TEACHING SKILLS TO TODDLERS: A PROGRAM FOR CARERS

The goal of this study is to test a program for parents.

What do families need to do?

1. Allow a research assistant to film you and your child doing a few simple activities in your home for 30 minutes, on 3 different days.
2. Fill out short questionnaires which will include information about you and your family, your opinions on parenting, and familiarity with some specific teaching methods.
3. Some families get materials right away, and some families get materials after 4 months.
4. All families continue any ongoing therapy/activities you are doing with your child.
5. Parents will receive \$100 upon completion of the study.

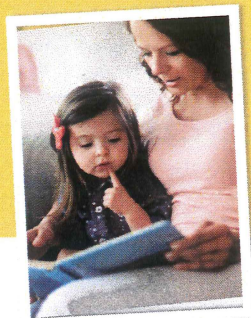
