Community Peacemaker Teams (CPT) is registered in Iraqi Kurdistan as an international non-governmental organization (INGO). Since 2006 the team has worked in Iraqi Kurdistan alongside Kurdish farmers and shepherds impacted by cross-border bombings, civil society activists and minority groups facing discrimination and violence, and non-violent initiatives to build peace and respect for individual and communal rights.

Outside Iraqi Kurdistan, CPT is based in the United States and partners with human rights defenders, grass-roots organizations and non-violent initiatives through its programs in Colombia, Palestine, the Aegean Region, Canada, the USA and various projects in other regions of the world.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Since the 1980s, Turkey and Iran have conducted military operations in northern Iraq, purportedly targeting various armed non-state opposition Kurdistan groups, such as the Kurdistan Workers' Party (PKK) and its affiliated armed groups, as well as the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Iranian Kurdistan (KDP-I). This report focuses on civilian impacts since Iraqi Kurdistan's semi-autonomous territory was established in 1991.

This report collates, documents, and verifies the immediate harm to the civilian population—death and injury—caused by Turkish and Iranian military operations inside Iraqi Kurdistan, as well as the broader impact on civilian life. Extensive military operations by the Turkish and Iranian military forces have resulted in forced displacement, environmental damage, the destruction of civilian infrastructure, and socioeconomic hardship. Casualties mainly occur during a broad range of civilian activities, including income generation (such as agriculture, animal husbandry, foraging, subsistence entrepreneurship, etc.), recreation (communal and family visits, celebrations, picnics, tourism), or simply being at home. As a result, since 1991, Turkish and Iranian military operations have caused 845 civilian casualties (425 killed and 420 injured), 15 non-belligerent casualties (10 killed and 5 injured), and 8 non-combatant casualties (8 killed) inside Iraqi Kurdistan.

The Turkish Armed Forces (TAF) are responsible for 83% of civilian casualties inside Iraqi Kurdistan, constituting an overwhelming majority. 344 civilians have been killed and 358 have been injured due to Turkish military operations, resulting in a total of 702 casualties. 39% of these casualties occurred between 2018 and 2024, due to a rapid increase in military operations inside Iraqi Kurdistan that began in December 2017. These 'Claw' series of operations aim to create a buffer zone incorporating most of the 360-kilometer-long Iraq/Turkey border region. To date, Turkey

has constructed 74 military bases inside Iraqi Kurdistan. The Turkish military presence and operations have caused the displacement of thousands of people from at least 170 villages, with a further 602 villages at risk of displacement, while also severely disrupting local economies, livelihoods, and indigenous ways of life. Underscoring the perpetual targeting of civilian life is the fact that the majority of casualties occurred when the victims were at home or engaged in agriculture, accounting for 59% of the total. Particularly concerning is that 28% of the casualties are children, totaling 194 casualties, with 79 killed and 115 injured.

Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) is responsible for 17% of civilian casualties inside Iraqi Kurdistan. 81 civilians have been killed and 62 injured due to Iranian military operations, totaling 143 casualties. Following the end of the Iran-Iraq war in 1988, Iran continued bombarding Iraqi Kurdistan territory mainly using artillery, resulting in the deaths of 63 civilians and the injuries of 48 individuals, amounting to a total of 111 casualties. These casualties make up 78% of the overall casualties caused by Iranian military actions. In addition, since 2013, Iran has constructed at least 151 military bases along the Iran-Iraq border, resulting in civilian casualties and displacement due to bombardments, landmines, and small arms fire from the bases. Also underscoring the targeting of civilian life is that the highest percentage of civilian casualties occurred when the victims were at home or engaged in agriculture, accounting for 54%.

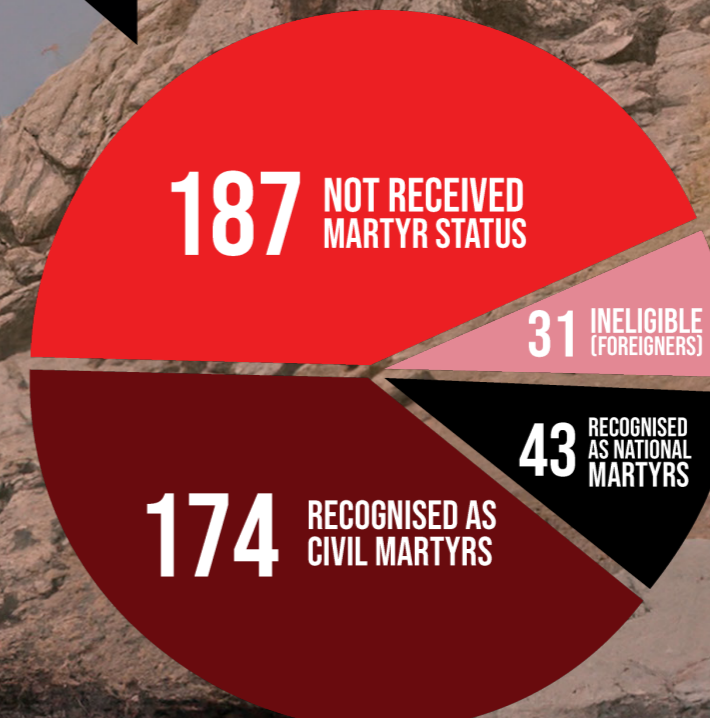
Iraqi Parliamentary Law 20 of 2009 and Law 57 of 2015 state that the government must provide financial compensation to all Iraqi citizens affected or harmed by military operations and terrorist actions. According to an order from the KRG Deputy Prime Minister issued in 2011, all Iraqi citizens that reside in Iraqi Kurdistan that are killed by Turkish

and Iranian militaries should be considered national martyrs.

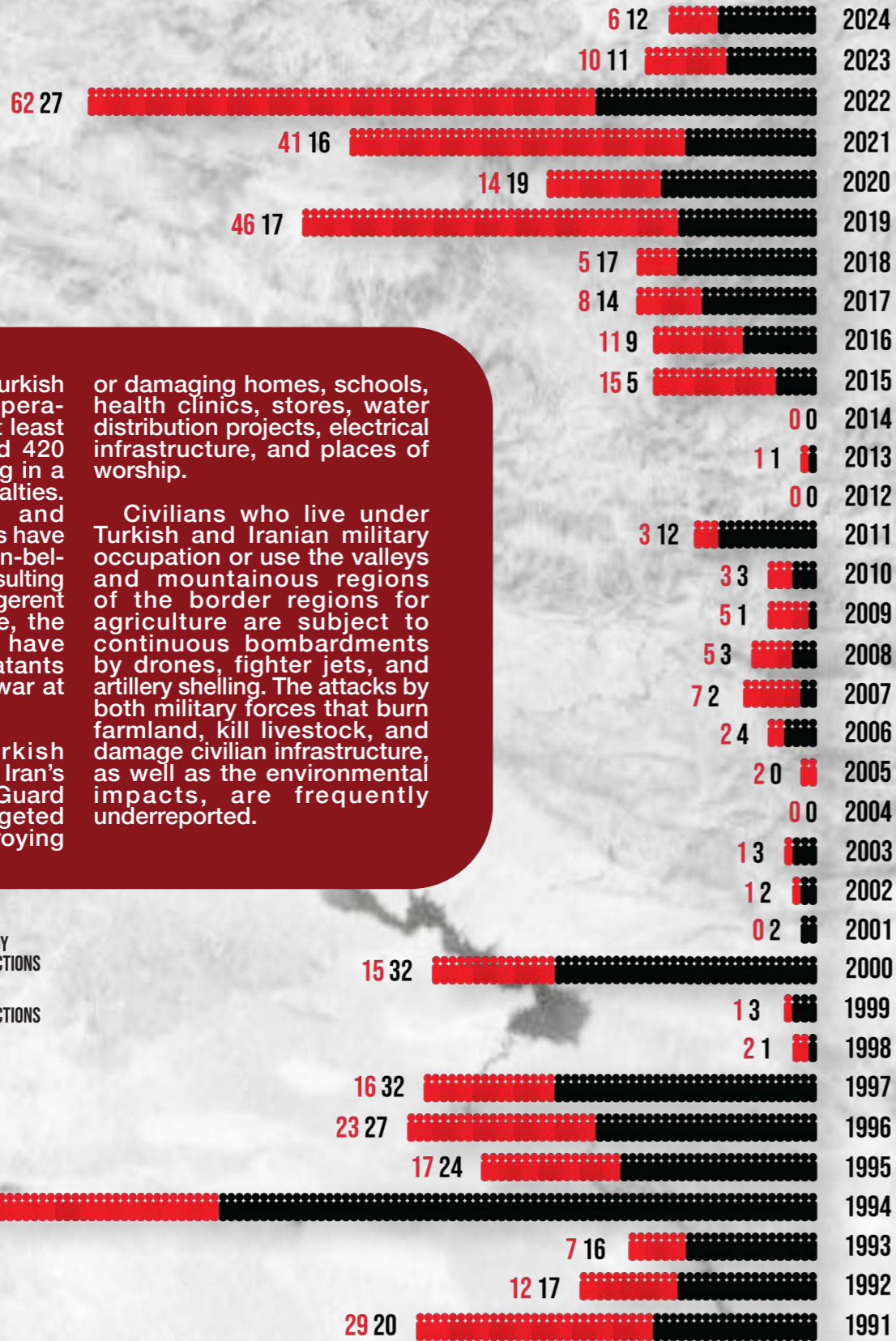
However, due to insufficient data since 1991, political dynamics, and a lack of state institutions addressing these issues, the government has not provided any support or compensation to the majority of impacted civilians.

The government has not designated 46% of killed Iraqi citizens as martyrs, leaving their families without any form of compensation. 93% of injured Iraqi citizens remain uncompensated, with many suffering from disabilities that prevent them from working and earning an income. Of the 420 injured civilians, 155 (37%) are in need of further medical assistance.

Overall, since 1991, Turkish and Iranian military operations have resulted in at least 425 civilian deaths and 420 civilian injuries, resulting in a total of 845 civilian casualties. Furthermore, Turkish and Iranian military operations have claimed the lives of 10 non-belligerents and injured 5, resulting in a total of 15 non-belligerent casualties. Furthermore, the Turkish Armed Forces have killed eight non-combatants who were prisoners of war at the time of their deaths.

At times, the Turkish Armed Forces (TAF) and Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) have targeted populated areas, destroying

or damaging homes, schools, health clinics, stores, water distribution projects, electrical infrastructure, and places of worship.

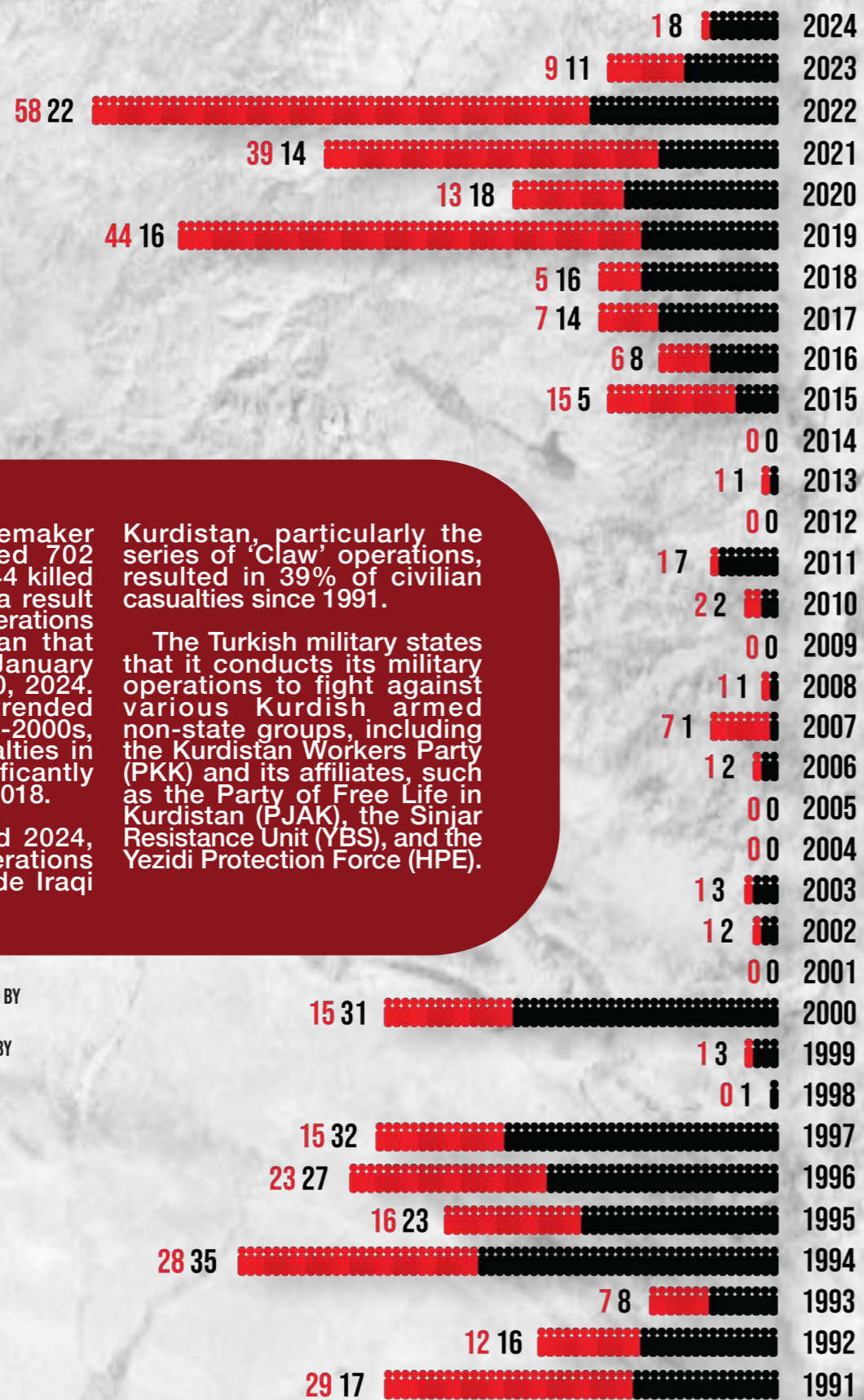
Civilians who live under Turkish and Iranian military occupation or use the valleys and mountainous regions of the border regions for agriculture are subject to continuous bombardments by drones, fighter jets, and artillery shelling. The attacks by both military forces that burn farmland, kill livestock, and damage civilian infrastructure, as well as the environmental impacts, are frequently underreported.

III. TURKISH MILITARY OPERATIONS



TOTAL CIVILIAN CASUALTIES CAUSED BY TURKISH MILITARY OPERATIONS IN NORTHERN IRAQ, 1 JANUARY 1991 TO 30 JUNE 2024



Community Peacemaker Teams (CPT) verified 702 civilian casualties (344 killed and 358 injured) as a result of Turkish military operations inside Iraqi Kurdistan that occurred between January 1, 1991, and June 30, 2024. Civilian casualties trended downward in the mid-2000s, following high casualties in the 1990s, but significantly increased starting in 2018.

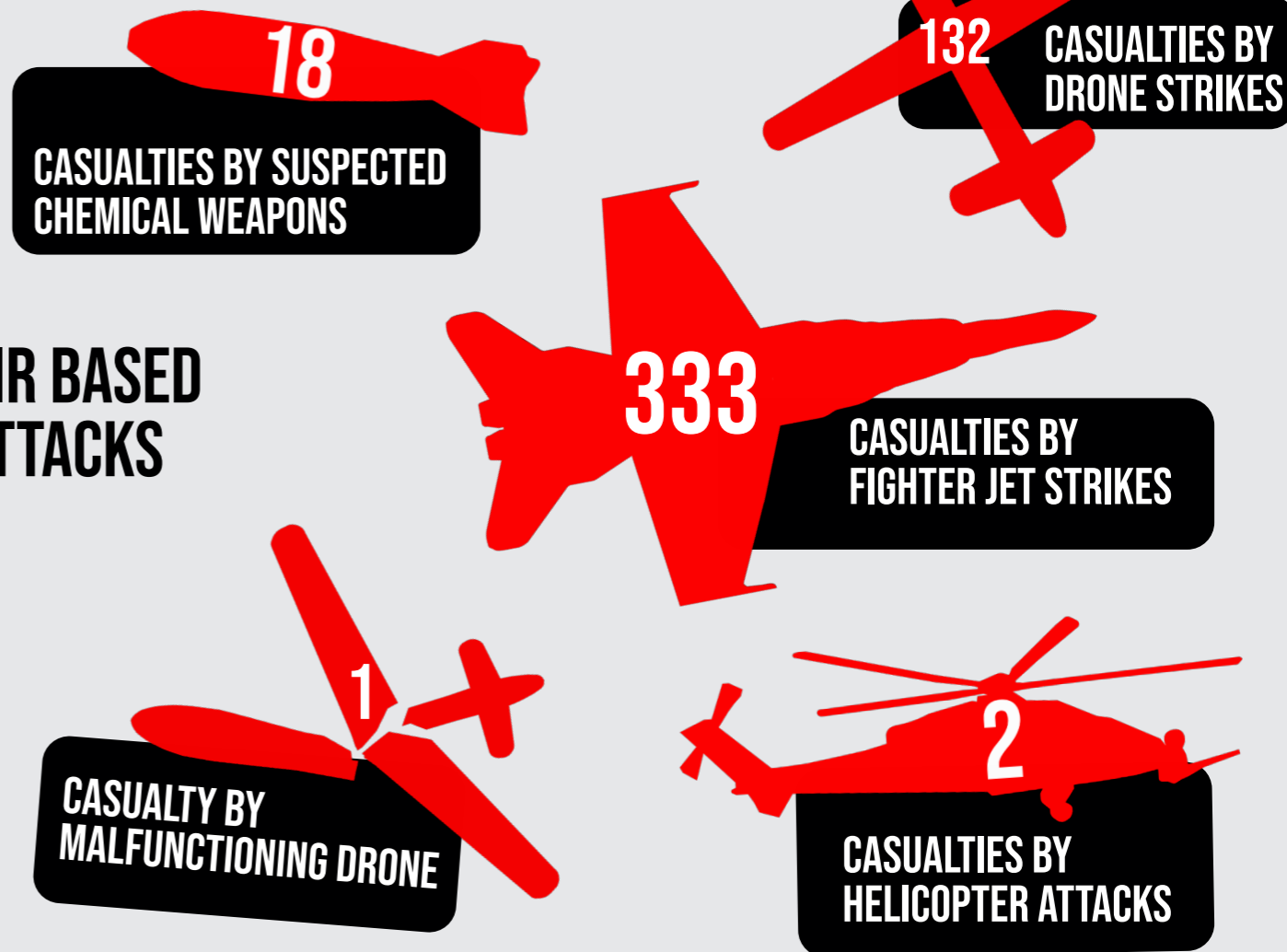
Kurdistan, particularly the series of 'Claw' operations, resulted in 39% of civilian casualties since 1991.

The Turkish military states that it conducts its military operations to fight against various Kurdish armed non-state groups, including the Kurdistan Workers Party (PKK) and its affiliates, such as the Party of Free Life in Kurdistan (PJAK), the Sinjar Resistance Unit (YBS), and the Yezidi Protection Force (HPE).

Between 2018 and 2024, Turkey's military operations and aggression inside Iraqi

3.1 TYPES OF ATTACK



AIR BASED ATTACKS

The leading cause of casualties for civilians in Iraqi Kurdistan by the Turkish Armed Forces has been bombardments by fighter jets, resulting in 333 casualties (174 killed and 159 injured), accounting for 47% of all casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces.

However, since 2015, drones have become the primary cause of civilian death and injury. Since 2015, 40% of total casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces (TAF) were caused by drone strikes, totaling 132 casualties (72 killed and 60 injured). This shift coincides with the development and manufacturing of the Bayraktar TB2 drone, which was first tested for its precision-strike capabilities in 2014 and subsequently

deployed. Its first verified use, causing civilian casualties, occurred in 2015 in Zargaly village in the Qandil mountains, resulting in 18 civilian casualties, marking the first civilian casualties since the ceasefire between the PKK and the Turkish state.

Aerial operations account for 69% of casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces, totaling 484 casualties, with 243 killed and 241 injured.

These casualties include:

- 333 by fighter jets (174 killed and 159 injured)¹
- 132 by drones (60 killed and 72 injured)
- 18 casualties by suspected chemical weapons (9 killed and

- 9 injured)
- 2 casualties by attacks from helicopters (2 injured)
- 1 casualty by a malfunctioned drone falling into a home (1 injured)

Turkish drone operations represent an escalation of military activities deeper south into Iraqi Kurdistan. Drone strikes have killed civilians as far south as Nalparez, approximately 210 kilometers away from the border, while also striking members of the PKK in populated areas as far south as Kalar, approximately 280 kilometers away from the Turkish border.

LAND BASED ATTACKS



Land operations account for 31% of casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces, totaling 216 casualties, with 101 killed and 115 injured.

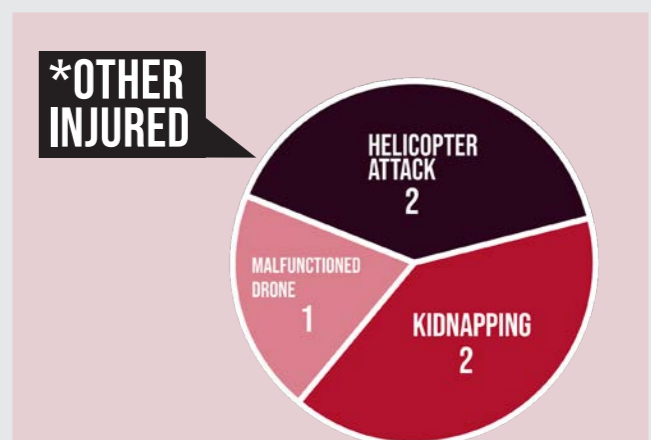
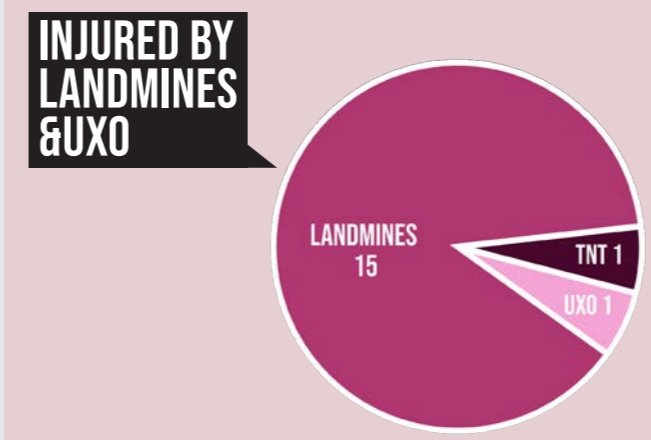
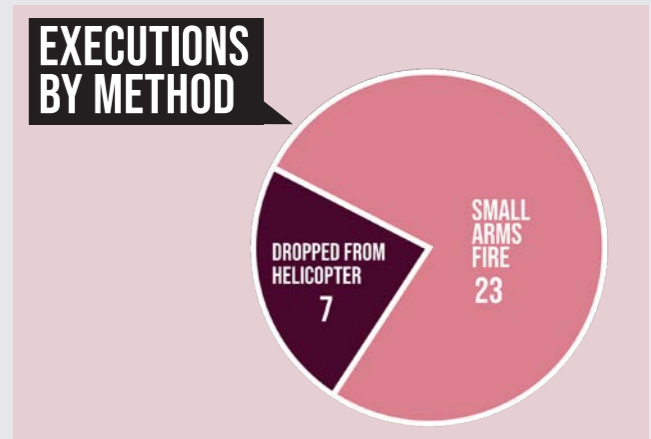
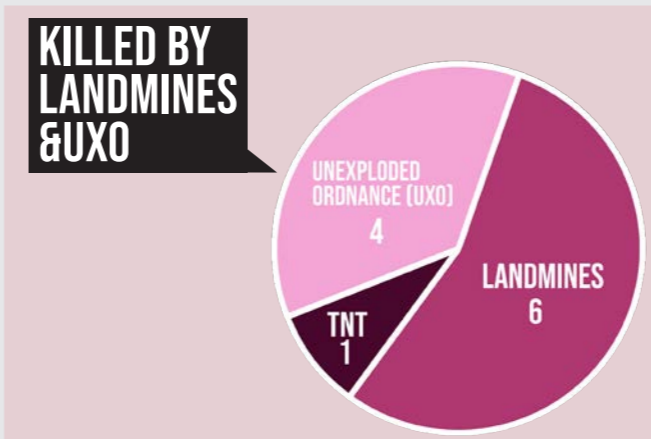
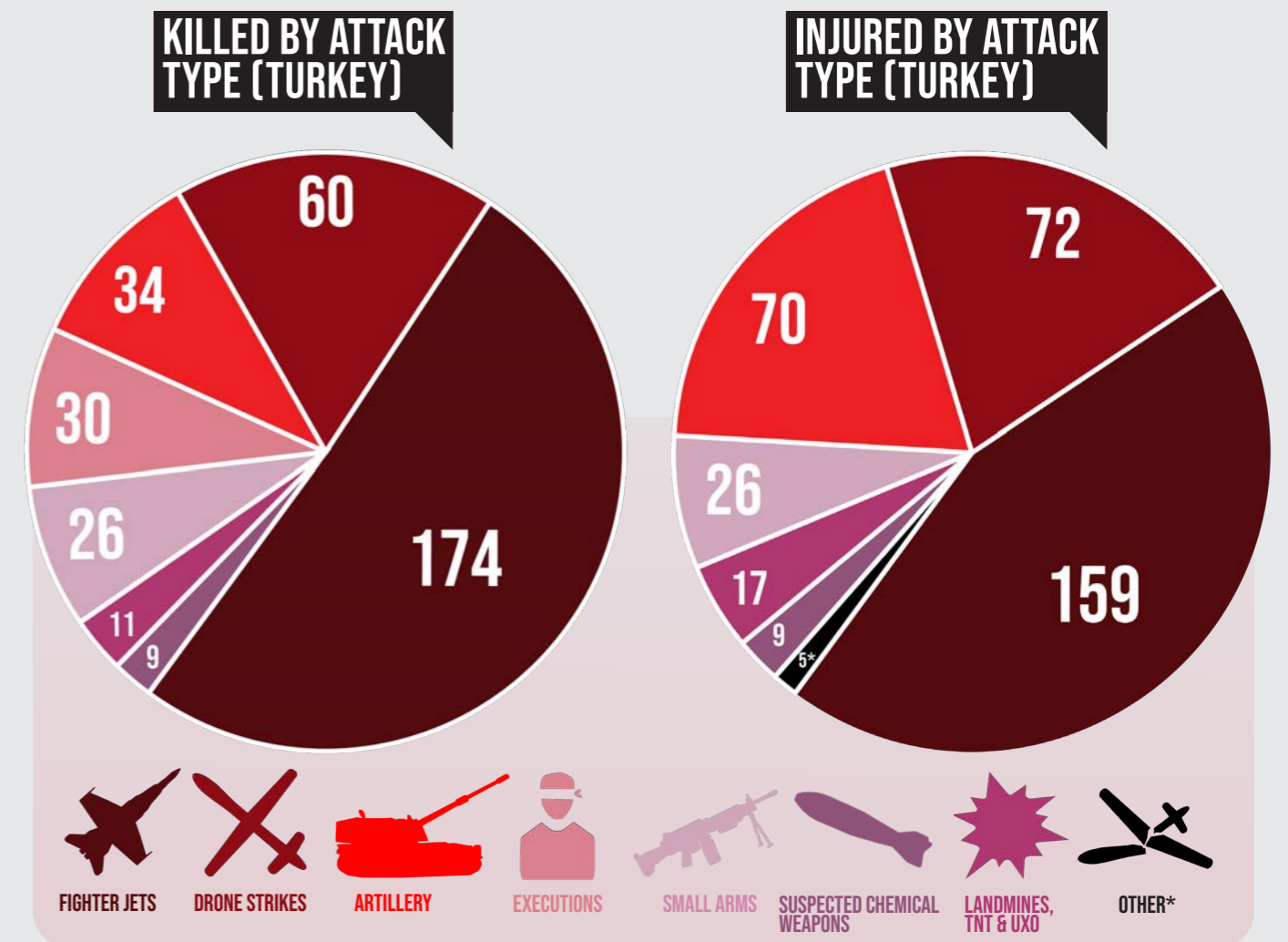
These casualties include:

- 104 casualties by artillery shellings (34 killed and 70 injured)
- 52 casualties by light weapons fire from military bases (26 killed and 26 injured)
- 30 casualties by execution (30 killed)
- 28 casualties by Explosive Ordnance (11 killed and 17 injured)

Explosive ordnance includes 21 casualties caused by landmines (6 killed and 15 injured), 5 casualties caused by unexploded ordnance (4 killed and 1 injured) and 2 casualties caused by TNT (1 killed and 1 injured).

- 2 casualties by kidnapping (2 injured)

Civilians living, working, and performing recreational activities near Turkish military bases are often subject to light weapons fire and artillery shelling while also being endangered by landmines that are planted within proximity of Turkish bases.



3.2 INTENTIONAL TARGETING OF CIVILIANS

The analysis of the data collected for the report reveals a grave concern over the Turkish Armed Forces' pattern of intentionally targeting civilians and civilian infrastructure, as well as their negligence in military operations that impact civilians, civilian life, and populated areas.

The Turkish military has constructed 74 military bases and outposts within Iraqi Kurdistan's border regions with Turkey: 56 in the Zakho and Amedi areas, and 18 in Mergasor and Sidakan. To assert control and dominance over certain areas, Turkey uses these bases as operational hubs for ground missions. The Turkish military utilizes its bases inside Iraqi Kurdistan to coerce the indigenous population into compliance. The Turkish Armed Forces also utilize extensive aircraft bombardments, artillery shellings, and light weapons discharges in their military campaigns, targeting both densely populated areas, civilian infrastructure, and rural regions frequently utilized for agricultural activities.

Moreover, Turkish military positions, particularly in the Amedi district, have been encircled with landmines, causing significant harm to the local indigenous population, who heavily depend on the environment for farming, livestock rearing, and animal care. Aside from bombardments and light weapons fire, the Turkish Armed Forces will also incinerate farmland, deforest, and target civilians as a means to compel, coerce, or intimidate the indigenous population to depopulate, restrict access of movement, stop touristic activities, and stop

The highest casualty count in a single incident since 2015 occurred on July 20, 2022, with 34 casualties (9 killed and 25 injured) due to artillery shelling in the popular tourist destination of Parakhe. Parakhe, located in the Zakho district, is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Iraqi Kurdistan, with many from Central and Southern Iraq coming for picnics and recreational activities. A nearby Turkish

engaging in agricultural activities. Overall, these actions have led to the displacement of thousands of people from more than 170 villages, with another 602 at risk, disrupted socioeconomic activities and cultural practices, and hindered agricultural and tourism industries. These military campaigns continue to target civilians and villages that have decided to remain, with casualties even occurring when civilians return to their abandoned villages or ancestral lands for agricultural purposes.

With the expulsion of civilians, Turkey has built extensive military road networks and expanded its base of operations, gaining control over the overwhelming majority of border territory in Iraqi Kurdistan. The Turkish military has also deforested areas near the border, such as Haftanin, Berway Bala, and Nerwa Rekan. In one particular area called Bermiza in the Sidakan sub-district, the northeasternmost sub-district of Iraqi Kurdistan, it has become highly restricted to enter due to the presence of the Turkish military. In that area, Turkey has installed its own telecommunications towers and equipment, censoring most Kurdish-language media and replacing it with Turkish-language media, representing a form of cultural assimilation. The presence of telecommunications towers in Iraqi Kurdistan causes significant disruption to the local networks, resulting in a considerable challenge for residents to communicate with one another using Kurdish and Iraqi SIM cards.

base bombarded the tourist area with artillery shelling at least twice, resulting in the casualties of 34 people, including three children. The Turkish military has targeted and hindered numerous tourist areas, leading to a drastic reduction in tourist activity in not just Parakhe but many places across Iraqi Kurdistan.

TARGETING REFUGEE CAMPS

Underscoring the tactic of targeting civilians are the 32 casualties (14 killed and 18 injured) in refugee camps inside Iraqi Kurdistan. Anti-Kurdish violence and Turkish military operations depopulated Kurdish villages in southern Turkey in the early 1990s, forcing refugees to flee south to Iraqi Kurdistan. Many refugees settled a refugee camp in the Pishdar district in the 1990s, culminating in an incident

on January 28, 1994, which killed many refugees. In 1998, the Makhmur refugee camp was created about 60 kilometers south west of Erbil, and all refugees from southern Turkey relocated there. Drone strikes and fighter jets routinely target the camp, and its near-complete inaccessibility complicates the verification of civilian casualties, increasing the risk of underreporting.

PURPOSELY STRIKING COMBATANTS AND CIVILIANS TOGETHER

There is also concern about the intentional targeting of civilians with drones, especially considering the high-precision capability of the Bayraktar drones. Numerous verified incidents indicate that Turkish drones, while following PKK combatants and visible in the sky, waited to target PKK vehicles and/or combatants until they were adjacent to or in close proximity to civilians. Drone strikes have also targeted civilians and vehicles in areas where there has been no PKK presence.

For example, on June 27, 2019, a Turkish armed drone followed two vehicles moving along a mountain road in the Pishdar district. One of these was a civilian pickup truck carrying a family of

eight returning to their hometown from their farmland, and the other was a vehicle carrying PKK members who were wounded in an earlier airstrike. The drone followed both vehicles for more than 45 minutes and waited to strike the PKK vehicle until it was adjacent to the civilian vehicle as it was trying to pass it. Shortly after striking both vehicles, the drone struck both vehicles again. This resulted in the deaths of 3 civilians and the injuries of 5, all belonging to the same family. Among the casualties, 1 child was killed and 2 were injured.

AUGUST 15, 2000: THE KANDAKOLAN MASSACRE

The largest verified incident of casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces occurred on August 15, 2000, in the Sidakan district in an area called Kandakolan, resulting in 43 total casualties. Fighter jets directly targeted the encampment twice with bombardments, with the second coming minutes later, resulting in the deaths of thirty civilians and the injuries of thirteen others. The encampment was large and widely known to be home to the indigenous nomadic people and had no direct relationship, affiliation, or presence with the PKK. Of the casualties, 56% were children, with 15 children killed and 9 injured, representing an alarmingly high rate of child casualties. Furthermore, the incident claimed the lives of two pregnant women who were nearing the end of their pregnancies. Survivors of the incident also provided eyewitness testimony to CPT that, after the bombardments, two helicopters simultaneously poured acid into the area of the bombardment. As a result of the incident and Turkish military bombardments, the remaining nomadic families were

forced to immediately relocate, losing their animals, sources of livelihoods, land, and cultural practices and traditions.

Turkish military operations in Iraqi Kurdistan have deeply impacted indigenous nomadic communities. The Turkish Armed Forces have killed at least 47 nomadic people and injured 23 others, forcing them to relocate out of Sidakan, the area that has been home to the majority of Kurdish nomadic families for generations. The Turkish Armed Forces have targeted nomads in their encampments or while tending to their animals. The result has been a drastic reduction and almost complete dissipation of nomadic activity, severely impacting the livelihoods of nomads, who are primarily shepherds or farmers, and the nomadic way of life, which is deeply rooted in traditions and agriculture and tied to seasonal migration patterns. The Sidakan district is the second most impacted district in terms of casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces, with 123 total casualties (75 killed and 48 injured).

TARGETING OF FESTIVALS AND BURNING FARMLAND

Also emphasizing the point of intentional targeting of civilians are the cases of the Zewa Sari festival and Berwary Bala's farmland. Saddam Hussein's Anfal campaign originally displaced the people of Zewa Sari and other villages in Nerwa Rekan to Turkey in the 1980s. Following the Kurdish Uprising in 1991, the villagers wanted to return to the area, but the war between the PKK and Turkey had reached their area and prevented them from returning, forcing them to migrate and settle in Shiladze and surrounding populated areas. As part of Zewa Sari's cultural practices and traditions, the villagers gathered every year in the Bamarne sub-district for a reunion, featuring dancing,

playing ancestral games, sharing food, and more. On May 26, 2022, a mortar from a nearby Turkish military base struck the edge of the gathering, killing two children and severely injuring another child while they were playing football. The gathering and festivities have since stopped due to the incident. In the Berwary Bala area, CPT has verified cases of Turkish military soldiers descending from their bases, setting fire to farmland in village areas, thereby forcing local residents to relocate to more urban areas. This is representative of the situation in many villages throughout the border region.

EXECUTIONS

Two particularly concerning incidents involve executions carried out by the Turkish military. In a 1996 incident in Sidakan's Bardakashik highlands, the Turkish military arrested 12 labor workers and executed 11 of them, with one miraculously surviving. One body was found beheaded. In a separate incident in 1994, the Turkish military arrested seven civilians, including three children,

in Mergasor, took them by helicopter, and then dropped them from the sky, also known as death flights. Due to fear of retaliation and safety, families did not want to share any personal documentation about this incident. There are 30 verified cases of executions conducted by the Turkish military.

3.3 ACTIVITY DURING DEATH OR INJURY

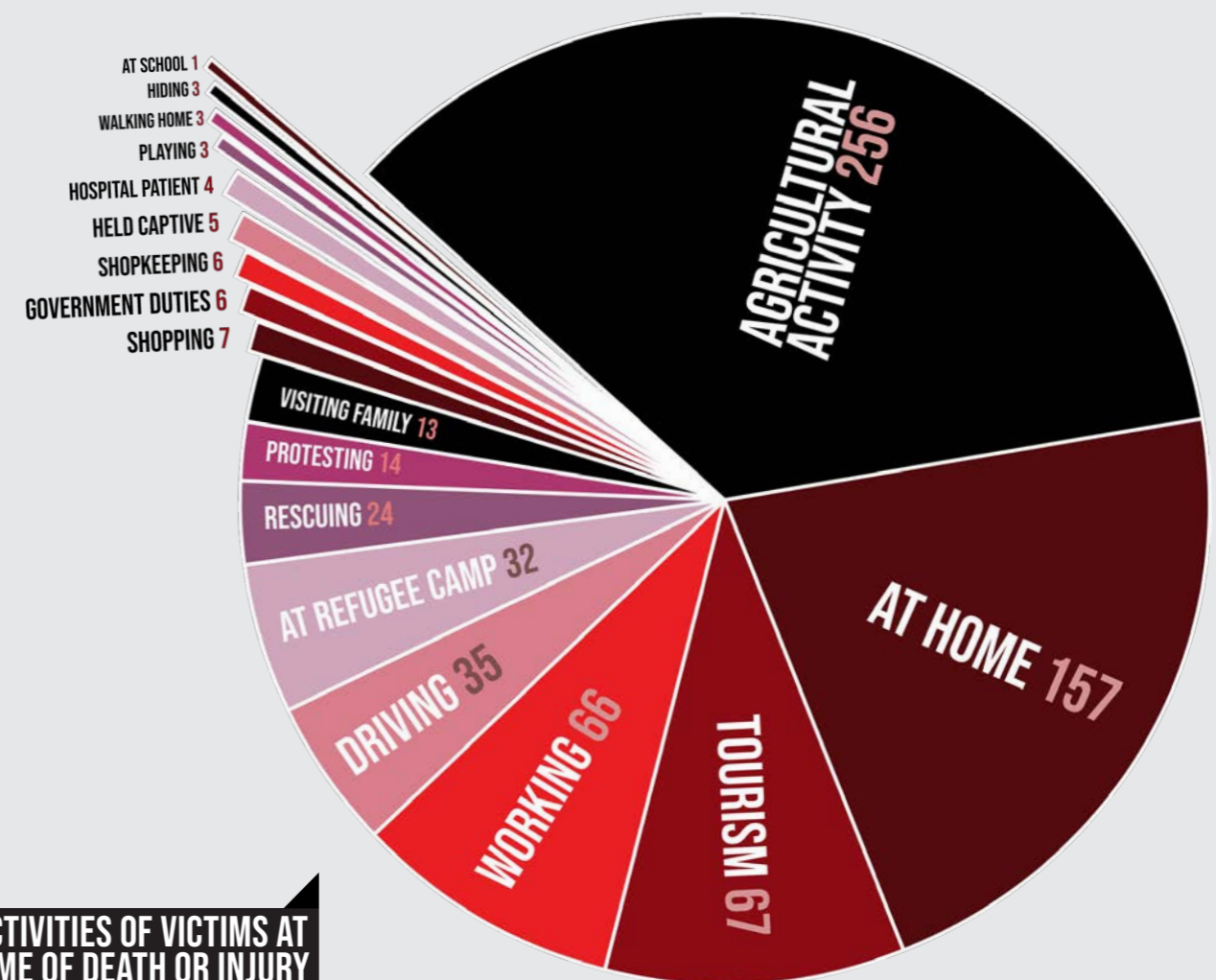
The four primary activities civilian casualties were undertaking when killed or injured were agriculture, being home, working, and tourism. 36% of casualties were when civilians were performing agriculture (143 killed and 113 injured), 22% of casualties were as a result of being at home (59 killed and 98 injured), 9% of casualties were when civilians were on tourism (32 killed and 35 injured), and 9% of casualties were when civilians were working (42 killed and 24 injured).

Agricultural activities consist of civilians farming, shepherding, foraging wild plants, beekeeping, fishing, and tending to animals. From casualties related to agriculture, 12% of casualties occurred when civilians were farming (29 killed and 53 injured), 10% of casualties were when performing nomadic activities (47 killed and 23 injured), 7% of

casualties were when civilians were tending to animals (29 killed and 22 injured), 5% of casualties were when civilians were foraging wild plants (20 killed and 13 injured), 1% of casualties were when civilians were beekeeping (10 killed), and another 1% of casualties were when civilians were fishing (8 killed and 2 injured).

The high number of civilian casualties in agriculture is concerning. Civilians perform agriculture in a wide range of settings, including urban areas, populated areas, mountainous regions, near bodies of water, highlands, and more. Agriculture is the primary source of income for many residents inside Iraqi Kurdistan.

5% of casualties occurred when civilians were in refugee camps, totaling 32 casualties (14 killed and 18 injured). The Makhmur refugee camp has been the site of

all refugee casualties, with some of these incidents taking place during the camp's 1990s location in the Pishdar district, prior to its relocation near Erbil.

5% of casualties were when civilians were traveling by vehicle (25 killed and 10 injured). Drone strikes caused 54% of the vehicular casualties, resulting in a total of 19 casualties (12 killed and 7 injured), highlighting the intentional targeting of civilian vehicles and/or the negligence in properly identifying combatant vehicles from civilian ones.

Notably, 3% of casualties occurred when civilians were trying to rescue civilians harmed by a previous bombardment, only to be then struck themselves (6 killed and 18 injured). 2% of casualties occurred during protests (1 killed and 14 injured). On January 23, 2019, 6 civilians were killed after Turkey conducted multiple aerial bombardments in the Amedi region, Shiladze. Soon after, the Turkish military operations in the area sparked protests. Families of martyrs from both Deraluk and Shiladze participated in the protests. The protest was held outside the Turkish military base in Siri located inside

Shiladze and Turkish soldiers fired into the demonstrations, causing 15 casualties.

2% of civilians were visiting relatives (6 killed and 7 injured). 1% of civilians were shopping at the time of the incident (1 killed and 6 injured). 1% of civilians were performing a governmental service, such as administrative work, at the time of the incident (3 killed and 3 injured). 1% of civilians were shopkeeping (2 killed and 4 injured). 1% of casualties were civilians that were being held captive by the PKK when they were killed after Turkey conducted an operation on Gara Mountain, bombarding the caves where the captives were being held, which also included eight captive Turkish soldiers. Less than 1% of civilians were hospital patients at the time of the incident (4 injured), walking home (2 killed and 1 injured), children that were playing (2 killed and 1 injured), individuals that were hiding or fleeing from bombardments (1 killed and 2 injured), and children studying at school (1 injured).

Kurdistan regional government's armed forces, while government employees are defined as people working in the government administratively or as technicians.

Due to the economic situation in Iraqi Kurdistan, it is very common for citizens to engage in more than one job aside from their main occupation. Since the financial crisis of 2014, there has been a perpetual delay in the payment of salaries, especially for government employees, including Peshmerga forces. Thus, teachers, Peshmerga, and other government employees are forced to engage in other occupations such as labor, farming, animal husbandry, etc. For instance, the majority of casualties among Peshmerga soldiers occurred during their engagement in agricultural activities, resulting in 31 casualties, representing 48% of all Peshmerga casualties who were in civilian status at the time of the incident.

14% of casualties were civilians with women working at home, totaling 100 casualties (40 killed and 60 injured). 13% of casualties were civilians with occupations as workers, totaling 90 casualties

(64 killed and 26 injured). 9% of casualties were civilians who worked as Peshmerga soldiers, totaling 65 casualties (49 killed and 16 injured). 8% of casualties were unemployed at the time of the incident, totaling 56 casualties (29 killed and 28 injured). 4% of casualties were civilians who were retired Peshmerga, totaling 30 casualties (5 killed and 25 injured). 4% of casualties were shepherds, totaling 27 casualties (20 killed and 7 injured).

4% of casualties were farmers, totaling 26 casualties (14 killed and 12 injured). 2% of casualties were students who were studying in university, totaling 11 casualties (5 killed and 6 injured). 1% of casualties were government employees, totaling 9 casualties (6 killed and 3 injured), shopkeepers, totaling 7 casualties (3 killed and 4 injured), and retirees, totaling 7 casualties (7 injured). Less than 1% of casualties were civilians who were captive prisoners (5 killed), medical staff (4 killed and 1 injured), civilians engaged in animal husbandry (1 killed and 2 injured), NGO staff (3 injured),

police officers (2 killed and 1 injured), beekeepers (2 killed), professional football players (2 injured), businessmen (1 killed), journalists (1 injured), lawyers (1 killed), religious leaders (1 injured), and village chieftains (1 killed).

Children represent 28% of total casualties, totaling 79 killed and 115 injured. Children often engage in various occupations to financially support their households. While attending school, children may also be workers, shopkeepers, shepherds, farmers, and more. Notably, 34% of child casualties, totaling 66 casualties, occurred while children were at home, while 33% of child casualties, totaling 64 casualties, occurred while children were engaged in agricultural-related activities such as farming or shepherding.

44 families and civilians (11 killed and 33 injured) chose not to disclose any information about the victims' occupations due to a fear of safety.

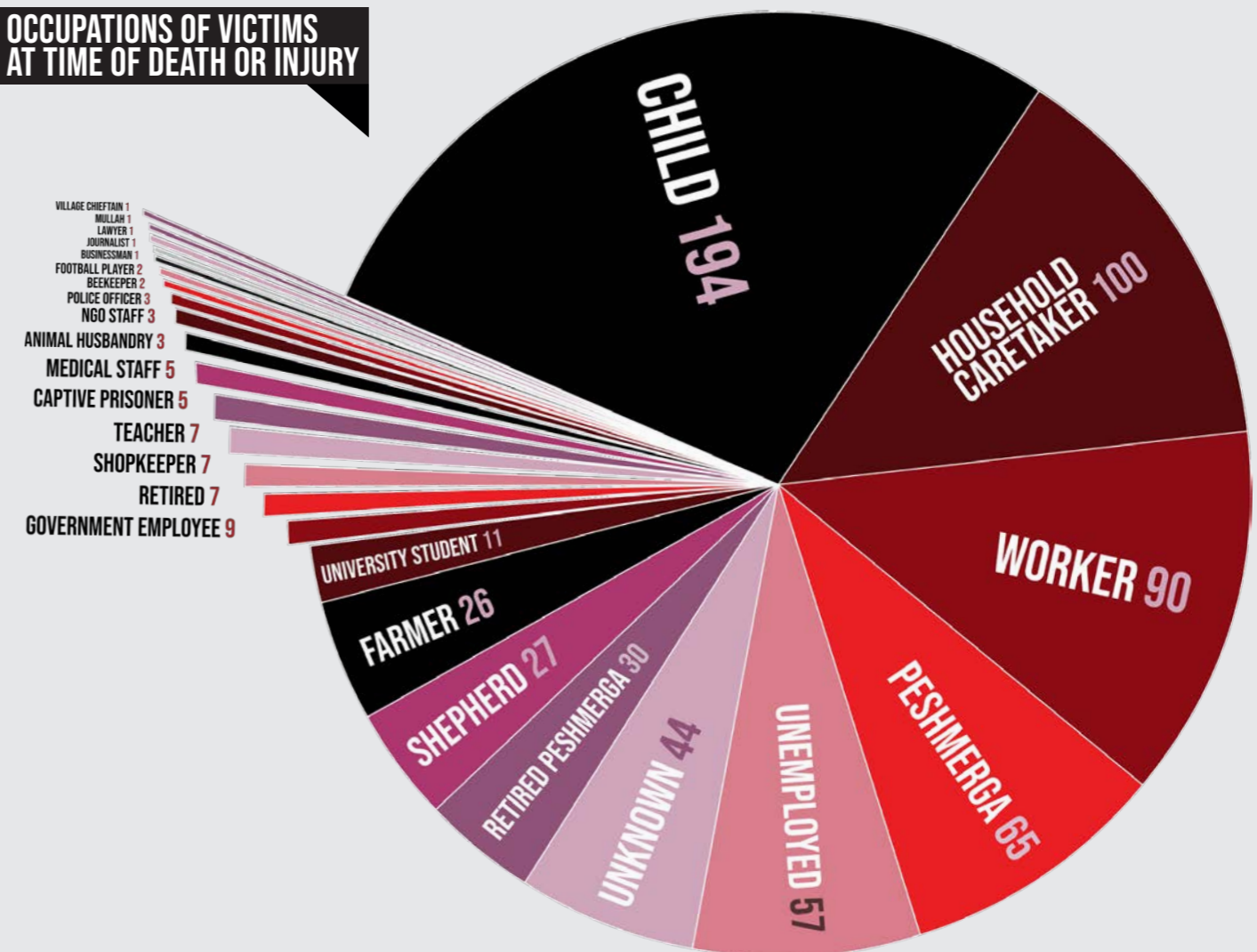
3.4 OCCUPATION OF VICTIMS

The four most impacted employment categories were women who were working at home, workers, Peshmerga military soldiers, and people who were unemployed at the time of the incident.

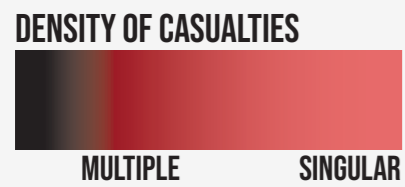
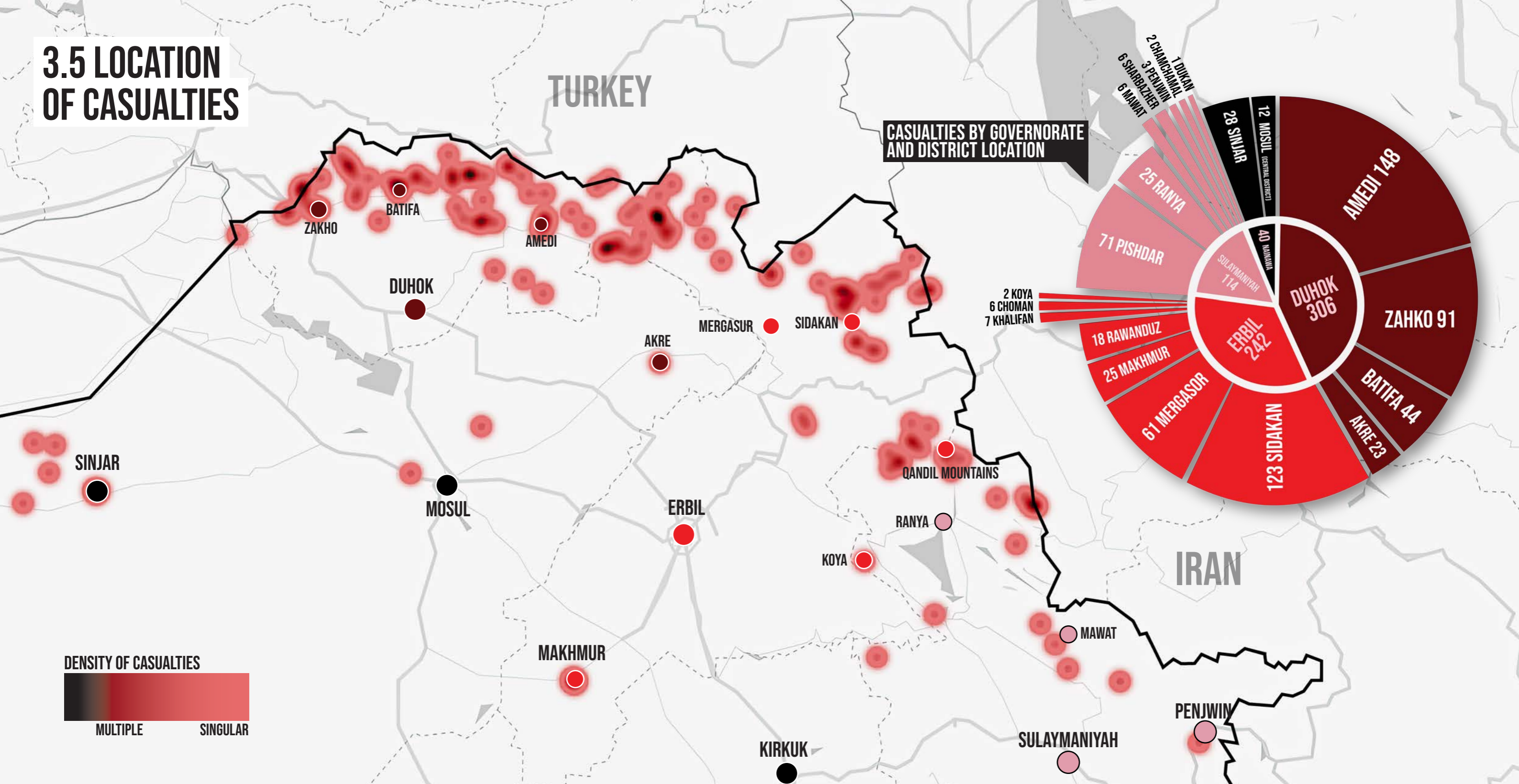
Women working from home are defined as women whose primary role involves performing household duties and caring for the family. The working conditions in Iraqi Kurdistan necessitate reliance on temporary employment. As a result, the occupation of workers is primarily defined by engagements in trading, caravanning, labor, driving, and construction. Economic circumstances compel villagers and individuals with low socioeconomic status to seek temporary employment in one of these fields, often requiring them to move from place to place. Furthermore, to accurately reflect the economic and employment landscape, jobs such as shopkeeping or teaching are categorized separately due to their stability and stationary nature.

The occupation of Peshmerga is defined as being part of the

3.5 LOCATION OF CASUALTIES



Iraqi Kurdistan divides its territory into four governorates: Erbil, Sulaymaniyah, Duhok, and Halabja. Also included in this report is the governorate of Ninewa. Ninewa is technically part of the Iraqi federal government, but certain parts of Ninewa are disputed territory between the Kurdistan Regional Government and the Iraqi federal government. After the Yazidian genocide in 2014, the YBS, also known as the Sinjar Resistance Units, became the de facto ruling military group in the area. The Turkish Armed Forces have consistently

targeted the Shengal area as well as the broader Ninewa governorate, resulting in many civilian casualties. Individuals who were members of the YBS were not considered verified casualties for the purposes of this report, as the YBS is an armed non-state actor and considered a belligerent actor in the war between the PKK and Turkey.

The Duhok governorate accounted for 44% of total casualties, comprising 306 casualties (151 killed and 155 injured). The Erbil governorate

represented 34% of total casualties, with 242 casualties (129 killed and 113 injured). The Sulaymaniyah governorate accounted for 16% of total casualties, totaling 114 casualties (51 killed and 63 injured). The Nainawa governorate had 6% of total casualties, with 40 casualties (13 killed and 27 injured).

In terms of casualties by the Turkish Armed Forces, the Amedi and Sidakan districts were the most impacted by the Turkish Armed Forces, accounting for 39% of total casualties. The

Amedi district accounted for 22% of casualties, including 148 casualties (90 killed and 58 injured).

The Amedi district is the most impacted region in Iraqi Kurdistan. The district borders Turkey and Iraqi Kurdistan for most of its length. It is also the region where the most armed conflict between the PKK and Turkey takes place, with most of the Turkish military bases located in Amedi. Aerial operations, such as drone strikes and fighter jet bombardments, caused 59% of

civilian casualties in Amedi, while land operations, such as light weapons fire from military bases and artillery shelling, caused 41%. The majority of casualties, 40%, occurred when civilians were engaged in agriculture, with the second most, 12%, occurring when civilians were involved in touristic activities.

Large portions of Amedi are inaccessible even to local authorities. In the Amedi district, especially in the mountainous regions of Avashin and Zap, the Turkish military occupies 82 out of 92 villages, completely displacing

the villagers from the 82 occupied villages.

The Sidakan district is the second-most-impacted region in terms of casualties in Iraqi Kurdistan. It has been the target of intense bombings by fighter jets, and many of its parts are also inaccessible due to the presence of the Turkish military. Sidakan is the northeasternmost district in Iraqi Kurdistan, which borders Turkey. It is the first region where Turkey built military bases for its series of 'Claw' operations and is home to most of the Iraqi Kurdish

indigenous nomadic people. Turkish fighter jets caused 67% of the casualties in Sidakan, totaling 82 casualties. 60% of casualties occurred when civilians were conducting agricultural activities, with the majority of this activity being nomadic.

In terms of sub-districts, the Sidakan Central Subdistrict, belonging to the Sidakan district, had the largest percentage of casualties, accounting for 17% of the total casualties, with 122 in total (74 killed and 48 injured). The Shiladze sub-district, belonging to the Amedi district, represented 10% of total casualties, with 69 in total (39 killed and 30 injured). The Darkar sub-district, belonging to the Zakho district, accounted for 7% of total casualties, with 51 in total (14 killed and 37 injured). The Sangasar sub-district, belonging to the Pishdar district, had 6% of total casualties, with 36 in total (19 killed and 17 injured).

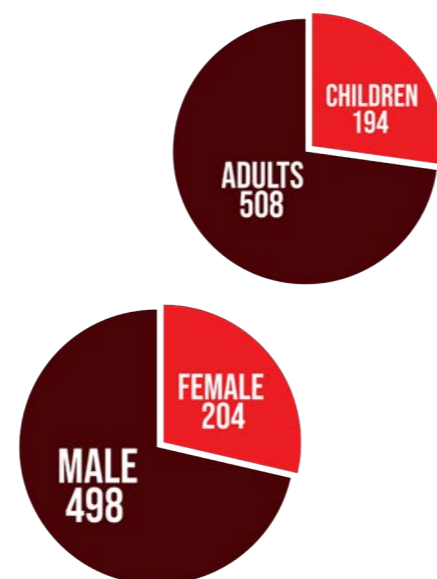
Overall, the Sidakan Central District, Shiladze, Darkar, and Sangasar sub-districts account for 40% of total casualties. Darkar, Shiladze, and Sidakan serve as the primary points of interest and ground hubs for Turkish military operations, as well as geographical links to create a buffer zone along the Iraqi-Turkish border. Consequently, Turkish military operations, both aerial and land, frequently target these sub-districts, imposing restricted access, military occupation, and forced displacement. The Qandil Mountains, the main headquarters of the PKK, are located in Sangasar, in the Pishdar district, explaining its high casualty rate.

The Zakho district accounted for 13% of casualties, including 91 casualties (36 killed and 55

Overall, Turkish military operations have resulted in 702 casualties, including 194 children. Among the child casualties, 79 children have been killed and 116 injured. Additionally, 278 adults have been killed and 247 injured, while 85 women have been killed and 119 injured. Notably, 36% of child casualties, totaling 70 casualties, occurred while children were at home, while 32% of child casualties, totaling 63 casualties, occurred while children were engaged in agricultural-related activities such as farming or shepherding.

injured). The Pishdar district accounted for 10% of casualties, totaling 71 casualties (32 killed and 39 injured). The Mergasor district accounted for 9% of casualties, totaling 61 casualties (30 killed and 31 injured). The Batifa district accounted for 6% of casualties, including 44 casualties (17 killed and 27 injured). The Sinjar district accounted for 4% of casualties, totaling 28 casualties (7 killed and 21 injured).

The Makhmur district also accounted for 4% of casualties that mostly includes the Makhmur refugee camp, totaling 25 casualties (7 killed and 18 injured). The Ranya district also accounted for 4% of casualties, totaling 25 casualties (11 killed and 14 injured). The Akre district accounted for 3% of total casualties, totaling 23 casualties (8 killed and 15 injured). The Rawanduz district also accounted for 3% of casualties, totaling 18 casualties (5 killed and 13 injured). The Mosul Central District accounted for 2% of casualties, totaling 12 casualties (6 killed and 6 injured). The Khalifan (5 killed and 2 injured), Choman (6 killed), Mawat (2 killed and 4 injured), Sharbazher (6 injured), Penjwen (3 killed), Chamchamal (2 killed), Koya (1 killed and 1 injured), and Dukan (1 killed) districts accounted for less than 1% of casualties.



3.7 'CLAW' OPERATIONS

At the end of 2017, Turkey initiated a series of 'Claw' operations aimed at fully securing the border regions of Iraqi Kurdistan, thereby creating a buffer zone between northeast Syria, also known as Rojava, and Iraq.

The series of 'Claw' operations includes Claw Operation, Claw Operation 1, Claw Operation 2, Claw-Eagle Operation, Claw-Tiger Operation, Claw Lightning Operation, Claw Thunderbolt Operation, and Claw-Lock Operation. Turkish Armed Forces have secured approximately 86% of the border region in Iraqi Kurdistan since the start of the 'Claw' operations, resulting in 105 civilian deaths and 169 injuries, totaling 274 casualties. In 2023, the total casualties reached their lowest point since the start of the 'Claw' operations, with 20 total casualties (11 killed and 9 injured).

However, this decline can be attributed to a reduction and pause in military activities due to the earthquake that occurred in southern and central Turkey in

early 2023 and the presidential election cycle.

In late 2024, it is expected for Turkey to resume 'Claw' operations to completely 'lock' the border region, specifically in the Gara Mountain area. The preparatory phase has already resulted in 9 casualties (8 killed and 1 injured). There is cause for concern that the resumption of Claw operations will result in a return to a similar rate of casualties as in previous years.

In June 2024, the Turkish Armed Forces resumed its 'Claw' operations to fully secure the border regions, lock the border, and gain control of Gara Mountain in southern Amedi. The preparatory phase of the operation in early 2024 resulted in 9 casualties (8 killed and 1 injured). The initial phase of the resumption of operations resulted in two casualties (1 killed and 1 injured), and the Matina mountain range, located in northern Amedi, is almost completely under Turkish military control.

3.8 CHEMICAL WEAPONS

CPT isn't an expert on chemical weapons. However, eyewitness testimony, photos and videos, the nature of injuries, and doctors' testimonies provide sufficient evidence to suggest the use of some type of chemical weapon in certain incidents. The specific type of chemical, its health and environmental implications, and the weaponry used have not been identified and should be investigated by an international party with expertise on the issue. The alleged use of chemical weapons led to nine civilian deaths and injuries, bringing the total to 18 civilian casualties and the deaths of 8 non-combatants.

Additionally, there are specific incidents, such as the aforementioned incident in Kandokolan,

that have broader implications for the use of chemical weapons on the environment, inhabited areas, and against non-state armed groups. Numerous survivors from Shiladze provided eyewitness testimony and images of injuries caused by barrel bombs filled with acid dropped from military aircraft in 1991.

Chemical weapons are very difficult to verify, and there is no organization or governmental entity to investigate alleged chemical weapons use in Iraqi Kurdistan. Due to the Turkish military presence there is restricted access to impacted areas and because of ongoing bombardments making it unsafe for any investigative party to enter.

3.9 CULTURAL IMPACT

A significant impact of Turkish military actions is the loss of cultural heritage. Numerous displaced civilians have been unable to go back, leading to significant cultural consequences, including the erosion of indigenous lifestyles. Urbanization disrupts tightly knit communities, resulting in the loss of not only economic livelihoods but also social relationships, community, festivities, and other cultural practices and traditions. For instance, certain

villages in the Kani Mase sub-district would venture to nearby mountains to celebrate Newroz, the Kurdish New Year. As part of a historical custom, they would celebrate for three consecutive days, maintaining a continuous fire. The construction of Turkish military bases halted these cultural practices due to the threat they posed from bombardments and other types of attacks.

During interviews conducted by CPT, displaced families frequently articulate a profound sense of cultural and communal deprivation, expressing that their only request is to return to their lands and resume their traditional ways of life. In places under Turkish military occupation, festivals, cultural traditions, and indigenous ways of life either cease to exist or gradually disappear from practice.

In addition, whenever Turkey seizes control of an area, it deliberately targets historical places such as castles, ancient sites, and other historically significant locations to construct its bases. For example, when Turkey launched the Claw Lightning operation in 2021 in Berway Bala, the Turkish Armed Forces first seized control of Qumry Castle, located between Hrure and Qumry village in Kani Mase. The castle, built more than 1800 years ago, became their first military base in Berway Bala.

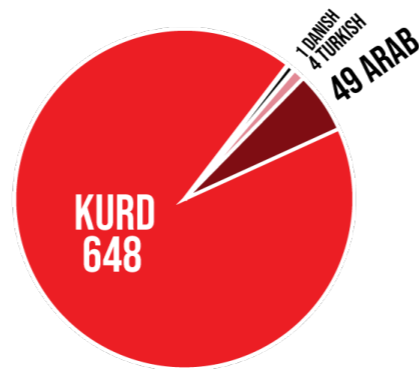
The presence of Turkish military outposts and the frequent bombardments they carry out have had a negative impact on the tourism industry. Specifically, tourism has experienced a major reduction in regions along the border and in places that have been targeted by these bombardments. The number of such incidents that occur each year directly correlates with the decline in tourism. In addition, the

Turkish military employs specific strategies aimed at undermining trust among individuals, communities, social relationships, and the community, all of which are the fabric of Kurdish society. Rumors are disseminated that local civilians are providing coordinates for areas under bombardment, thereby undermining and eroding trust within communities.

In the Bermiza subdistrict, which is a part of the Sidakan district, civilians often engage in discussions over the impact of Turkish censorship on Kurdish media. This censorship has led to a situation where the younger generation of Kurdish children is unable to speak Kurdish fluently but can speak in Turkish. The new generation of children engage extensively on digital platforms for language consumption and learning, thus impacting their ability to speak their native tongue. Generally, Turkish military activities have resulted in cultural degradation in different communities across Iraqi Kurdistan and pose a danger to others.

3.10 ETHNICITY

Of the 702 total casualties, 92% were of Kurdish ethnicity, totaling 648 (321 killed and 327 injured). 7% of casualties were civilians of Arab ethnicity, totaling 49 (18 killed and 31 injured). The remaining 1% of casualties were civilians of other ethnicities, including 4 Turkish civilians (4 killed) and 1 Danish (1 killed).



The vehicle of Dlovan Shahin destroyed by a Turkish drone missile in 2020. He was travelling from Batifa to Sarsing subdistrict to visit his mother-in-law. Dilvan had stopped to talk to a friend in Hassan Pirik village when the missile struck. Both were killed.

IV. IRANIAN MILITARY OPERATIONS



TOTAL CIVILIAN CASUALTIES CAUSED BY IRANIAN MILITARY OPERATIONS IN NORTHERN IRAQ, 1 JANUARY 1991 TO 30 JUNE 2024

Community Peacemaker Teams (CPT) verified 143 civilian casualties (81 killed and 62 injured) as a result of Iranian military operations inside Iraqi Kurdistan that occurred between January 1, 1991, and June 30, 2024.

Since the Iran-Iraq war ended in 1988, Iran has continued cross-border military operations. Casualties inflicted by Iran have remained consistent over the years, but 1994 marked the deadliest year for civilians, accounting for 43% of the casualties (38 killed and 23 injured). Land operations caused 93% of the casualties, while aerial operations accounted for only 7%.

Since 2013, Iran has constructed at least 151 military bases along the Iraqi-Iranian border, mostly in the Choman region, resulting in civilian casualties and displacement due to bombardments and shootings from these bases. Artillery shelling has caused

78% of total casualties. The highest percentage of civilian casualties occurred when victims were at home or conducting agricultural-related activities, accounting for 54%.

The Iranian military states that it conducts its military operations to fight against various armed non-state Kurdish opposition groups, including the Kurdistan Democratic of Iranian Kurdistan (KDP-I), the Democratic Party of Iranian Kurdistan-Révolution Leader Wings, the Kurdistan's Organization for the Communist Party of Iran (Komala CPI), the Kurdistan Free Life Party (PJAK), the Komala Party of Iranian Kurdistan, the Kurdistan Freedom Party (PAK), and other similar groups.

Recently, IRGC has conducted strikes on Iraqi Kurdistan using the excuse of targeting alleged Israeli intelligence sites inside the Erbil governorate.

4.1 TYPES OF ATTACK

The leading cause of casualties for civilians in Iraqi Kurdistan by Iranian military operations has been artillery shelling, resulting in 111 casualties (63 killed and 48 injured), accounting for 78% of all casualties.

- 111 casualties by artillery shelling (63 killed and 48 injured)
- 19 casualties by shootings at military bases (13 killed and 6 injured)
- 10 casualties by drones (5 killed and 5 injured)
- 3 casualties by explosive ordnance (3 injured). (Explosive ordnance includes: 3 casualties by landmines (3 injured))

Casualties are predominantly concentrated in populated areas such as villages and towns situated close to the Iranian

border. Furthermore, Iran has significantly expanded its military presence along the border, as evidenced by the construction of numerous new military bases, most notably in the Choman region.

Civilians have testified that Iranian soldiers regularly shoot at shepherds and steal animals from villages and grazing areas near their bases. New Iranian military outposts in the Choman region have also planted landmines in areas immediately surrounding their bases in Iraqi Kurdistan, causing danger and casualties to residents living nearby.



4.2 WOMEN AND CHILDREN

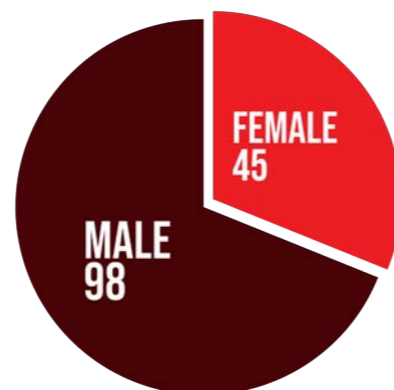
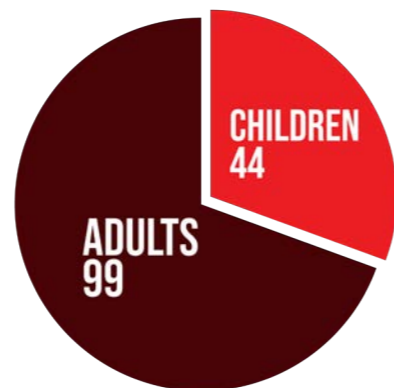
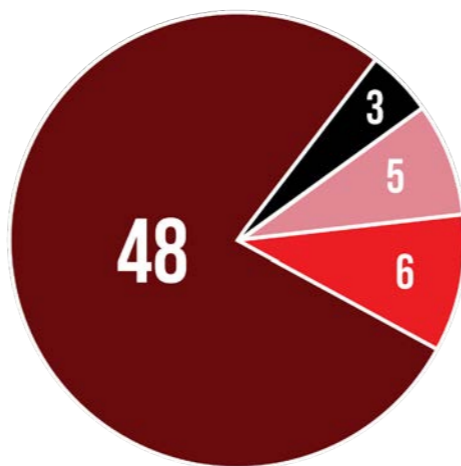
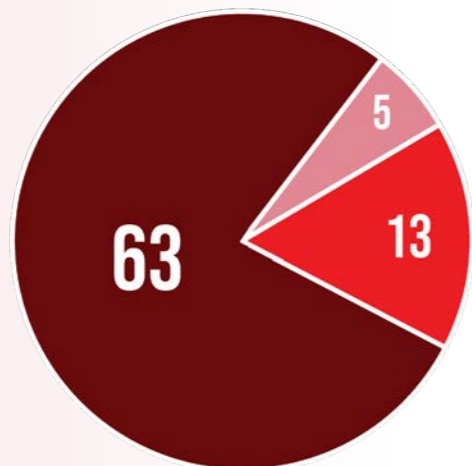
Overall, Iranian military operations have resulted in 143 civilian casualties, including 44 children. Child casualties constitute 31% of all casualties. Among the child casualties, 28 have been killed and 16 injured. Additionally, among the 99 adult casualties, 26 women have been killed and 19 injured, totaling 45 casualties. 43% of the child casualties occurred when the children were fleeing or hiding from Iranian bombardments.



Ali was severely injured by an Iranian bombardment in July 2019 while working on his family's farm in the Barbezin area. His sister, Zeitun, was killed in the attack with his brother, Sirwan also wounded. Doctors retrieved 16 pieces of shrapnel from Ali's body.

4.3 TARGETING OF CIVILIANS

THE QALADZE MASSACRE

The incident with the highest number of casualties occurred on August 6, 1994. 21 people were killed and 7 injured by an Iranian artillery bombardment on the city of Qaladze, 28 kilometers from the Iranian border. These civilians had sought refuge in their basements due to ongoing Iranian shelling of the city during the Kurdish Civil War. They were killed and injured by a single artillery shell landing in a courtyard they had all collected in after emerging from their shelters. Among the 21 civilians killed, 16 were children, and among the 7 injured, 5 were children. This incident underscores the civilian impact of Iranian military bases, the reach of Iranian artillery as well as the devastating effects artillery has on dense civilian areas.

TARGETING FARMERS IN BARBEZIN HIGHLANDS

On July 19, 2019, Iranian artillery bombarded the Barbezin area, of the Sidakan district, for over an hour. During this time, one civilian was killed and two injured, including one child. All the casualties were siblings, and were at home working on their family's cucumber and tomato fields, while the rest of the family attended a funeral in a nearby town. While there were some members of the KDP-I in the Barbezin mountain region, they did not occupy

positions near the family's farm or in other civilian-populated areas. The bombardment did not result in the death or injury of any KDP-I members. This incident highlights negligence in targeting and the potential deliberate targeting of civilians by artillery shelling in populated rural and agricultural areas.

STRIKES ON ERBIL

On January 15, 2024, while Iranian ballistic missiles were targeting the suburbs of Erbil, the capital of Iraqi Kurdistan, Iranian drones targeted a civilian house in the same area. The attack resulted in nine casualties, (4 killed and 5 injured), five people from the same family including two children, three houseworkers from the Philippines, and a guest from the United Arab Emirates.

Iran alleged that the house served as a base for the Mossad, the Israeli state intelligence agency, without providing any evidence. This incident marked a bold shift in the willingness of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps to target civilians in densely populated urban areas with aerial operations.

4.4 ACTIVITY DURING DEATH OR INJURY

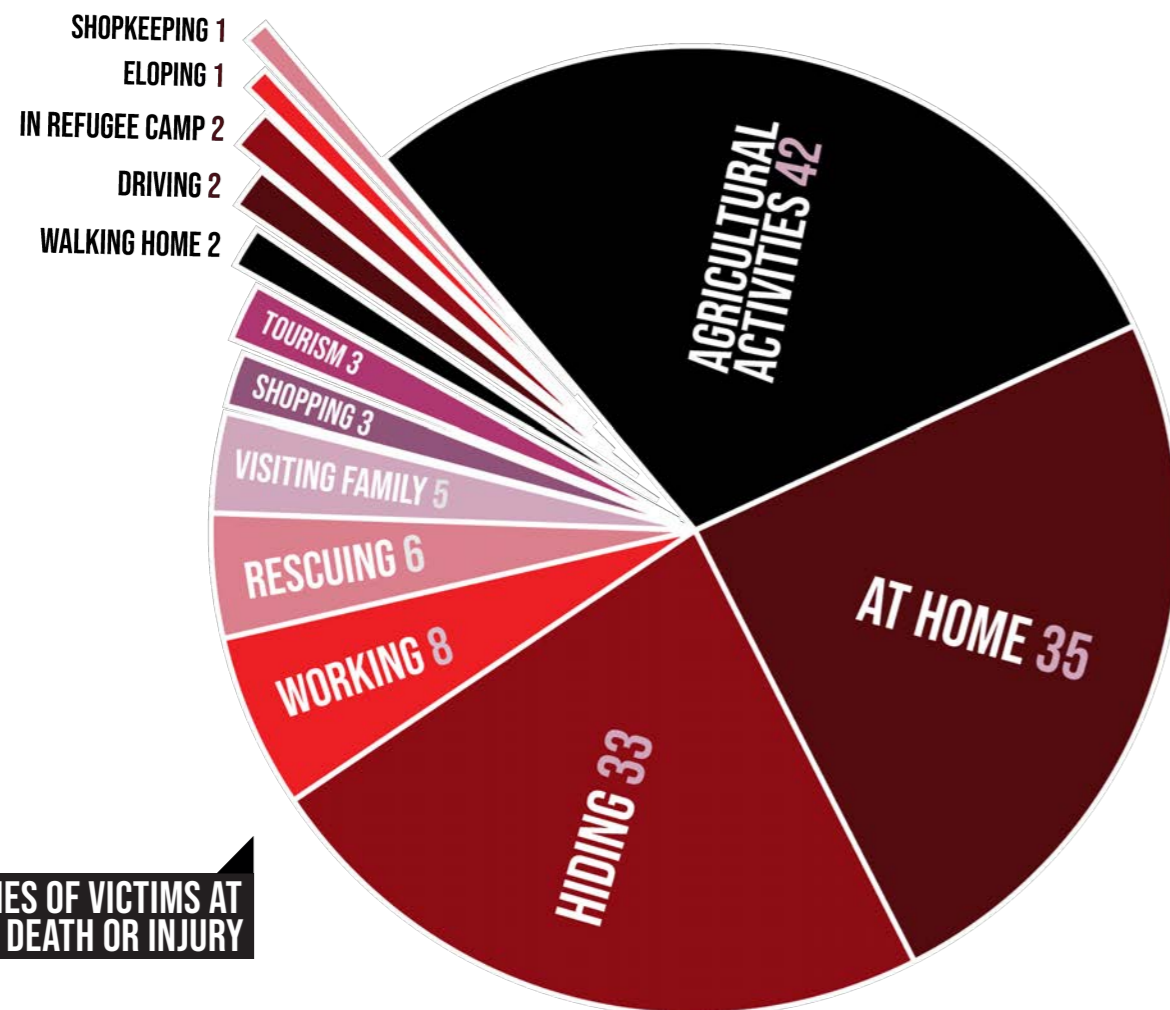
Civilian casualties were killed or injured in three main activities: agriculture, being at home, and hiding or fleeing from bombardments. 29% of casualties were when civilians were performing agriculture (20 killed and 42 injured), 24% of casualties were when civilians were home (19 killed and 16 injured), and 23% of casualties were when civilians were hiding or fleeing from bombardments (22 killed and 11 injured).

Agricultural activities consist of civilians farming, shepherding, foraging wild plants, beekeeping, fishing, and tending to animals. In terms of casualties related to agriculture, 19% of casualties occurred when civilians were tending to animals (15 killed and 12 injured), 5% of casualties were when civilians were farming (4 killed and 3 injured), and 1% were when performing nomadic activities (2 injured).

Similar to the impact of Turkish

military operations, there is a pattern of targeting populated areas and lands for agricultural purposes, particularly with the use of artillery. This pattern is extremely concerning, given the civilian casualties and the impact on civilian livelihoods.

6% of casualties occurred when civilians were working (5 killed and 3 injured). 4% of casualties occurred when civilians attempted rescue due to bombardments (5 killed and 1 injured). 3% of casualties occurred when civilians were visiting relatives (3 killed and 2 injured). 2% of civilians were shopping (1 killed and 2 injured). 2% of casualties were civilians on touristic activities (1 killed and 2 injured). 1% of casualties were walking home (1 killed and 1 injured). 1% of casualties were when civilians were driving (2 injured). 1% of civilians were in a refugee camp. Less than 1% of civilians were shopkeeping (1 killed) and eloping (1 killed).

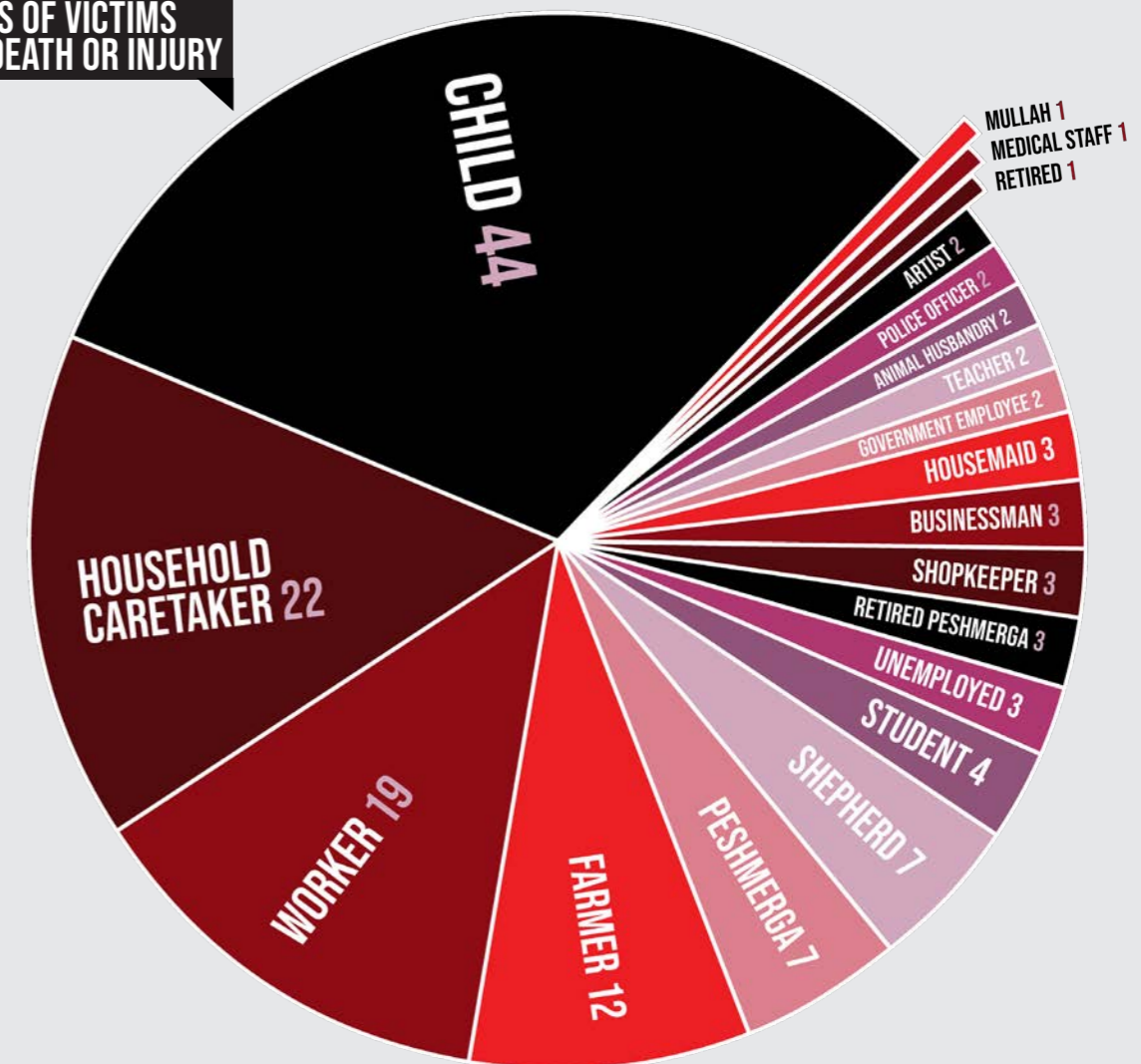
The three most impacted employment categories were women working from home, workers, and farmers. 15% of casualties were women working at home, totaling 22 casualties (11 killed and 11 injured). 13% of casualties were civilians with occupations of worker, totaling 19 casualties (10 killed and 9 injured). 8% of casualties were farmers, totaling 12 casualties (9 killed and 3 injured).

5% of casualties were Peshmerga, totaling 7 casualties (5 killed and 2 injured), and shepherds, also totaling 7 casualties (5 killed and 2 injured). 3% of casualties were civilian students, totaling 4 casualties (3 killed and 1 injured). 2% of casualties were civilians that were unemployed at the time of the incident, totaling 3 casualties (1 killed and 2 injured),

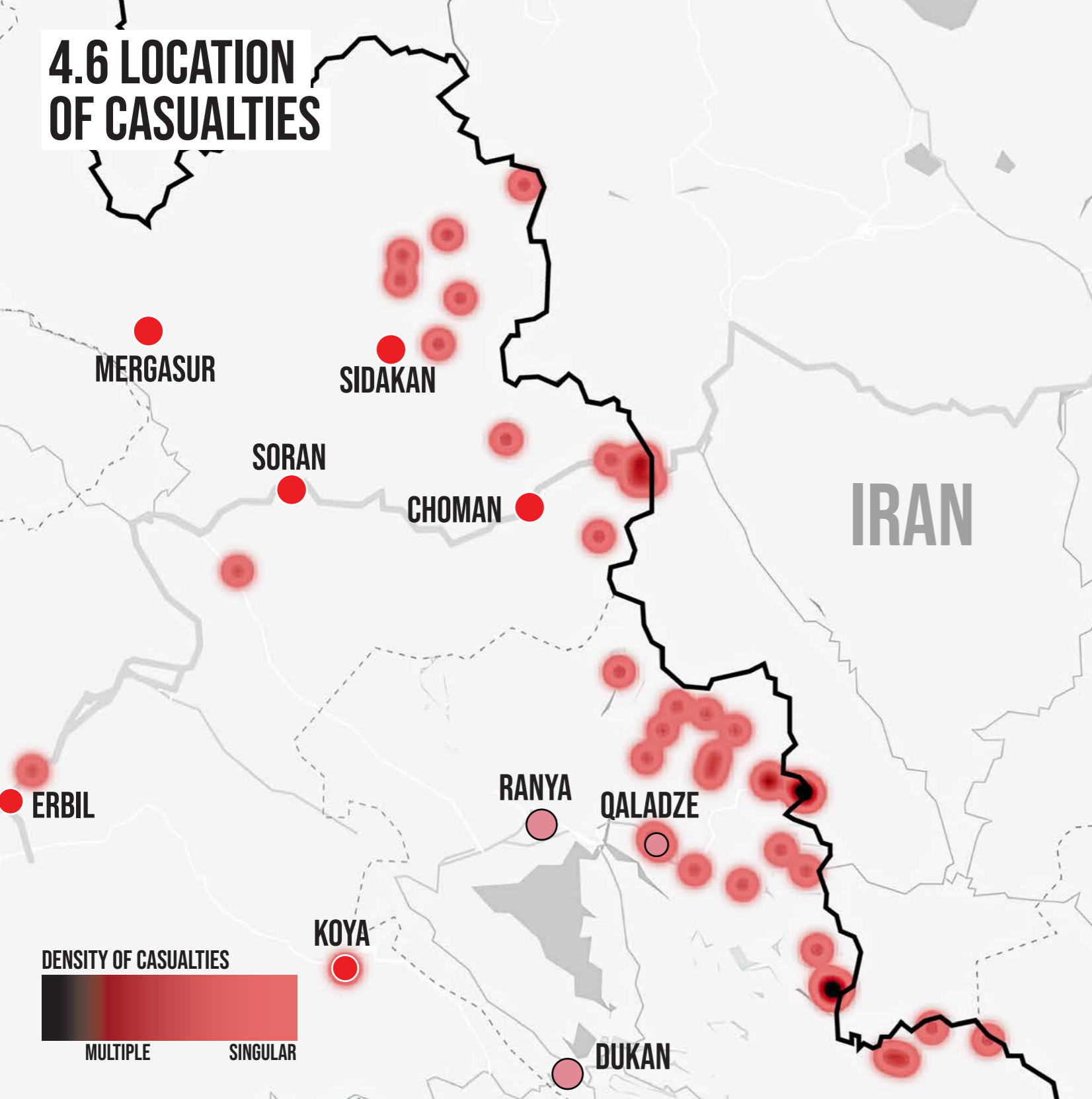
retired Peshmerga (3 injured), shopkeepers (1 killed and 2 injured), businessmen (2 killed and 1 injured), and housemaids (2 killed and 1 injured).

1% of casualties were civilians who were government employees (2 injured), teachers (2 injured), civilians engaged in animal husbandry (2 killed), police officers (2 injured), and artists (2 killed). Less than 1% of casualties were retirees (1 injured), medical staff (1 injured), and religious leaders (1 killed).

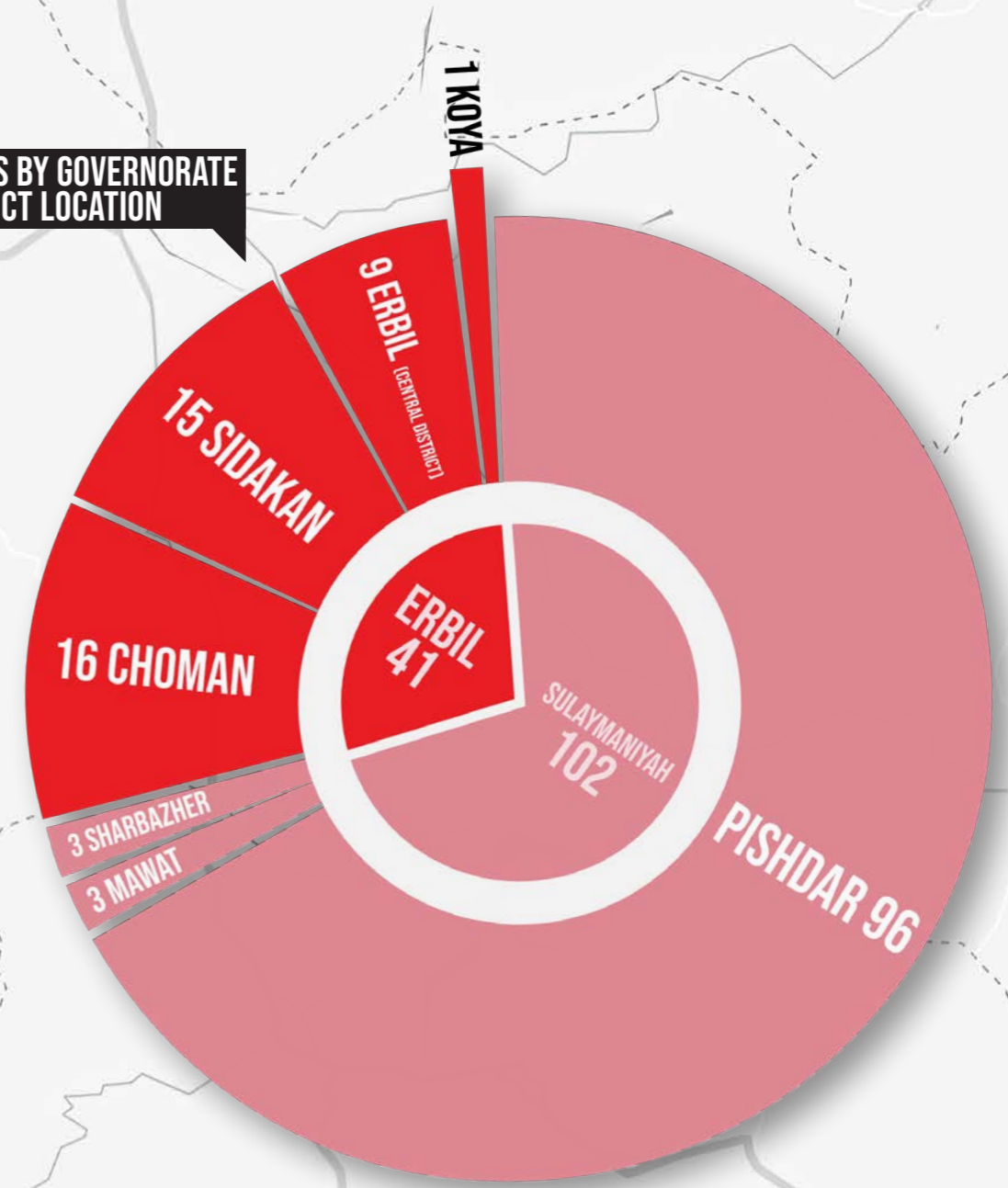
OCCUPATIONS OF VICTIMS AT TIME OF DEATH OR INJURY

CASUALTIES BY GOVERNORATE AND DISTRICT LOCATION



The Sulaymaniyah governorate accounted for the majority of casualties caused by Iranian military operations, with 71% of casualties, totaling 102 (62 killed and 40 injured). The majority of the Iranian border in Iraqi Kurdistan is in the Sulaymaniyah governorate. The Erbil governorate accounted for 28% of total casualties, including 41 casualties (19 killed and 22 injured).

The Pishdar district is overwhelmingly the most impacted district in Iraqi Kurdistan by Iranian

military operations, accounting for 67% of casualties, totaling 96 casualties, (59 killed and 37 injured). One explanation for Pishdar's high proportion of casualties is that the Kurdistan Free Life Party (PJAK), an affiliate of the PKK, is based in the mountains of Qandil in Pishdar district.

However, it is important to mention that both Qaladze and Zharawa, which suffered the most civilian casualties from Iranian artillery shelling, are a

considerable distance away from the Qandil Mountains.

Secondly, most of the casualties in Pishdar occurred in the 1990s, during the civil war between the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Kurdistan (KDP) and the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan (PUK). The civil war started in Qaladze, located in the Pishdar district, and is the site of the largest incident of casualties by the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps. The Iranian state strategically maneuvered between the two political parties, utilizing its own

military and political maneuvers to achieve its objectives.

The Choman district accounted for 11% of casualties, totaling 16 casualties (10 killed and 6 injured). The Sidakan district accounted for 10% of casualties, totaling 15 casualties (4 killed and 11 injured). The Erbil Central District accounted for 6% of casualties, totaling 9 casualties (4 killed and 5 injured). The Mawat district accounted for 2% of casualties, totaling 3 casualties (2 killed and 1 injured). The Sharbazher district accounted

for 2% of casualties, totaling 3 casualties (1 killed and 2 injured). The Koya district accounted for less than 1% of casualties (1 killed).

In terms of sub-districts, the centers of Qaladze and Zharawa accounted for the largest percentage of casualties, with both at 21%, totaling 42%. Both towns are located in the Pishdar district and were both subject to artillery shelling in the mid-1990s that caused many casualties.

4.7 IRANIAN MILITARY BASES

Iran has built at least 151 additional military bases along Iraqi Kurdistan's and Iranian borders. Most of these bases are in the Pishdar district, of the Sulaymaniyah governorate. In addition to causing casualties, the construction of these military bases has had various impacts on civilians.

Nomadic people can no longer use the land for agricultural purposes in many areas near Iranian military bases. The displacement of many villages has resulted in the people losing their long-standing cultural practice of harvesting wild vegetables in their mountains. Iranian soldiers often shoot from the military bases at shepherds, villagers, and farmers whose grazing areas,

villages, or farmlands are nearby. In addition to shootings, many bases, particularly in the Choman region, have planted landmines up to one kilometer into Iraqi territory, posing significant threats to the remaining villagers or tourists visiting the area. CPT has verified one casualty from recently planted landmines in the Choman region. The village where the incident occurred is now empty, with residents rarely returning. A repercussion of these incidents is a significant decline in tourism while also making it unsafe for international diplomats, consular staff, and governmental authorities to visit these areas.

4.8 ETHNICITY

Of the 143 total casualties, 97% were of Kurdish ethnicity, totaling 139 (79 killed and 60 injured). Less than 1% were of Arab ethnicity, totaling 1 casualty (1 killed). 2% were of other ethnicities, totaling 3 casualties (1 killed and 2 injured).



V. DIFFICULTY OF DOCUMENTATION

Verification and documentation are becoming more and more difficult, especially in situations of casualties resulting from Turkish military actions. Due to the Turkish military presence, some parts of Iraqi Kurdistan have become inaccessible and impossible for any NGO to visit.

The collection of documentation was difficult in some areas due to civilians and local authorities being unwilling to provide documentation to CPT about incidents related to Turkish military operations. This reluctance is likely explained by pressure and threats from the major political parties in Iraqi Kurdistan. As a result of these challenges, 56 civilians were listed as unknown without documentation, but they were still considered verified casualties after meeting verification standards.

As a result of Turkish and Iranian military operations, such as bombardments or other attacks, some families have had essential documents destroyed or lost, including Iraqi IDs, martyr's IDs, food ration cards, and other documentation essential for legal compensation and verification. In most instances, there is no way to remake these documents, leaving only names to be collected. By the same token, death certificates of impacted civilians may state "explosion" or cite a cause of death unrelated to Turkish and Iranian military operations, with any changes being extremely difficult.

This makes it challenging for impacted families to take any legal action for compensation and adds several steps and obstacles for verification. Furthermore, CPT could not retrieve documents of foreigners from abroad or those killed and injured who reside in southern and central Iraq due to those areas being outside CPT's area of capacity. However, information was still collected digitally.

Another difficulty arises from the fact that the safety of NGOs is not ensured in Turkish and Iranian militarily occupied areas, making any communication, visitation, and investigation with impacted civilians very challenging. For example, in 2022, when CPT was visiting Hirure, a village militarily occupied by Turkey close to the Turkish border, an artillery projectile was fired from a nearby Turkish military base and struck close to the CPT vehicle, which was clearly labeled with an NGO decal. This occurred after CPT had visited with a few of the remaining families who had refused to leave despite Turkey's frequent bombardments and military presence.

Another issue stems from the fact that the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG) lacks a committee or any documentation pertaining to casualties from Turkish and Iranian military operations, rendering the government an unreliable source.

VI. COMPENSATION FOR VICTIMS

Law 20 of 2009 and Law 57 of 2015 from the Iraqi Council of Representatives stipulate that all Iraqi citizens affected or harmed by military operations and terrorist actions are entitled to financial compensation. According to an order from the former KRG Deputy Prime Minister issued in 2011, all Iraqi citizens that reside in Iraqi Kurdistan that are killed by Turkish and Iranian militaries should be considered national martyrs.

As per the Law on Compensation (Law 20 of 2009 and Law 57 of 2015), Iraqi authorities will compensate all citizens, including IDPs, whose properties were affected by war related incidents.

According to Article 2 of Law 20, there are five categories eligible for compensation:

1. Martyrdom, missing in action, kidnapping, or injury;
2. Full or partial disability based on a medical report issued by a specialized medical committee;
3. Injuries and other cases that require temporary treatment based on the specialized medical report in this field;
4. Damaged property;
5. Disadvantages relevant to job or education.

In the Kurdistan Region of Iraq, the Law on the Rights and Privileges of the Families of Martyrs and Anfal Victims mirrors the Martyrs' Foundation Law of Federal Iraq. It provides benefits for the following groups of persons:

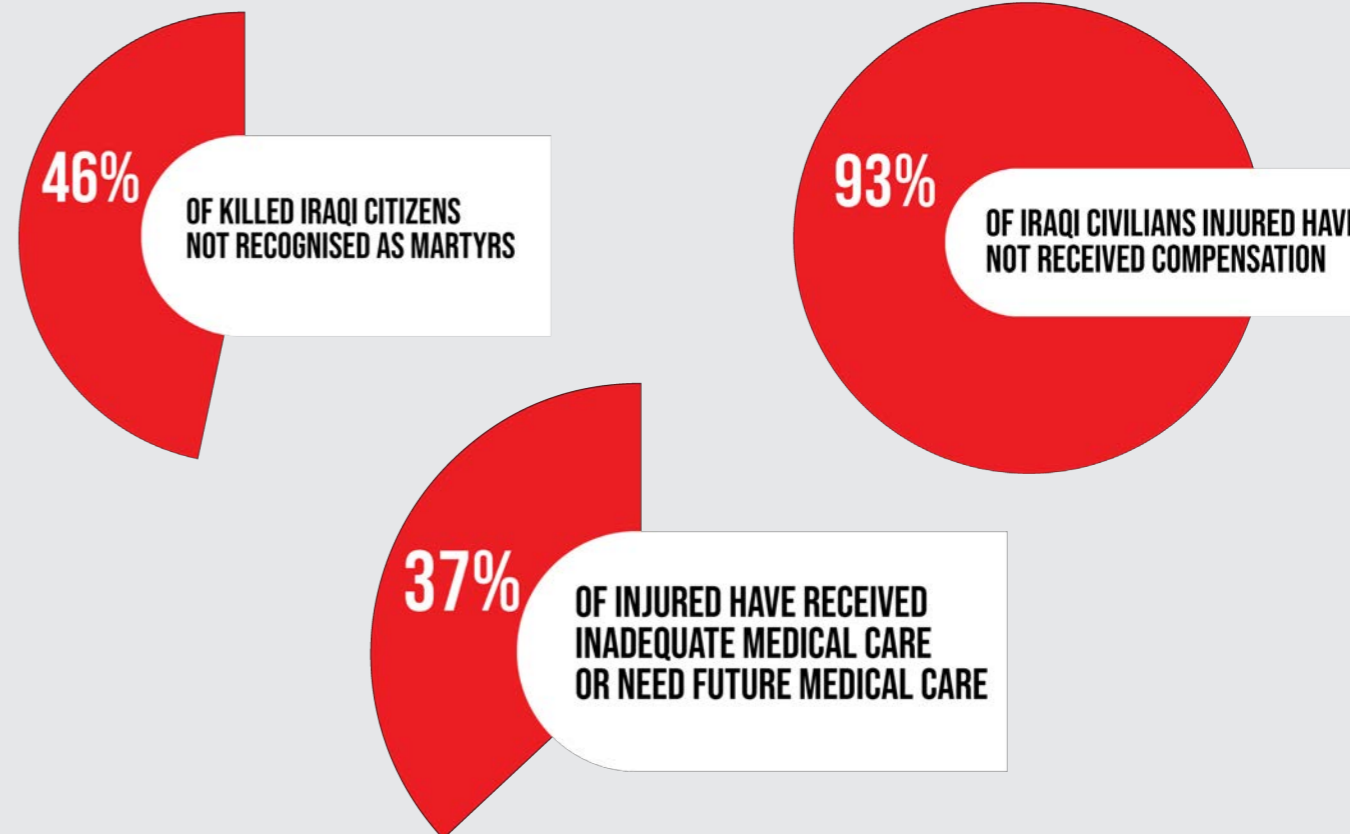
Civilian Martyrs: whoever was martyred as a result of war or terrorist attacks, or lost their lives during Kurdish revolutions and the Great Exodus of Kurds in 1991;

Law 20 of 2009 and Law 57 of 2015 stipulate that all Iraqi citizens affected or harmed by military operations and terrorist actions are entitled to financial compensation. The law may grant the status of 'National Martyr' or 'Civil Martyr' to killed civilians, entitling them to appropriate compensation. Injured civilians are required by law to receive any necessary medical assistance and compensation. The victim also should receive additional compensation if the attack results in a disability. The KRG's compensation for some of the victims has been largely insufficient. Compensation packages from the KRG for martyrs range from 150,000 IQD to 500,000 IQD per month, with a few exceptions. The compensation doesn't

provide for material damages, medical services, psychological impacts, difficult living conditions, or additional necessary medical assistance needed for injuries. Most people haven't received compensation for damage to their properties or farmland. Additionally, the victim's relationship and ties to one of the two main political parties in Iraqi Kurdistan determine their likelihood to receive any financial package.

Out of the 404 killed Iraqi citizens, 187 have not received recognition as martyrs, resulting in no compensation for their families. Civilians in the Makhmur refugee camp, even if they were born in Iraq, are not legally Iraqi citizens. Most citizens of Arab descent have received compensation. Among the 420 injured civilians, 157 have either received inadequate medical assistance or are in need of further medical aid. Of these 157 individuals requiring additional medical assistance, 34 are children. Overall, out of the 403 Iraqi citizens injured, 373 do not receive compensation, with many of them disabled and therefore unable to work and earn an income.

Payman Talib suffered severe injuries including losing a leg from a Turkish drone strike in Kuna Masi, 2020. Her husband and two children were also injured in the attack which damaged their store.



VII. NON-CIVILIAN CASUALTIES

NON-BELLIGERENTS

Armed members of both the Iraqi federal government and the Kurdistan Regional Government are considered non-belligerent actors, as both the Iraqi state and the Kurdistan Regional Government are considered non-belligerent actors in the conflicts between Turkey and the PKK and Iran and armed non-state Kurdish opposition groups.

The Turkish Armed Forces killed ten non-belligerents and injured five. 80% of the non-belligerent casualties, totaling 12 casualties (8 killed and 4 injured), were armed members of Peshmerga who were on active duty at the time of the incident. Due to widespread bombardments, some active duty Peshmerga casualties were involved in the same incident

as civilians, including a massacre on January 28, 1994, when Turkey conducted a series of strikes on the Pishdar area. This resulted in the deaths of 11 civilians and the injuries of 13. Additionally, 20% of the non-belligerent casualties were active Iraqi border guard commanders, totaling 3 casualties (2 killed and 1 injured), who were killed and injured by Turkish bombardments while performing their military duty. At the time, they were meeting with the PKK to discuss the expansion of Iraqi bases in the Sidakan area - an area that the PKK held some control over at the time of the incident. One non-belligerent, an active Peshmerga, was killed by the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps in an incident that injured two other civilians.

PRISONERS OF WAR

Prisoners of war who are members of belligerent armed forces are considered non-combatants. The Turkish Armed Forces killed eight non-combatants with suspected chemical use. The PKK held 13 people captive in the mountainous region of Gara, including 8 Turkish soldiers and 5 civilians. The five

civilians, including one Iraqi and four Turkish citizens, were kidnapped due to accusations by the PKK that they were collaborating with Turkish Armed Forces and Turkish intelligence. In 2021, Turkey conducted an operation on Gara Mountain, killing all the captives, including the prisoners of war, likely with tear gas, as most of the victims died from asphyxiation.

VI. RECOMMENDATIONS

IRAQI FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

- Implement Law on Compensation Law No. 20 of 2009 and Law No. 57 of 2015.
- Ensure that all Iraqi citizens are treated and compensated equally, not based on ethnicity.
- Implement structures and methods that are accessible to impacted families to receive support and compensation.
- Protect Iraqi sovereignty and use diplomatic means to ensure civilians safety.
- Provide means and access for civilians who need medical assistance including for specialist care outside Iraq.

KURDISTAN REGIONAL GOVERNMENT

- Implement the Law on the Rights and Privileges of the Families of Martyrs and Anfal Victims.
- No differentiation on compensation and martyrdom status based on political party affiliation.
- Create functional and accessible institutions for impacted civilians to provide appropriate support, compensation, and necessary information.
- Take measures to ensure safety of civilians, their livelihoods, and lands throughout Iraqi Kurdistan especially those impacted by the construction of Turkish and Iranian military bases
- Correct death certificates of impacted civilians to state that were killed by foreign military actions and not labeled incorrectly or vaguely (such as 'accident') as is sometimes practiced.

INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY

- Turkey receives arms and mechanical parts integral to the development of drones, fighter jets, and other arms from the United States, and various European countries. These countries that supply arms and weapons parts, along with other states and international entities such as NATO, should ensure that Turkey is held accountable for its civilian impact and held to international legal standards, humanitarian law, agreements, and treaties.

VII. METHODOLOGY

For the purposes of its report on the civilian impact of military operations, Community Peacemaker Teams (CPT) only includes verified civilian casualties. Civilian casualties are recorded as 'verified' when the CPT determines, based on the totality of the information reviewed, that there is clear and convincing evidence that civilians or non-belligerent actors or non-combatants have been killed or injured by Turkey or Iran in northern Iraq within the appropriate time frame from 1991 to the present. Civilians killed or injured by civil war, remnants of previous conflicts between states, and the former Iraqi regime are not included. For example, civilians killed or injured by remnants of the Iran-Iraq war were not included.

To meet a high standard of verification and accuracy, CPT requires a combination of at least three different types of independent sources, such as victims, witnesses, death certificates, medical documents, police reports, local authorities, community leaders, or other sources. The data for this report is predominantly obtained through interviews conducted by members of Community Peacemaker Teams (CPT) with survivors of the attacks, affected individuals and families, and local authorities throughout the years of 2023 and 2024. This information is corroborated and cross-referenced by medical documents, media sources, death certificates, CPT's own documentation, and other legal documentation.

Where CPT is not satisfied with the reliability and credibility of information concerning civilian casualties, it will not consider it verified. Members of armed non-state actors were not counted as non-belligerent civilian casualties. However, certain cases involving members of armed state groups, such as the Iraqi Border Guard and Peshmerga, were included as civilian casualties due to being in civilian status at the time of the incident. Peshmerga and Iraqi Border Guards on active duty were not included as civilian casualties but were included as non-belligerents, as both the Iraqi state and the Kurdistan Regional Government are considered non-belligerent actors in the conflicts between Turkey and the PKK and Iran and armed non-state Kurdish groups. Additionally, prisoners of war are considered non-combatants, even if they are from belligerent actors, and thus are included as non-combatant casualties.

Unverified incidents are not included in this report. CPT does not claim that the statistics presented in this report are complete and acknowledges possible under-reporting of civilian casualties given the limitations inherent in the operating environment, particularly considering the current political situation in Iraqi Kurdistan.

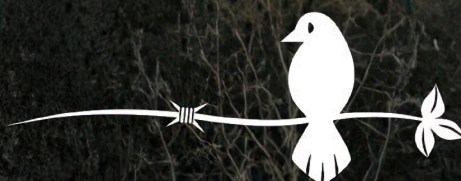
