Routine for Mock exams at UTC Portsmouth:

- 1. Students must line up in classes in the atrium 10 minutes prior to the stated start time.
- 2. Students must provide a clear, **transparent pencil case** in which to store their equipment (black pens, a ruler, a pencil, eraser, highlighter pen and a calculator).
- 3. Students are not permitted to bring any means of electronic communication (e.g. mobile phones) into the exam room. These should be kept **switched off, in their bags**.
- 4. The presence of a mobile phone during an exam will lead to immediate disqualification for that student
- 5. All watches must be removed and not brought into the exam room
- 6. Students' bags are to be stored in lockers.
- 7. Students *must* enter the exam hall in silence. Any form of communication to peers may result in disqualification from the exam. Students may raise their hand without calling out to attract the attention of an exam invigilator.
- 8. At the end of the exam, students are sat in silence as papers are gathered up. Students leave the exam hall when directed and in silence.
- 9. Unless explicitly stated on the exam timetable, students attend lessons as normal.
- 10. Should an exam impact upon a student's break time, this will be reallocated to ensure that students do not miss out on their break.
- 11. All exams will be held in the Sports Hall except Statistics. Those with separate invigilation will be in Rooms 206 or 214
- 12. All morning exams will cover periods 1 & 2. All afternoon exams will cover periods 5 & 6 unless otherwise stated
- 13. Word Processors for Access Arrangements will be delivered to Sports Hall and collected for printing afterwards
- 14. Students allocated 25% extra time are expected to stay for the additional time
