UCCR TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Families - Little Basin)

- DESCRIPTION OF PREMISES UCCR agrees to permit Licensee to use the property identified in this Agreement as "Little Basin" according to the following terms and conditions. The Agreement includes the use of all improvements to the Little Basin except those which UCCR expressly excludes by so notifying the Licensee's representative upon his/her arrival at the Little Basin.
- If Licensee and/or its participants prepares its own food, it assumes all responsibility for any foods prepared, and for all activities incident to their preparations, and shall hold UCCR and the Little Basin owner harmless from any and all liability arising therefrom.
- USE OF PREMISES AND SCHEDULE Licensee using the Little Basin with the sole intent
 of family style camping during the term of this Agreement, shall use the Little Basin for
 recreational and educational purposes and shall comply with all applicable laws, codes and
 regulations
- UTILITIES UCCR shall provide water and garbage disposal without charge to Licensee. Limited electrical service available, please contact the site director.
- 5. MAINTENANCE UCCR shall maintain the Little Basin in good condition and repair and shall provide janitorial services to the premises and buildings. Licensee agrees to assist in keeping the Little Basin clean, and shall leave the Little Basin free of defacement caused by Licensee and/or its participants. Guests are liable and may be charged for damages caused to the site or equipment as determined by the site director.
- 6. HEALTH AND SAFETY
- A The California Code of Conduct and Regulations has jurisdiction at Little Basin.
- B UCCR does not provide medical supervision, treatment or maintenance and dispensing of medications for campers. These responsibilities belong to the Licensee.
- C Emergency transportation is available through local emergency response groups by dialing 911. Licensee agrees to furnish non-emergency transportation.
- D UCCR prohibits hunting, fireworks, firearms, ammunitions and explosives at the Little Basin. The use of gasoline and other flammables are restricted. Prior authorization from the Site Director must be obtained.
- E Licensee will prohibit smoking. Open fires may be built only in the provided campfire rings, for which fire permits have been secured. It is understood that Licensee and its participants must comply with all lawful orders of appropriate fire control officials.
- F Use of vehicles at the Little Basin is restricted to roads and parking areas designated by the Site Director. Posted speed limits shall be obeyed. There is a limit of 2 vehicles per site (a trailer counts as a vehicle). Additional parking available on the parking terrace; extra vehicle fee will apply.
- G. Once at the Little Basin, the Licensee is required to participate in a brief orientation to UCCR's safety regulations and emergency procedures led by the Site Director or designee.
- 7. USE FEES AND COSTS
- A Site Fees: Rates are determined by site, not per person
- Additional Use Fees If more persons use the Little Basin than the Licensee guaranteed (meaning more than 8 per site, or additional day use guests), Licensee shall pay to UCCR an additional fee. This fee will represent the use of the Little Basin by the additional persons (or cars), and will be calculated by totaling the individual charges for each additional person's lodging, car, or day use fee, or other per person or car fees where applicable.
- C Breakage and Damage Licensee agrees to pay UCCR the amount reasonably necessary to repair or replace property or equipment damaged or destroyed by Licensee and/or its participants during Licensee's use.
- D Payment Terms Licensee agrees to deliver payment in full to a representative of UCCR prior to Licensee's arrival at the Little Basin.
- 8. LIABILITY FOR INJURY TO PERSONS OR PROPERTY
- A Licensee agrees to supervise and to assume full control and responsibility for any persons, entities or things other than UCCR personnel or property who/which are, for any reason, on the Little Basin by reason of Licensee's program or use of the Little Basin.
- B Licensee agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless UCCR and the Little Basin Owner and their past, present and future members, directors, officers, employees, agents and independent contractors and its and their successors, assigns and heirs from and against any harm and/or claim made by any third party arising out of or in any way connected with Licensee's actions and/or failure(s) to act with respect to its performance of this Agreement.
- C Neither UCCR nor the Little Basin Owner shall be liable to Licensee or to any company insuring Licensee for any loss or damage to Licensee if the casualty causing such loss or damage was or could have been covered by any other property insurance.
- D For the purpose of this section, "any person" includes, but is not limited to, Licensee's agents and employees, participants in Licensee's program, and Licensee's visitors.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

- A Licensee warrants that the person signing the Agreement has the authority to execute this Agreement on its behalf.
- B This Agreement may be altered or amended only by written agreement of both parties.
- C UCCR reserves the right to require that the Licensee remove from the Little Basin any persons in, or in any way connected with, Licensee's group who, in the sole opinion of UCCR, are creating a disturbance or who are otherwise disrupting activities at said Little Basin. Licensee agrees to permit only authorized persons to enter the Little Basin and shall take all necessary steps to remove unauthorized persons from said Little Basin.
- D Licensee agrees that the total number of participants on the premises will not exceed the Little Basin Building Maximum at any time.
- 10. TERMINATION AND BREACH

- UCCR and Licensee agree that these terms and conditions are material inducements to the execution of this Agreement, and that the breach of any one or more of said provisions shall be a material breach entitling UCCR to terminate this Agreement without notice. Waiver of one or more breaches shall not be construed as waiver of any subsequent or other breaches.
- B UCCR may terminate this Agreement without any liability upon ten (10) days prior written notice to Licensee either 1) with cause or 2) upon a determination by UCCR, in its sole and exclusive judgment, that the requirements of the State Fire Marshal, the Department of Public Health and Safety, or any statute, rule or regulation of any federal state or local body, imposes undue requirements or hardship on UCCR. In such latter events, all amounts paid by Licensee to UCCR shall be fully refunded.
- C If the Little Basin is destroyed by fire or other cause or is so damaged that it is untenantable, this Agreement may, in the discretion of UCCR, be terminated and Licensee shall have no further obligation hereunder.
- In the event a legal action or other proceeding is brought to enforce the terms of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the non-prevailing party those of its fees and costs incurred in the proceeding which the Finder of Fact shall, in its sole discretion, apportion in its favor.
- E. In the event of cancellation by Licensee, Licensee may be charged a cancellation fee If Licensee terminates this Agreement within seven (7) days of arrival date without using the Little Basin as agreed and if UCCR cannot re-license the Little Basin, then Licensee agrees to pay to UCCR the fee for one night for site(s) reserved as a cancellation fee.
