

## The remarkable story of the theme music.

"I feel I should know the music, but I can't quite place it," is a recurring comment by listeners to the Climate Matters podcasts and FreshFM radio episodes.

And that's not surprising, because the music, "For Seasons," is a brilliant yet heart-wrenching adaptation of Vivaldi's famous violin concerti "Four Seasons" modified so as to reflect climate change.

Using the original score, meteorological history, and artificial intelligence – and guided by composers and data experts - changes were orchestrated to the music to reflect changes in the climate since Vivaldi wrote the music some three hundred years ago.

With a "same only different" feel, starting in familiar territory but becoming increasingly deranged, the music is the brainchild of the Elbephilarmonie Orchestra in Hamburg, Germany.
