#### 3-Dimensional Tic-Tac-Toe

With 3-D Tic-Tac-Toe, you can get 3 in a row horizontally, diagonally, or vertically.

The Cube is the O. The Jack is the X.

On the very first turn, the first player may not place a piece in the center. After that, pieces may be placed wherever players want.

There are 2 ways to play:

- 1. First player to get 3 in a row wins. This is very easy and the games will be short.
- 2. The second way is much more interesting.

Play continues and players make as many 3-in-a-rows as they can. Each time you make a 3-in-a-row, put a tally mark on your side of the score sheet.

Keep playing until the game is full of Cubes and Jacks. Then count up the number of 3-in-a-rows each player has. The player with the most tally marks at the end is the winner.


- 3. Here are ways you can make 3-in-a-row.
