**Consider this story about the Bryce Family.** Mr. & Mrs. Bryce both work outside the home in order to provide for their family.

Due to Covid, the Bryce's have been affected by furlough, but thankfully have now been able to return to work full-time. But, this leaves them in a lurch.

Their 2nd grader, Ethan, is scheduled for distance learning, setting him up to be home without supervision all day, expected to complete his schoolwork. The Bryce's are incredibly concerned about leaving Ethan home alone; he has a knack for finding trouble when adult supervision is lacking. The Bryce's can't afford to sacrifice either income and are at a loss for what to do.

Fortunately, there is a wonderful solution thanks to the Boys & Girls Club!

The Boys & Girls Clubs have launched a Back 2 School Program to help the MANY families in the same situation. While adhering to strict safety guidelines, the clubs are able to offer a safe and encouraging place for kids to complete their distance learning as well as participate in after school activities.

This amazing program runs Monday through Friday from 7am to 6pm and includes:
