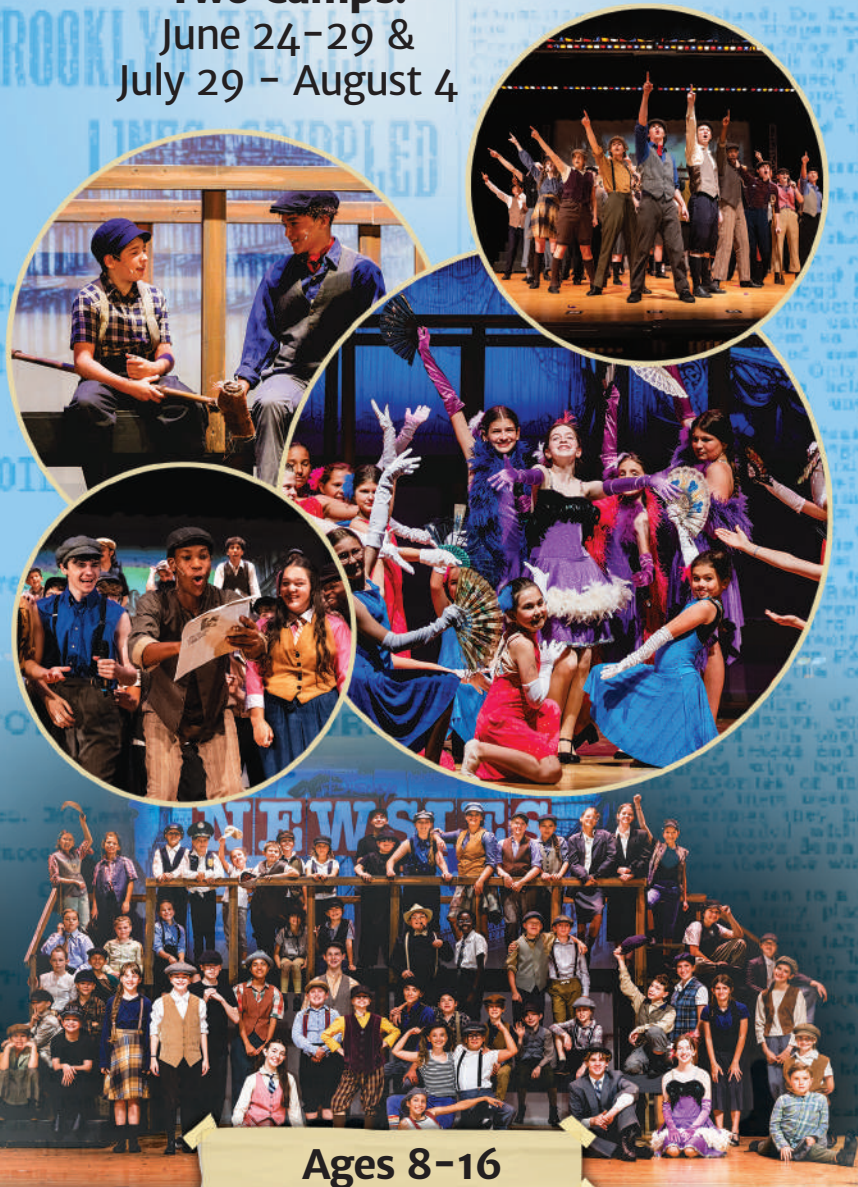

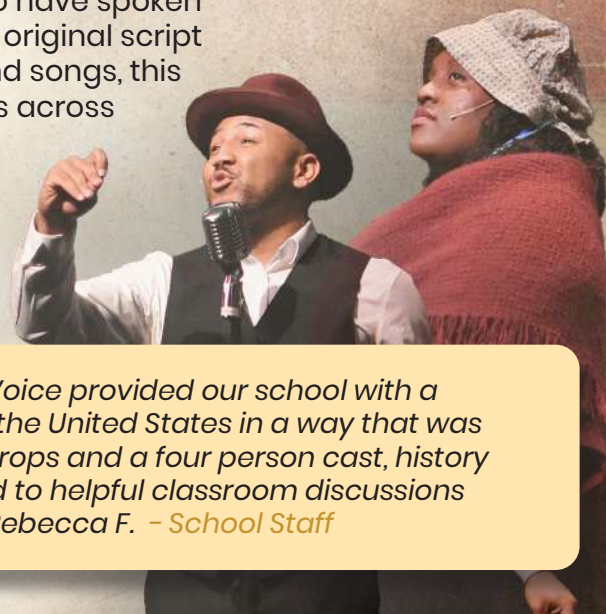
LIFT EV'RY VOICE

FINANCIAL *statement*

Servant Stage Company is carefully managed and has ***never run a deficit since its creation, with a sustainable vision for the future to serve our community for generations to come.***

Our fiscal year closed on Dec. 31, 2024 with \$1,038,170 in assets (\$973,718 in cash of which \$181,613 is in restricted funds). Our income for 2024 was \$1,183,764 against \$846,066 in expenses.

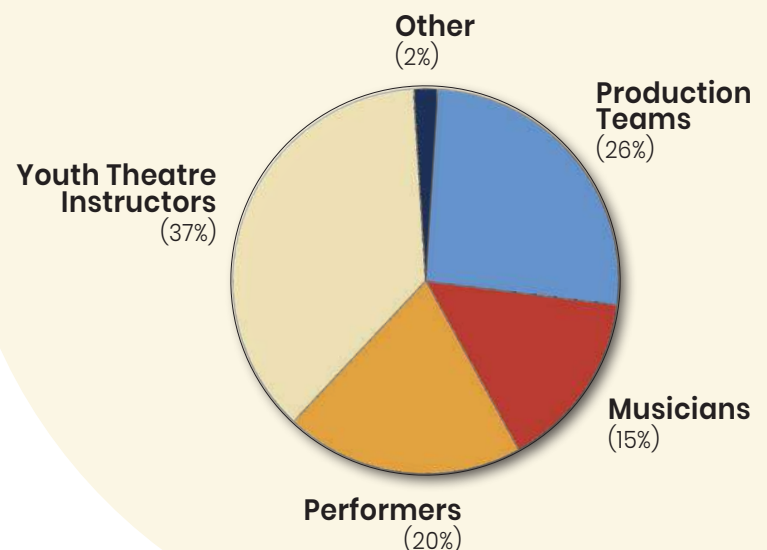

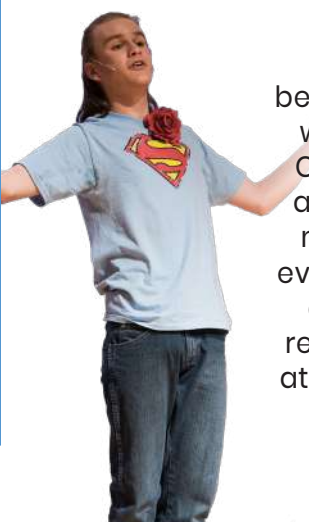
