All art mediums will be considered in this call for submissions, from photography, sculpture, ceramics, fabric, mixed media, digital, video, and audio. Also all paintings and drawings including, oil, acrylic, pastels, ink, graphite, etc.

### **Selection Process:**

All exhibition proposals will be juried by a panel of arts professionals, such as museum curators, art consultants, art activists , women issue activists, art educators and accomplished artists in consultation with the Gallery Director. Considerations used to evaluate submitted work include artistic quality, depth of content, originality, relevance, and feasibility. Incomplete submission

packages will not be reviewed.

## **OVERVIEW for Selected Artists:**

### **Shipping, Insurance and Sale of Artwork**

Artists are responsible for the delivery and pick-up of all artwork to Erie Art Gallery in Erie, PA. The artist(s) will be responsible for insuring work during delivery, shipping and loading to and from Erie Art Gallery. Works are insured by Erie Art Gallery while on the premises of Erie Art Gallery only. Artists are required to sign a Loan Agreement if accepted. Erie Art Gallery will use images for media and publicity purposes. All work should be for sale. All sold works must remain on display in the gallery for the duration of the exhibition. Erie Art Gallery receives a commission of 30% for all works sold as a result of the exhibition. Payment will be mailed to the artist within 30 days of the exhibition closing.

### **Shipping Art:**

Include a prepaid shipping label. Place the shipping label in a clear shipping bag (free at major carriers) inside the box. Open a FREE account with any major carriers and to get an air bill for prepaid shipping. (UPS, Fedex, DHL or USPS ) All major carriers can send you preprinted airbills with your ID on them. **YOU MUST INCLUDE A RETURN LABEL AND YOUR RETURN LABEL MUST HAVE A BARCODE ON IT.** Your label is not correct if it does not have a barcode on it. If we do not get a return label and it doesn't sell we will take it as a donation to the gallery.


