SUNDAY SERVICE REFLECTION

Talk about your favorite moment from this week’s worship service. What scripture passage, worship song, or sermon quote did you relate to the most? Why?

SCRIPTURE READING

Pray and ask God to illuminate his Word. Then, read the below passage(s) of scripture out loud.

And now, compelled by the Spirit, I am going to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there. I only know that in every city the Holy Spirit warns me that prison and hardships are facing me. However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God’s grace. Acts 20:22-24 NIV

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Choose one of the questions below to answer in relation to the above scripture passage(s).

- What did you notice about this passage(s)?
- What did this passage(s) teach you?
- How are you challenged to live differently?
- How can you apply this passage(s) to your day-to-day life?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What are a few things in life that you have avoided doing because you know someone else will do it for you?
- We tend to have the same mindset when it comes to sacrificing and prioritizing for important things in life: “Someone else will do it.” But what if they don’t? What’s one thing you’d do differently if you knew no one else was coming?
- Take a moment to ask God to give you the courage to act as if no one else was coming.

TALK IT OVER WITH KIDS

- Let's be honest—we've all made messes before! Talk about a time that you, a friend, or a sibling made a huge mess and didn't clean it up afterwards.
- Why didn't you clean up the mess? Was it because you figured someone else would?
- In life, we can sometimes think we don't need to share with our sibling, be nice to the new kid, or pick up our mess because someone else will. But what if no one else would do those things? How would you do things differently if you knew no one else would do those things?
