### Dance Rules and Guidelines

1. **A photo ID is required to enter the dance. The doors will close at 9pm.**
2. **Refunds will not be issued for late students or for non-attendance.**
3. Appropriate dress is mandatory for both boys and girls. All school dress code rules apply. See back for dress code guidelines. All carry-in bags, purses, and coats must be left at the coat check.
4. **We have a zero tolerance policy for alcohol and drug use.** All students will be expected to take a breathalyzer test before entering the dance. If a student receives a positive result on their initial breathalyzer test, the student

will be held and retested 15 minutes later to confirm the positive result before any action is taken. Any positive reading will result in exclusion from the dance. No refunds will be given.

5. Students may be breathalyzed during or at the end of the dance. If a student receives a positive result after they have been admitted to the dance, the student will be disciplined based on the AHS discipline grid.
6. **Sexual Harassment and Inappropriate Dance:** AUSD Board of Education Policy 5611 and Title IX of the Federal Education Amendments of 1972 prohibit sexual harassment at any school-related functions. Therefore, sexually offensive or inappropriate language, gestures, and dancing are not acceptable. Dancing styles that involve intimate touching of the breasts, buttocks, or genitals, or that simulate sexual activity or intercourse are NOT allowed. When students are dancing back to front, all dancers must remain upright: no sexual squatting or bending is allowed; no hands on knees and no hands on the dance floor with your buttocks facing or touching your dance partner; no lying on the floor in a sexually suggestive manner; no lap dancing or sitting on the groin of another dancer; no thrusting that simulates intercourse. The AHS Administration reserves the right to determine what constitutes sexual harassment and inappropriate dancing. If a student is found to be dancing inappropriately, he or she will receive one warning and will be taken off of the dance floor for 15 minutes. If a second incident occurs, the student will be removed from the dance completely and his or her parents will be notified.
7. All students and guests are subject to all school rules and regulations. Students in violation of school rules and regulations will be disciplined based on the AHS discipline grid. Refunds will not be issued for non-attendance due to disciplinary reasons.
8. Students may be prevented from attending a dance based on their attendance record. Please refer to the attendance policies in the Student Handbook.
9. All students, including guests, must comply with the decisions made by the chaperones at the dance (administrators, teachers, parents, and security staff). Students and guests failing to comply with the decision of the chaperone will be asked to leave.

### **Albany High School Appropriate Dress**

1. Clothing should be neat, clean and appropriate with shoes worn at all times. Common sense and reasonable judgment should eliminate the need to correct students in the area of dress and personal appearance.
2. Shorts may be worn, but shorts and skirts that are too short, frayed, torn, or too tight are not acceptable. Clothing must not have holes that would attract attention and/or cause a distraction to the educational process. The judgment of this is up to school personnel.
3. Markings or insignia on clothing or the body, or items of clothing must not be obscene, suggestive, show gang affiliation, inappropriate language or advocate disruptive behavior.
4. Clothing must not advertise or promote alcohol, tobacco or drugs. It must also not incite violence.
5. Underwear may not show.
6. Tops worn by boys or girls must not be revealing as judged by school personnel. Clothing should cover the midriff.
7. Clothing that is disruptive or causes a distraction while at school or a school function may not be permitted.
8. Albany High School reserves the right to allow or disallow certain apparel and accessories. If a student is asked to remove a hat or other headgear by any school personnel or guest teacher, the request must be honored promptly with no discussion.
