Format Summer Term 7 is 5 weeks for Monday or Wednesday evenings only. See inside registration form for exact days, times and prices.

1st Day Procedure Skaters should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled class time to pick up name tag and to allow sufficient time for preparation.

Equipment Single Blade hockey or figure skates are required. All sizes of hockey and figure skates are available to rent for only \$3.00. Helmets are highly recommended for all children 5 years of age and under (bicycle helmets are acceptable).

Attire Comfortable, flexible and warm clothing, including hats and gloves or mittens, are recommended for all skaters!

Payment Cash, check or credit card and check.

Policies 100% refund will be given up to 5 days before the first day of class. No refunds will be given after the first day of classes. We do not pro-rate classes. The rink reserves the right to cancel or consolidate any class.

Class Descriptions for Summer Term 7

Snowplow 1, 2, 3 & 4

This class is designed for 3 to 5 year olds. The most elementary skating skills are combined with fun and games

Basic Skills 1 through 6

Classes introduce fundamentals to skaters ages 6 and up and for tots who have passed Snowplow 4

Free skate and Pre Free skate

half hour class For skaters who have passed Basic 6—For those that cannot make the Monday hour long Jr. Blades class.

Junior Blades

Junior Blades is for skaters that have passed Basic 6. Introducing free skate, moves in the field, off-ice warm up routines, stretching and artistry. This is an Hour long class.

Adult Classes

designed for those over the age of 16.

Adapted

Classes designed for those with special needs.

Learn to Play Hockey—Youth

Monday evenings at 6:40-7:30 pm. Skaters must have passed Snowplow 4 or Basic 2 in order to enroll. Basic equipment required—HECC certified helmet with facemask, shin pads, elbow pads & hockey gloves and stick.

It is highly recommended LTP Skaters also continue with LTS Classes through at least Basic 5

Learn to Play Hockey—Adults

Monday evenings 7:40-8:30 pm —is for anyone 16 yrs of age & Older. Skating skills & Stick handling is part of the curriculum. Basic equipment required (Helmet w/facemask, shin guards, elbow pads, hockey gloves, stick)

Skate Rentals extra \$3.00 per pair each week.
