- 1. The examination sessions highlighted in red include 20 minutes over and above the time traditionally allocated for the papers concerned.
- 2. The aural tests in Irish are included with the paper and are not timetabled separately. The duration of the Irish aural test is 20 minutes at Higher and Ordinary Level and 30 minutes at Foundation Level. In all other language subjects with an aural component, the duration of the aural test is related to the duration of the CDs and, including reading time, will not exceed 40 minutes.
- 3. Leaving Certificate Examinations in Hebrew Studies, Ancient Greek and in the Non Curricular Languages listed below will be held on Monday 17th June from 9.30am to 12.30pm.
