STATEMENT

Kappa Psi Pharmaceutical Fraternity, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware and located and doing business at 179 Longwood Ave., Boston, Massachusetts, has adopted and is exercising legitimate control over the use of the collective service mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for ORGANIZING CHAPTERS AND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF MEMBERSHIP IN A NATIONAL PHARMACEUTICAL FRATERNITY AND FURTHERING THE MORAL AND EDUCATIONAL IDEALS THEREOF, in Class 100, Miscellaneous, and presents herewith five specimens showing the collective service mark as actually used in connection with such services by the members of such organization and is used to indicate membership in such organization, the col-

lective service mark being used on letterheads and identification tags, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office on the Principal Register in accordance with the act of July 5, 1946. Applicant is the owner of Registration No. 277,589 issued November 18, 1930 renewed.

The collective service mark was first used on May 30, 1879 and first used in connection with the services and the services rendered in commerce among the several States on November 18, 1898.
