SUNDAY SERVICE REFLECTION

Talk about your favorite moment from this week's worship service. What scripture passage, worship song, or sermon quote did you relate to the most? Why?

SCRIPTURE READING

Pray and ask God to illuminate his Word. Then, read the below scripture passage(s) out loud.

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? Romans 8:31-32 NIV

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Choose one of the questions below to answer in relation to the above scripture passage(s).

- What did you notice about this passage(s)?
- What did this passage(s) teach you?
- How are you challenged to live differently?
- How can you apply this passage(s) to your day-to-day life?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Think back to a time that you felt very confident and a time that you felt insecure. What was the difference between those two experiences?
- What would you trust God with if you knew beyond a shadow of a doubt he'd come through?

• Confidence, if placed in our circumstances, is shaky. But when our confidence is in God, we can stand firm no matter what happens. How can you start to put your confidence in God?

TALK IT OVER WITH KIDS

- Talk about a time in your life when you did something that was out of your comfort zone, but you ended up being confident and secure anyways. Why were you so confident?
- The Bible tells us we can have confidence because God is with us. Why should God being with us make us feel so confident?
- Pray and thank God for always being with us, no matter the circumstances in our life!
