## **Immigrants' Rights Attorney**

The Legal Aid Society of San Mateo County seeks an attorney with a passion for economic justice and immigrants' rights to join our LIBRE Project. LIBRE ([www.thelibreproject.org](http://www.thelibreproject.org)) is a multi-agency collaboration that educates immigrants and their families about their rights and eligibility for safety net benefits and immigration relief, and provides legal advocacy on their behalf.
