What:

CITYarts will produce and create a mural at the Hamilton Grange Middle School with students led by professional NY artist Arturo Garcia entitled Windows of Opportunity. The project commences the 6th year of CITYarts collaboration with Hamilton Grange, and will empower youth to feel a stronger sense of involvement in their school and community while helping them to develop visions and goals for success. This mural will be painted on canvases that will be displayed in the school's auditorium. CITYarts will also invite NYPD officers from nearby precincts to the school to foster friendships and to develop a deeper and more meaningful understanding of one another.

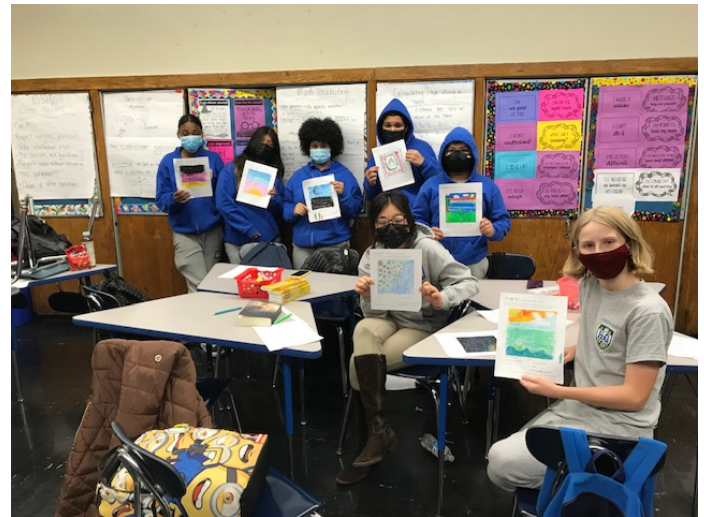
