A Brief History of Granville Missions

Era 1: 1940's -1970's:

Missional Works Established

- Granville missionary families work to plant Brethren churches in the Dominican Republic. Over 100 active Dominican Churches today.
- Businessmen at Granville establish Calling Foundation/Ministries and develop Seniors Housing with land from the City of Vancouver, and are gifted a home that provides accommodation for returning missionaries.
- Three businessmen from Granville are part of a group that established Regent College at UBC.
- Many families at Granville support the early work of Young Life ministries to youth in Vancouver through board and committee work as well as opening homes to weekly club.
- *Granville members continue to be involved in all of these ministries up until today.

Era 2: 1980's-1990's:

Opening of Closed Countries and Asian Immigration

- Granville supports missionaries who undertake work in the former Soviet Union countries of Russia, Moldova, Albania, and Ukraine.
- Granville members teach English in China and Mongolia as a means
 of early entrance into these closed countries. The Mongolia work
 influences teaching English at Granville.
- Teaching English to the wave of primarily Asian immigrants starts at Granville and leads to the establishment of a distinct service in Mandarin.

Era 3: 2000's-today:

Local and Global Expansion of Granville Missions

- A Missions Team is established that supports missionaries locally and around the world to enhance Granville's missional reach to each continent.
 Most of the missionaries supported have come through Granville doors.
 Clear plans are developed every three years guiding the work.
- · Over 500 Granville members sent on short term missions.
- Alpha global leadership is supported and Alpha as a missions' outreach at Granville is started.
- Large donations are provided for Missions purposes at Granville and are used for important projects with our global missionary partners.
- Camp ministry is supported at Rockridge (new Young Life Camp), Anvil, and Pioneer with many volunteers from Granville.
- Granville supports church planting efforts with lasting works established in Fresno, California and locally with The Way church in three locations in Vancouver. A leader Granville supported in Alpha is a key leader in this Church.
- Granville partners with key justice and care missions in indigenous people's outreach, sex trafficking recovery, low-income family support, and orphaned children.
- A ministry encouraging Christians to reach out to neighbours is established at Granville and shared with other Christian communities.

Jason Ballard is the Lead Pastor of The Way Church Vancouver. He is Executive Director of the Canadian Church Leaders Network (CCLN), a network committed to serving church leaders in Canada and developing the next generation ministers who will lead the church of tomorrow. Our initiatives include producing online content and resources, hosting regional events, and faacilitating the Church Leaders Incubator, a two-vear program to strengthen young pastors for long-term, effective, senior leadership. Our goal with all of our initiatives is to catalyze conversation and build bridges across various contexts in order to better equip more resilient, theologically robust, and culturally nuanced church leaders to thrive in our post-Christian culture.

"We started CCLN in 2020 with a conviction to play our part in seeing the next generation of Canadian pastors filled with hope, connected in community, and equipped to lead in our time. As we step into our fourth year as a ministry, we are only more convicted, hope-filled, and passionate about this work. We feel deeply humbled by the growing trust from pastors and supporters across Canada. Pray that we would have

increased capacity to invest in more pastors in significant ways and join us as we pray for the renewal of the Church in Canada."

Georgia and Achao (Emmaus, Lucas and Zion) are full-time missionaries to the Philippines. Georgia and Achao founded the non-profit Abundant Grace of God Maternity Centre which shares God's love with the families of the province of Kalinga through maternity care. Georgia and Achao have been serving since 2007 and were commended by Granville Chapel in 2012.

The isolated province of Kalinga, an area still plagued with tribal wars and poverty, is one of the most beautiful and untouched areas in the Philippines. The people have historically had little to no access to medical care. In fact, before most of the pregnant women delivered their babies at home on their own, without any prior prenatal care or attending doctor or midwife. Many of these women and babies died due to complications that would have been easily preventable with adequate care from a qualified midwife.

Georgia is a Certified Professional Midwife. In 2007, Georgia, her husband Achao together along with some young local women wanting to study midwifery, set up a maternity clinic to serve the tribal peoples of Kalinga. It was opened in February 2007 and almost 4000 babies have been delivered and over 50 local midwives have been trained. Georgia spends her time training local midwives and caring for moms and babies at the centre. Achao is charge of clinic maintenance, emergency driving and building projects manager.

We served in Asia for 32 years among unreached people-most recently in Thailand, where Eric served our global Pioneers family as International Director for 11 years, until 2022. We continued to engage in global ministry with Pioneers from Columbia, SC, while caring for Eric's parents in their final few years, and now participate in the care of Ellen's parents. Being stateside means our ministry is often virtual, or requires international travel. ABOUT US

We were sent out by Granville Chapel to do church planting work in Thailand with OMF International in 2008. Since 2019 we have been living in Chiangrai, the northernmost province of Thailand, where we are part of the Tai Yuan team (the Tai Yuan is the name for the Northern Thai people group). The team is involved in church planting and discipleship in various locations and settings.

MINISTRY UPDATES

The particular focus of our family has been the Chiang Rai International Christian School, a very strategic regional asset in the kingdom of God. The teachers are all missionaries that are supported by their sending churches, and the school is very overtly and positively Christian. Yet, some 30% of the student body consists of children from Thai families, mostly Buddhist. Through reaching and discipling these families and the wider communities they are a part of, we hope to see a movement for Jesus that will have an impact on the whole region.

Jonathan was born in Canada and raised in France, where his parents were called to serve God in 1966. Rachel was born and raised in Angola and Namibia, where her parents served as missionaries. Following their training in education, theology and clinical counselling, Jonathan and Rachel went to France in 1999 to develop a range of resources and services to help and train Christian workers serving within the French-speaking world. Their three adult children live in France, Ireland, Scotland. They attended Granville Chapel while on sabbatical in 2008.

Their goal is to help and equip Christian workers (missionaries, pastors, church planters and national Christian leaders) to maintain and renew their health and their passion for ministry, and thus remain effective in pursuing their call to reach people with the love of Jesus. They direct a centre for the care of Christian workers called Entrepierres, located in southeastern France, to which they welcome around 300 people a year for times of replenishment, debriefing, spiritual direction, vocational guidance, pastoral care, and short-term counselling. Although they are based in France, their work extends throughout French-speaking Europe and Africa, where Jonathan travels to teach in Bible schools, seminaries, and pastors' conferences. Life in Vancouver Westside consists of biweekly and weekly "Club" for grades 6 - 8 (WyldLife) and grades 9 -12 (Young Life) respectively: where teens play games, sing songs, and a leader shares about their life and the life of Jesus, all with no strings attached. Outside of those evenings, there's plenty of life-on-life time spent between leaders and teens; cheering at their sports games, going for coffee, hikes, you name it! Mercutio and the volunteer leaders also run "Campaigners", a student leadership group & weekly bible study; encouraging the youth to be active in their faith, to talk about impacting the lives of their friends and highschools, and to pray for one another. In all the time spent together. there have been great intentional conversations. Teens today are taking in info 24/7, and asking big questions. Pray for their wisdom and safety, and that they might see leaders as trustworthy friends and mentors. As well, pray for more awesome leaders, who love Jesus and have a heart for teens.

programs are built on mutually transforming long-term relationships. treating those we journey alongside with dignity and respect and valuing cultural heritage. The House serves as a center for operations and a nurturing community space. The Boundless mentorship program pairs youth with adults so they can be known, celebrated and supported. The Post Secondary program walks alongside young adults through this major transition. Four young men currently live at Inner Hope's Home supported by house parents. Inner Hope engages with cultural mentors and a community advisory committee to facilitate healthy partnerships

Issues that we actively address include: Homelessness / Racism / Aging Out of Care / Children in Care / Addiction. Through all this we believe there is hope. By God's grace, we see His love transform young people as we journey alongside them, nurturing their development into greater stability, impacting their families and community.

Inner Hope knows that dignity, respect and valuing cultural heritage are essential as we work together toward right relationships and holistic healing.
