FAQ: CAMPABILITY 2018

1. Where is the camp located?

St. John's Academy: 1533 Wildwood Dr., St. Augustine 32086; This is located 3 miles off I-95 and FL-207 (one exit south of the Outlet Malls). It's next to Treaty Park.

2. Will my insurance pay for the cost of camp?

No, insurance pays for services that occur during camp (e.g. therapies), but not for camp itself. However, we do offer scholarships to those eligible.

3. Does my child have to attend all 7 sessions? Do you only offer full-time?

No, your child is not required to attend all 7 sessions, nor have to attend full-time. We offer a weekly rate (\$250/special needs & \$185/sibling) and a daily rate (\$60/special needs & \$40/sibling), which allows for part-time attendance. However, when you register and submit your deposit/payment, you'll need to specify which days and weeks your child will be attending for staffing purposes and planning field trips.

4. What special needs will be represented in your camp? Does my child need to be potty trained?

- The camp is open to those with developmental, intellectual, and physical disabilities. These conditions include Down syndrome, Autism, Williams syndrome, Cerebral Palsy, Spina Bifida, limited mobility (uses a wheelchair or walker), etc. *Please note we are not specialized in behavioral health or mental health. Also, if your child has medically complex needs, we recommend you have your child attend a daycare/camp that specializes with the medical needs of your child and has nurses who can accommodate to what your child needs.
- Your child is not required to be potty trained. We understand children with special needs are at different points in reaching milestones. It will be your responsibility to provide daily pullups, wipes, and a change of clothing.

5. TIME: Can I drop my child off before 8:00AM? What if I pick up my child after 5:00PM?

Unfortunately, there is no early drop off. Our camp runs from 8:00AM - 3:00PM, with extended day 3:00PM - 5:00PM (there is an additional charge of \$10/day for extended day). There will be a charge for every additional minute past 5:00PM.

6. What services are you offering in addition to the camp?

7. Do I provide lunch and snacks for my camper?

Yes, due to the various dietary restrictions many of our children have, we have determined it best for parents to provide the lunch and snacks based on their camper's

restrictions and preferences. We will have water available to the campers all day, and some basic snacks on standby (goldfish, crackers, pretzels). If there is a special snack the teacher would like to give the campers because of the theme of the week, you will be asked about it prior to the camper receiving the snack.

8. Will there be field trips? And if so, is it included in the cost of the camp?

Yes, we will have a weekly outing, with the goal of it being related to the theme of the week. *There is no additional charge for the field trips. These are being covered by scholarships.

9. Will you be open on Wednesday, July 4th?

No, the camp will be closed the week of July 2nd, resuming July 9th.

10. What is the teacher to camper ratio?

There will be 2-3 staff per 10 campers. There will be a lead teacher and an assistant. We will also have additional volunteers. All staff have background checks done. All volunteers have statements of recommendation.
