Conservation License Information

New York State Conservation (Hunting) licenses are available for purchase at the Town Clerk's Office. Guide books are also available free of charge. Hunting licenses and permits are valid from September 1 through August 31 of each year, while fresh and salt water fishing licenses are valid a year from the date of issuance. Salt water fishing licenses (Marine Registration) are free to both residents and non residents.

To obtain a hunting license, applicant must submit proof of hunter education or previous hunting license for each type of license applicant is seeking to purchase. To qualify for a New York State resident license, a person must live in New York State for more than 30 days immediately preceding the date of application; proof is required. Land ownership in New York does not make you a resident. If applicant is under 18, the residence of parents or legal guardian shall be deemed such person's residence. Minors under the age of 12 may not obtain a hunting license or hunt wildlife.
