ABOUT SIR KEN ROBINSON

Sir Ken Robinson's entire career has been dedicated to transforming our perceptions of creativity and how we cultivate creativity in our schools, businesses and other organisations.

An internationally recognised authority in creativity and innovation in education and business, Sir Ken Robinson is also one of the world's leading speakers. Videos of his famous talks to the prestigious **TED** Conference are the most viewed in the history of the organisation and have been seen by an estimated 300 million people in over 150 countries.

Sir Ken works with governments in Europe, Asia and the US, international agencies, Fortune 500 companies and leading cultural organizations. He led a national commission on creativity, education and the economy for the UK Government, was the central figure in developing a strategy for creative and economic development as part of the Peace Process in Northern Ireland, and was one of four international advisors to the Singapore Government for a strategy to become the creative hub of SE Asia.

Called "*one of the world's elite thinkers on creativity and innovation*" by Fast Company magazine, Sir Ken has received numerous awards and recognitions for his ground-breaking contributions.

In 2003, he received a knighthood from Queen Elizabeth II for services to the arts.

THE EDUCATION REVOLUTION

All across the world, education systems are attempting reform. But, Sir Ken Robinson believes that *"reform is no use anymore. Because that's simply improving a broken model."* What he calls for is a revolution that transforms the system into something new. *"Not evolution, but a revolution!"*

Sir Robinson's education revolution aims to put innovation fundamentally at the core, to help us do what is difficult and challenge what we take for granted.

Robinson quotes Abraham Lincoln as saying, *"the dogmas of the quiet past are inadequate to the stormy present. The occasion is piled high with difficulty and we must rise with the occasion. As our case is new, so we must think anew and act anew. We must disenthrall ourselves, and then we shall save our country."*

Sir Ken Robinson, a leading thinker on creativity and education, has studied models of education and their effect on societies around the world. His ideas about education, and how to change it, have resonated across cultures and audiences.
