 - Your address needs to be the one where you are registered to vote in NSW.
 - For the name of the party write "Keep Sydney Open Party"
3. Return it as soon as possible
 - Send a scan or photo to party@keepsydneyopen.com
 - Mail to PO BOX 280, Darlinghurst, 1300
4. The NSW electoral commission may mail you a letter asking you if you have joined, it's vital that you reply.

To be eligible to register, you need to be enrolled to vote in New South Wales and not already a member of another political party.

RETURN THIS FORM TO THE SECRETARY OF YOUR PARTY for lodgement with the New South Wales Electoral Commission.

IMPORTANT

Each declaration of membership must be completed by (or at the direction of) the party member concerned and then signed by the member. ***Particulars to be completed are to be written by hand at the same time the form is signed.*** Each declaration of membership is to be made on a separate sheet of paper.

The Electoral Commissioner may, in order to verify the requirements for registration of a party, request a person who signs a declaration of membership to confirm that the person is a member of the party and that the person completed and signed the form.

Under the provisions of *Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act 1912* and the *Local Government Act 1993* this declaration is available for public inspection.
