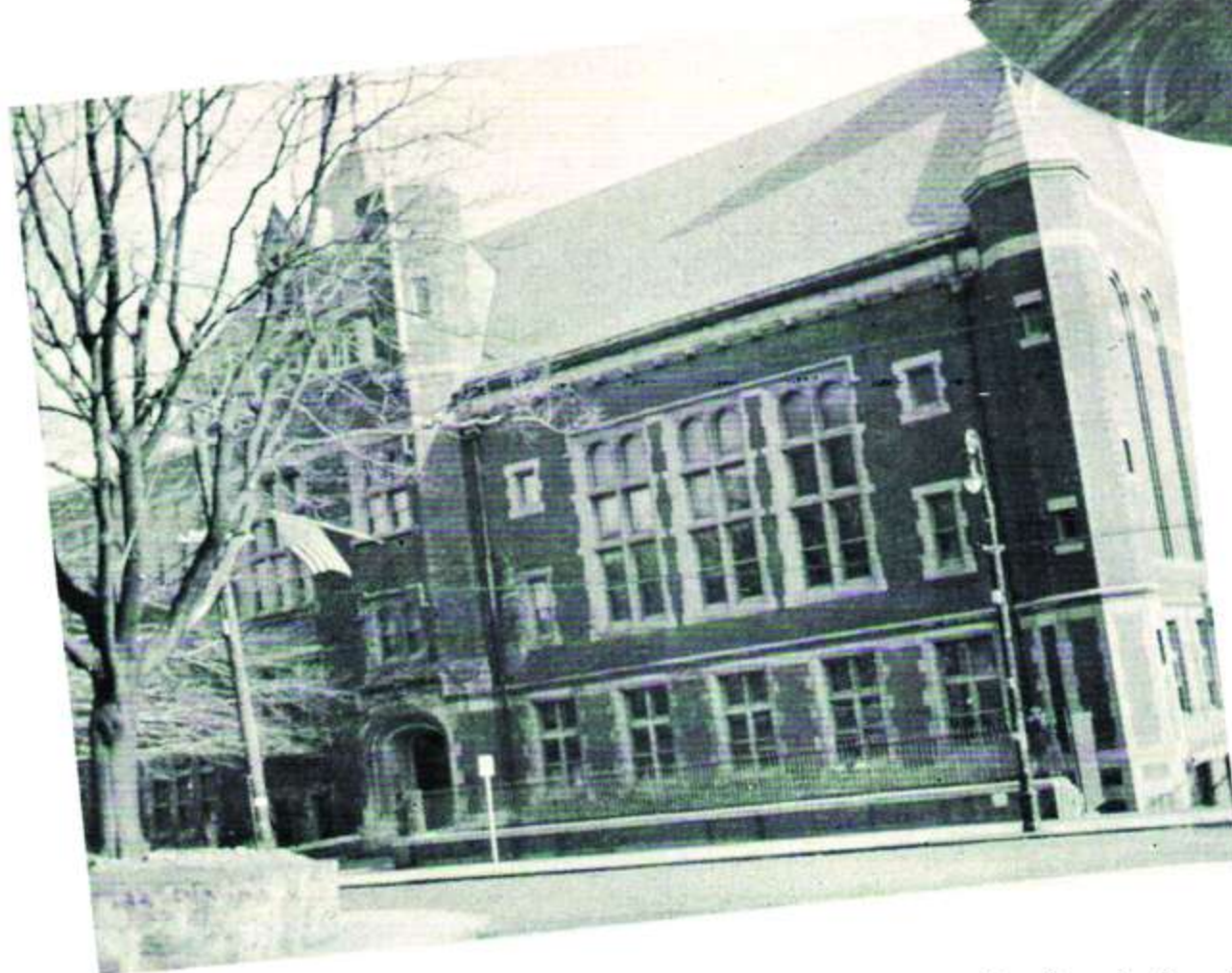
# 1940 - 1954
