

# As a Public Service to the Community . . .

The Shelter Island Town Police Department in conjunction with The Shelter Island School District would like to remind those persons holding a Junior Driver's License of the following New York State Vehicle and Traffic Operation and Use Regulations:

If you hold a **Junior Driver's License** you may operate a vehicle when:

- **accompanied** by a licensed Parent, Guardian, Driver Education Teacher or Driving Instructor (over age 21) **between the hours of 5:00 am – 9:00 pm**
- **unaccompanied between the hours of 5:00 am – 9:00 pm ONLY** if you are traveling to or from work, a work study program, a course at a college, university or a registered evening high school, a drivers education course which is not part of the school day or if you are engaged in farm employment (*Appropriate paperwork for operation under these circumstances must be in the possession of the operator at all times.*)
- **unaccompanied between the hours of 9:00 pm – 5:00 am ONLY** if you are driving to and from work, a work study program, a course at a college, university or registered high school evening program or if you are engaged in farm employment (*Appropriate paperwork for operation under these circumstances must be in the possession of the operator at all times.*)

## IN ALL CASES:

Holders of a Junior Driver's License MAY NOT drive their vehicles unaccompanied for the purpose of attending regularly scheduled high school classes. If students wish to drive their vehicles to and from the high school for any purpose other than those listed above, the Junior License holder must be accompanied by a licensed parent, guardian, driver education teacher or driving school instructor.

As with all New York State Vehicle and Traffic Laws, the Shelter Island Police Department intends to vigorously enforce the operating restrictions, which apply to holders of Junior Driver's Licenses. These restrictions are in place to protect the individual operator and the community. Please respect these rules and regulations.
