or the character of Jesus) and one thing to pray for as we seek to have the mindset of Jesus together.

Share you thoughts and now turn to pray for each other.
