**Jimmy's 310F in the original 1961 Paint Scheme- June 2017**

Phase I is 95% complete after more than 2 years and 3,100 plus volunteer man hours of labor. We have NAV lights installed in all areas except for a tail cone light which we still need. We plan on using a battery and solar panels to operate a night time lighting system.

Phase II is to design and erect the 310 on a 15' high pedestal and locate it as permanent display in front of the terminal building. We are considering design and cost options for either a fixed or a dynamic display. Indiana would have the only airport having an aircraft flown by the name of the person for which it is also named.

Our goal is to complete this project and dedicate it next year. Engineered drawings, materials and your support is very much needed. The local chapter has done its part, What is left cannot be accomplished with volunteer support, but financial commitment of \$20,000-\$25,000 to perpetuate Jimmy's legacy in the community.
