stiffness

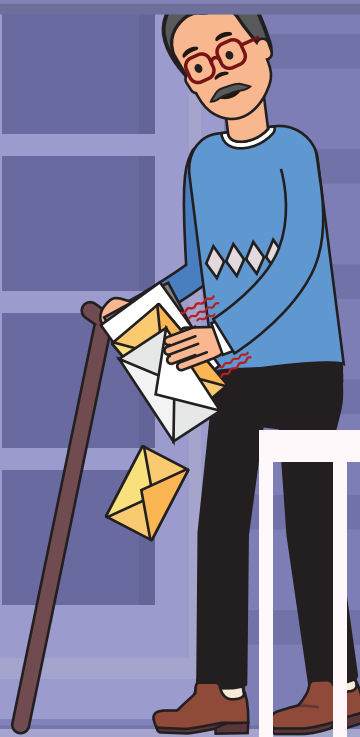


poor balance

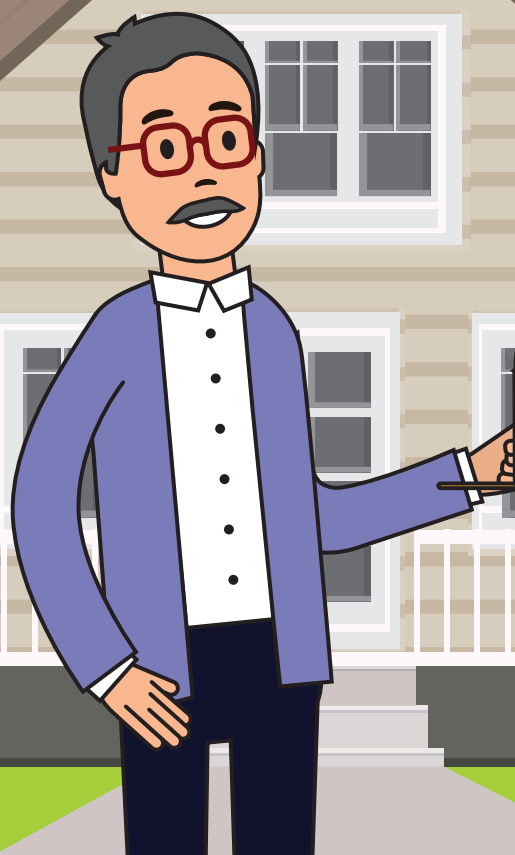


slurring
