DEC 15, 1900

POSSIBLY THE THIRD MEETING
OF GRAND CHAPTER

Baltimore Md., Dec. 15th, 1900.

The Grand Chapter of Kappa Psi met in Delta Chapter hall at the University of Maryland December fifteenth nineteen-hundred at two o'clock (P. M.). The officers were assigned to their respective places. The President stated that he would have to dispense with reading of last minutes of meeting held in Gamma hall New York on account of absence of Brother Eldridge who had them. President stated same facts about last meeting and called on Brother Hill to tell something of same.

Beta Chapter of Brown was evoked and charter taken away. It was decided that no Dental men could be initiated and no chapter could be started in a Dental school.

President stated the greetings of retiring members. The same President then made a very interesting and enthusiastic talk giving the history of Kappa Psi from beginning naming officers:

President Lamsdale of Delta Chapter then introduced Brother Hill of New York College of Pharmacy who gave us a very interesting talk of Gamma Chapter, it was very pleasant owing to the high respect of Gamma Chapter. He also gave us a few points on initiation. After Brother Hill made his address Brother Procter was introduced and related the history of Beta Chapter which was very creditable to ^{the} chapter, moral standing being the chief point of membership. Brother Lamsdale of Delta Chapter was then introduced and gave us the history of Delta Chapter. Following Brother Converse of Epsilon Chapter was then introduced and made a few remarks about Epsilon. He was in favor of the two chapters in Baltimore having a chapter house of the two chapters. Brother Smith then explained the standing of K. Psi. at Yale. Brother Horney was introduced and made a very appropriate talk. Brother Smith stated that Kappa Psi should be a Democratic body (applause). A discussion then followed at the brotherly meeting of office of Grand Chapter.

The present officers are to continue in office as long as it is desirable to them, amendment, "that they shall hold office until the majority of Alpha Chapter ask them to resign, discussion. Motion made to reconsider the motion of Grand officers holding office for life, carried. The motion made that "Present Grand officers hold office until they wished to resign or were requested to resign by majority of Grand Chapter" carried. Motion made to incorporate the society of N. Y. under the laws of Delaware as a protective, mutual, literary society. Motion that the Secretary write to the New York Herald explaining the report which came out sometime ago, seconded and carried.

Brother Hill, Alpha of Gamma Chapter extended a cordial invitation for next meeting of Grand Chapter to be held in New York.

Brother Procter extended an invitation for next Grand Chapter to be held in Richmond. Voted upon and carried to meet at Gamma hall in New York.

Motion made to adjourn until President
calls another meeting of Grand Chapter,
carried.
