Charges:

1. Increase communication with all the Collegiate Chapters.
2. Promote the use of the Kappa Psi Chapter email accounts to ensure all Chapters get important emails and documents and assist Chapters that have trouble accessing their accounts.
3. Create a forum where Collegiate Brothers can interact with the Collegiate Development Committee and solicit their help or advice, and triage their questions to other committees when needed.
4. Gather the best rush/recruitment practices from all the Collegiate Chapters and how to implement them, and create a Rush/Recruitment Activities Guide to be put on the website for all Chapters to use.
5. Gather the best fundraising practices from all the Collegiate Chapters and how to implement them, and create a Fundraising Guide to be put on the website for all Chapters to use.
6. Assess the Collegiate Chapter services on the website and recommend any changes or needs to the Web Services Committee.
7. Review and update the Province Planning Guide and promote its' use to Chapters that are hosting Province Assemblies.
8. Review and update the Officer Training Manual.
9. Create a Collegiate Guide to GCC.
10. Encourage the Chapters to increase their literacy and understanding of the Constitution and By-Laws.
11. Survey the Collegiate Brothers to determine what their needs are.
12. Improve the functionality of Collegiate Chapters.

Accomplishments:

1. The use of chapter emails and Constitution literacy was promoted in each letter of communication to the province during the first year of the two year term
2. A social media group was created to help facilitate a forum where Collegiate Brothers can interact with the Collegiate Development Committee
3. The Collegiate Chapter services on the website were assed and any recommendations were made
4. The Officer Training Manual was reviewed and updated
5. A Collegiate Guide to GCC was created and sent out prior to the 57th GCC



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Recommendations for the next Committee:

1. Help facilitate the addition of newly chartered Collegiate Chapters to the website
2. Update any additional information that is warranted into the Collegiate Guide to the Grand Council Convention.
