Materials List: acrylic paint, round paint brushes of varying sizes, small stretched canvas, I'm using 14" by 11", jar of water, spray bottle of water, palette knife (optional), palette or something to mix paint on, small piece of plastic wrap or foil to cover mixed paint, colored and white tissue paper, small pieces of decorative paper, plain or patterned, scissors, Mod Podge or white glue, flat brush for glue, pens and paper for drawing including opaque paint pens or gel pens (optional), sturdy small-ish leaves with prominent veins for rubbing, oil pastels or colored pencils for rubbings, imagination

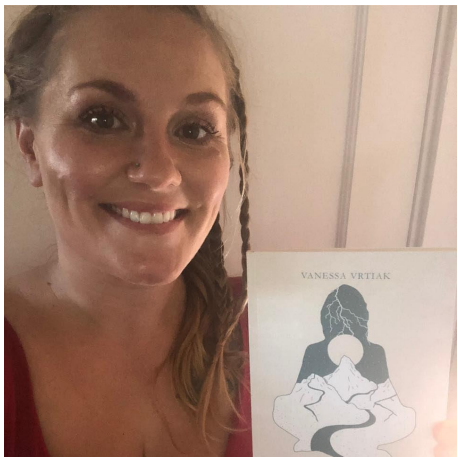

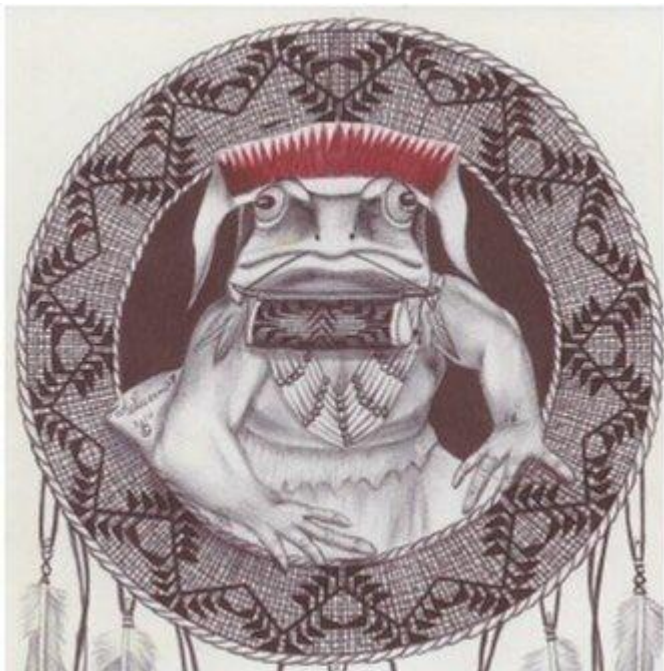
