School safety: prevention

Prevention - physical

- Architectural design in schools and exteriors
- Cameras in schools

Prevention - people

- Behavior and Emotional Screener system: given three times a year to measure student's social-emotional health, identify issues
- SEL Hub with DuPage County Regional Office
- Collaborative relationships with local mental health organizations/providers
- Universal social-emotional work: developing persistence, problem solving, working cooperatively
- Psychologists, social workers at schools
- Interventions as needed
- Parent programs: Glenbard Parent Series
- You! Contact your school or local police when there is something we need to know.

School safety: prepared and proactive

Prepared and proactive - physical

- Some of the schools have tools such as Raptor, CrisisGo and various other security measures
- Safe2Help, SpeakUp notification systems families or students can use
- Communications systems within and between buildings
- Approved, shared evacuation sites
- School drills

Prepared and proactive - people

- Staff trained on ALICE or run-hide-fight
- Membership in DuPage Regional Safety Committee
- Partnerships with local police departments
- Collaborative work with other local organizations to investigate and apply for grants that support mental health and wellness initiatives
- Gun lock “giveaway” through Glen Ellyn Police Department
