

- Step 1: Make a fossil.**
Use the 'make a fossil' worksheet to learn about the different types of fossil and make one of your own.
- Step 2: Colour in your fossil box.**
Use books or the internet to find out facts about fossils to fill the missing words.
- Step 3: Cut out your fossil box.**
Ask an adult to help you. You will need a pair of scissors to cut all the way around the box. Make sure you carefully cut along all the dashed lines.
- Step 4: Fold and glue.**
For the final step you will need glue. First, fold along all the solid edges (solid lines). Then glue the sides together.
Helpful hint: Remember to fold all the sides away from you to make a cube.
