- buttered lobster scramble** ..... 18  
scrambled eggs, asparagus, béarnaise sauce
- petit sirloin eggs benedict** ..... 16  
cheddar scallion buttermilk biscuit, 2 poached eggs  
and hollandaise
- maple glazed grilled country ham** ..... 16  
potato latke, fried eggs, sliced granny smith apple

## COCKTAILS

- brennivín bloody** ..... 9  
brennivín aquavit, crushed pepper, sweet + smokey rim
- bourbon kiss** ..... 10  
four roses, lejay cassis, basil, fresh lemon

## BIG BOTTLED BEER

---

### logsdon farmhouse ales | hood river, oregon

fresh hop seizoen [farmhouse ale] 7.5%

*this unfiltered bottle of seizoen is naturally refermented and carbonated with select yeast strains, producing complex fruity and spicy flavors that are balanced with hops and soft malt character.*

### brooklyn brewery | brooklyn, new york

the discreet charm of the framboise (2016) [framboise] 7.3%

*this beer started as a base sour beer featuring barley malt, wheat, and spelt. it was then aged in woodford reserve bourbon barrels, each containing fifteen pounds of fresh raspberries. finally, the beer was bottle conditioned with brettanomyces lambicus and champagne yeasts. the result is a sharp, dry, bombastic beer that is excellent with food.*

### firestone walker | paso robles, california

bravo [imperial brown ale] 13.2%

*the first ale ever brewed for the anniversary blending program, it is a single-hopped strong brown ale brewed using the hop variety bravo. it is then aged for up to a year in circa 1990's used heaven hill bourbon barrels.*
