UDHR Audio/Video

This year, we recorded additional translations of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and began projects to translate and record the UDHR in languages never before translated for this purpose. We began in Zimbabwe with 6 additional dialects, and continue our focus on the Middle East and North African region. All languages are added to our **udhr.audio app** and to our **new YouTube channel**.



- Over 120 languages recorded
- 17,185 new unique users in 2019 (67,047 total users 2016-2019)
- Used in every country in the world (except for Greenland)
- New YouTube channel
- New Arabic and Plain Language UDHR Projects:
 - We are currently wrapping up first translations ever of Egyptian, Algerian, Moroccan and Sudanese
 - We will continue to focus on adding less official/formal language translations to increase accessibility to the general public

The portal is a database-driven web site (hreportal.com) containing the **largest online collection of human rights educational curriculum**, professional development materials and links to service learning opportunities.

- added new, current materials
- conducted a comprehensive UI/UX review in preparation for our school district pilot
