US Chess and KCA memberships may be purchased or renewed on-site. *BOTH US Chess and KCA memberships are required. **Other States Accepted.** All advanced entries must be in by e-mail by **January 5, 2018 by 9:00PM.**

Format: 4 rounds Swiss – Game/60 with 5 second delay (Dual-Rated); Three Sections: Open, Reserve-U1800 and Amateur-U1400 (Based on January 2018 Rating Supplement)

Entry Fee: All players pay on-site on Saturday.

Only Cash will be accepted. Refer to the table for both adult and scholastic rates. Players must be present by 9:30AM or else they will not be paired for first round.
