Reports – 7:15

- "State of Disgrace" update
 - Just had this action. Ken Kidd action at Trump Tower this afternoon. 14 of us were arrested They should be released from jail by 9pm. We shut down Trump Tower for an hour. It was a beautiful thing. Started up top and unfurled a huge banner– Security didn't know where we were coming from next. Pix on RAR page. They will make you proud. Share those photos on social media.Get the word out. Signs: Shut Down Trump, State of Emergency, State of Disgrace.
 - The release of the arrested folks began to be processed just before 8pm.

Finance

- Ivy has a handout showing the accountant expenses that were approved last week, to prepare our taxes. Handout also reports our cash and bank balance in a more transparent way.
- Has a lot of new items for approval. Several actions went over the pre-approved
 \$200 amounts and need additional funds approved.
- Impeach \$109; Women's March \$159; Impeach hats \$141; Rent signature. Floor voted to approve all of these.
- Andy joint fundraising finance operation at the moment: Impeach hats. \$15.
 Cash strongly preferred. WIII also have them at the Impeach action on Thursday.

- Collected \$271.00 tonight.

- Elevator Action Group
 - First action: Addressed incoming MTA president [?]
 - Second action Community Board 1 had a meeting re: new elevators, because they didn't want an ugly structure blocking their new building. People spoke and unanimously voted that elevators would be installed. Secondary meeting after that - and no one spoke against the elevators.
 - Plan to renovate 33 stations. Nine stations are being worked on. But Tuesday there was a vote to shelve some of them.

TomCat Bakery

- Jeanne -radiobaron@gmail.com organizing efforts in solidarity with workers at Tom Cat Bakery. We've been working on it for months. Asking restaurants not to assist Trump administration in rounding up immigrant workers. Still, many restaurants have refused to drop their accounts. Now we are escalating that effort. We are going to do something like the cough-in, the first action RAR did. Disrupted business as usual inside the restaurant. Talk to Jeanne to get the name of the restaurant. Demonstration will be on Thursday Feb 8, 7pm.
- The restaurants hate when we do this. Also, we are doing this in coalition with IWW, DSA (Democratic Socialists for America). They are calling it a Tip and Sit. We will chant, move out if they ask us to. The Impeach Trump group will join us on the outside.
- Jay from floor Who is their largest competitor? Are we driving business to the competitor? Would they be willing to donate to RAR? [Laughs] There are two of them. Jeanne says we can start working with them.
- Signs: Who Bakes Your Bread? Things taste better with fairness. No Justice No Bread. RAR photographer is embedding with them, as well as a video person. The workers are using this hashtag: #TomCatWorkersRise. They will work with Comms to come up with other hashtags.
- It's not too late for TomCat to adopt the best practices. There are many other targets. If Tomcat does it, we can move on to other targets.
- Passed around the rent bag to pay for the hall.
- Teach-in on single payer health care. (vote)
 - Jake Do we want to empower the Facilitation and Education groups to bring in speakers for 20-30 minute presentations, or approve them one at a time as they are proposed?
 - Question: Why don't we get speakers from working groups?
 - Question: How are you choosing?
 - Ouestion: Do we pay them for speaking?
 - Process to make a speaker suggestion: contact <u>Education@risesandresist.org</u>
 The idea is to coordinate so that groups don't schedule speakers at the same time.

- Question: How do we deal with controversial speakers, esp. elected officials? Do
 we vote on those? Andy suggests that elected officials be proposed in advance
 and voted on. Jake agrees that such speakers will be brought to the floor for a
 vote. We try to get them to speak pro bono, and if not, get someone else.
- Floor votes to approve empowering the committees.
- Jake has a speaker to propose on the subject of Single Payer Health Care Bob Lederer (suggested by Annette, who works in the field)... Straw poll on dates: Feb 27, March 6, March 20.

Immigration Committee and report on Ravi

- Captured by ICE at a check-in. 20 agents, 10 cars, for just one person. He knew he was targeted because he was a leader of NY Sanctuary coalition.
- By order of a federal judge he was released this week. Interview with Ravi posted today. His release was granted because his capture was inhumane. He is scheduled to be before a judge again and may be deported then.

Presidents' Day action

- Jay Monday, Feb 19, late afternoon-early evening. Last year we did a big public event, and this year's we're doing something a little more nuanced, focused on immigration. Wollman Rink in Central Park. It is completely branded with Trump stuff. A day of ice skating with RAR will be posted. Components of it will be a vague action. Issue with the rink is that admission is \$15 per person, and renting skates costs \$15 additional. RAR tries to help offset the cost so that more can attend. Raising the subject- asking the floor if we can cover some of those costs.

- Philip reminds us that the city could not make a go of Wollman rink in the 80's and Trump rescued it. Jay - Yes. It's still owned by the city, but the business is run by Trump.

 report. Thinks all the pieces worked. We had a big banner, too high for the police to
 grab. Katrina and Alexandra dropped flyers into the cafeteria and immediately got
 nabbed. All kinds of RAR folks were there in the lobby looking spiffy. Chanting. People
 got up and spoke. Lots of RAR folks filming. New York One, CBS covered it.

 - Arrest part cops were decent, no-nonsense. Put in the wagon, not segregated by gender (or the cop's perception of gender). Three to a cell. Spent three hours getting to know each other! Three or four supporters were at the jail waiting for them. Some women were in the jail with them - had climbed into the globe at 59th Street.
