Of the **11** mandatory minimum sentences for **WEAPON OFFENCES**

- 5** have been challenged and upheld
- 3** have been both upheld and struck down in different courts
- 3** have been struck down

Of the **15** mandatory minimum sentences for **DRUG OFFENCES**

- 1** has been challenged and upheld
- 1** has been both upheld and struck down in different courts
- 13** have been struck down



Of the **25** mandatory minimum sentences for **SEXUAL OFFENCES**

- 10** have been challenged and upheld
- 4** have been both upheld and struck down in different courts
- 11** have been struck down

Of the **10** other mandatory minimum sentences (murder, robbery, etc.)

- 10** have been challenged and upheld
