

MANDATORY MINIMUM SENTENCES IN CANADA




Canadian law now has more mandatory minimum sentences than ever before. But many are being deep-sixed by the courts as unconstitutional cruel and unusual punishment.

rangefindr.ca takes a look at the mandatory minimum sentences that have been challenged in court to see how many are still afloat.

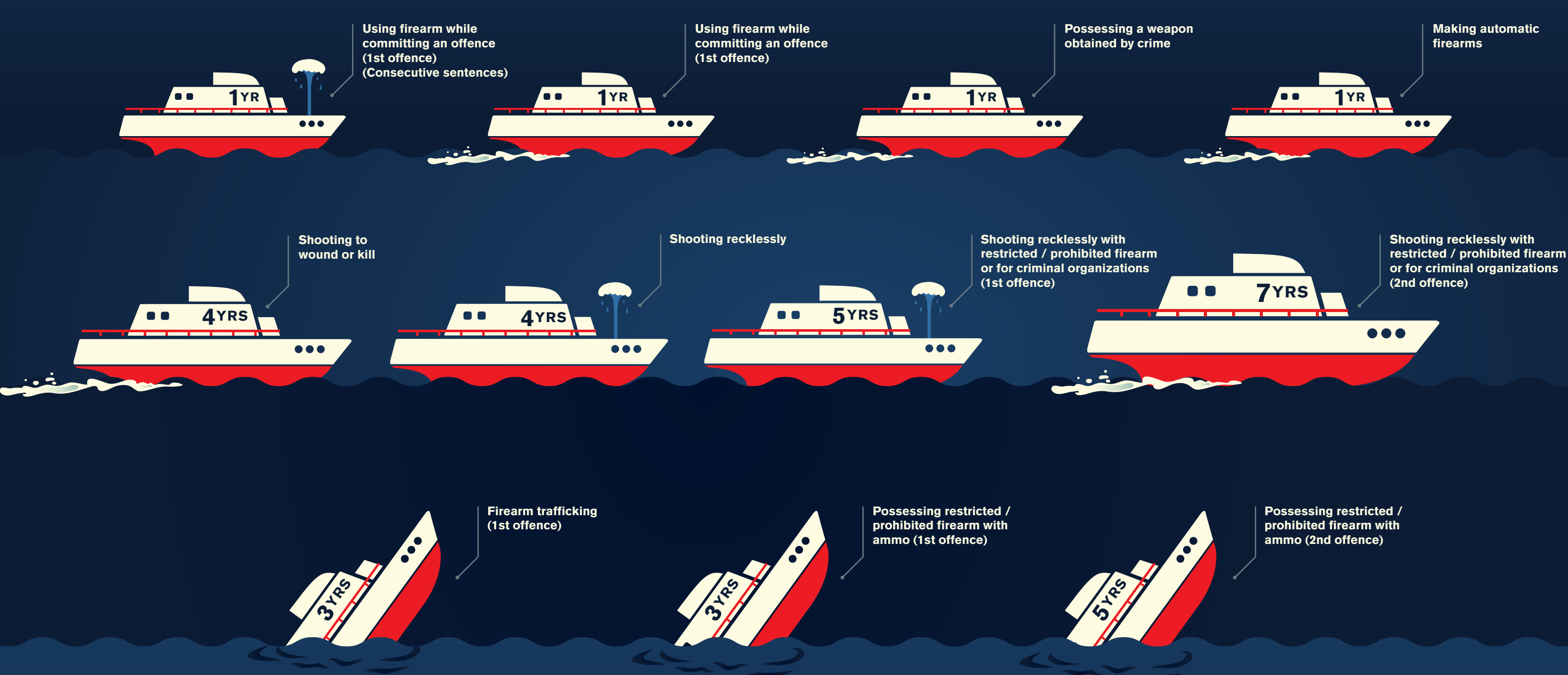

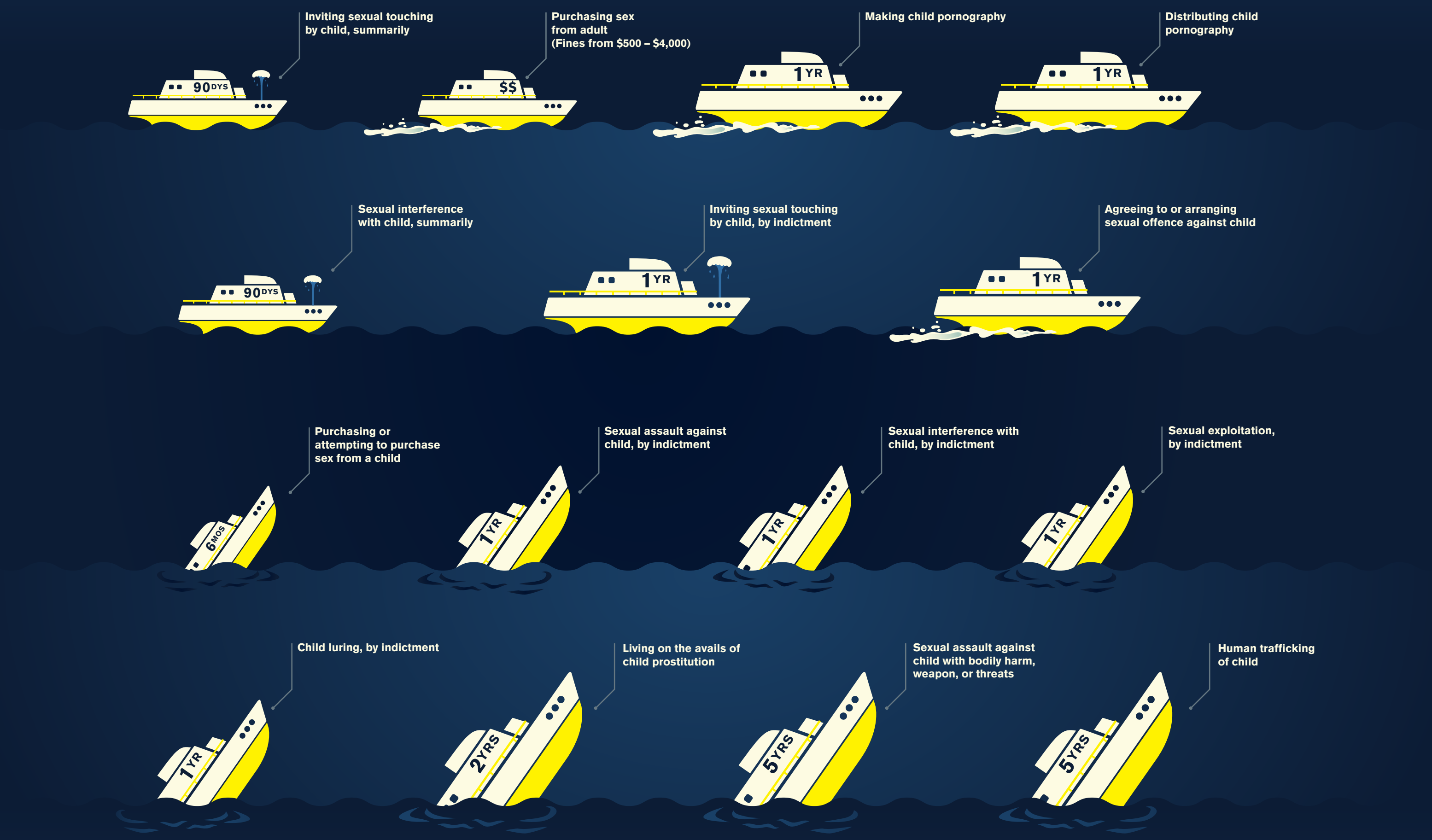

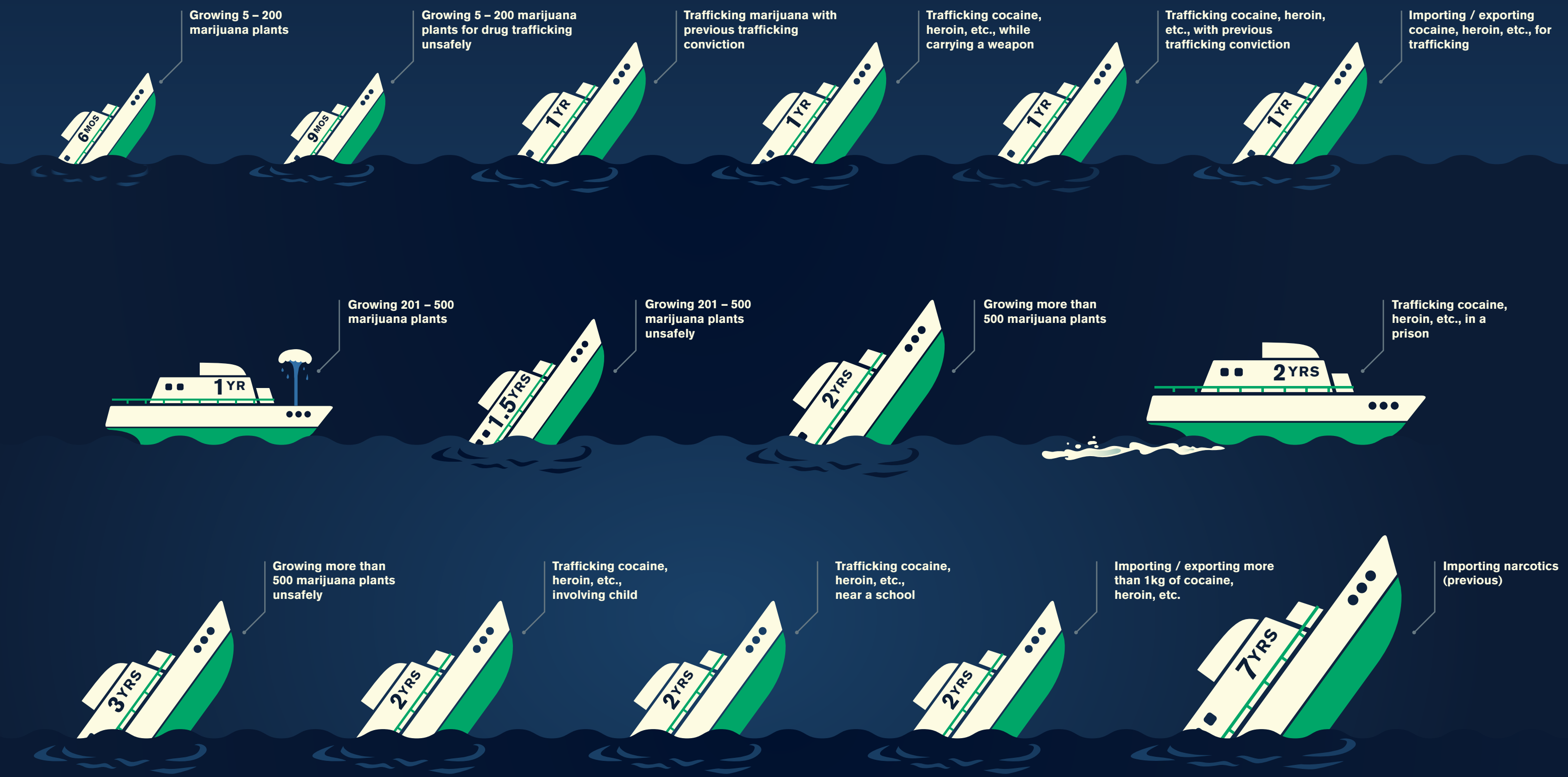
