## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- What are a few things in life that you have avoided doing because you know someone else will do it for you?
- We tend to have the same mindset when it comes to sacrificing and prioritizing for important things in life: "Someone else will do it." But what if they don't? What's one thing you'd do differently if you knew no one else was coming?
- Take a moment to ask God to give you the courage to act as if no one else was coming.

## **TALK IT OVER WITH KIDS**
