- U.S. federal agencies will be available to answer questions about replacing identification documents and will have applications on hand. Please see information below specific to each agency and location
- Catholic Charities, a non-profit, will be on hand to assist with the preparation of immigration forms

Participants and Services (Spanish Speakers Available)

- **Catholic Charities of Santa Rosa**, an accredited agency, will assist with immigration form preparation
- **U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services**, will provide information and forms for replacing naturalization certificates, I-551 “green cards”, and employment authorization cards. www.uscis.gov
- The **Mexican Consulate** will provide information about replacing Mexican documents, including Mexican passports.
- **U.S. Passport Office** will provide information about replacing U.S. passports **only** at the Santa Rosa event. **Bring photos for passport replacement and copies of docs if available**
- **The Social Security Administration** will provide information and provide assistance applying for replacement social security cards.
- **California Department of Motor Vehicles** will provide information on replacing California driver licenses and identification cards.
