

**What is a Bike Valet Parking Station?** A free, safe and convenient place to park your bike(s) while you attend an event. The Bike Valet Parking Station is monitored by attendants who keep an eye on your bike in a secured parking area.

**Family Friendly & Age Friendly –** The Bike Valet Parking Station is family friendly & age friendly. Folks of all ages, and folks with small children are encouraged to consider parking their cars in a remote location and riding your bikes in to town events, especially along the Goffstown Rail Trail, which provides a safe & scenic bicycling environment for everyone.

**Walk-Friendly Too!** Goffstown events are also perfect opportunities to get in a walk along the Goffstown Rail Trail. Why sit in traffic in your car when you can enjoy a leisurely walk along a

beautiful rail trail? Choose a distance that works for you, and park in one of many parking locations along the trail.



## **Bike Valet Parking Station**



### **Goffstown Old Home Day Sat July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018 10am to 4pm**

Park your car at one of many parking locations along the Goffstown Rail Trail. Ride your bike along the beautiful & safe Goffstown Rail Trail to the event. Park your bike for free at the convenient Bike Valet Parking Station (behind Town Hall)!

Park at one of these parking locations along the Goffstown Rail Trail:

**Goffstown Parks & Rec (155 South Mast Road)** – Trail runs directly in front of the Parks & Rec Center building. 1.0 mile to Village. About 30 parking spots.

**Mast Road Trailhead** – Located on Route 114, across from the Villa Augustina ball fields. Usually a portable toilet at the ball fields in the summer months. 1.5 miles to Village. About 12 parking spots.

**Hillsboro County Complex (328 Mast Road)** – Park at the public parking lot at the Hillsboro County Complex office buildings. The rail trail runs behind this building complex. 3.5 miles to Village. About 30 parking spots.

**Danis Park Road** – The rail trail intersects Danis Park Road. The rail trail intersects Danis Park Road. A small paved parking lot accommodates 4 vehicles. 3.8 miles to Village.

**Mooseclub Park Road Trailhead** – The rail trail intersects Mooseclub Park Road. A small paved parking lot accommodates 4 vehicles, plus limited shoulder parking for 3 or 4 cars. 4.9 miles to Village.

**Sarette Recreation Complex** – Park at this lot in front of the sports fields. Access the gravel service road that leads you to the rail trail by passing through the zig-zag gate. Follow this gravel road to the second zig-zag gate that accesses the rail trail. Distance from the parking lot area to the rail trail, along the gravel service road is .2 miles. 5.8 miles to Village.
