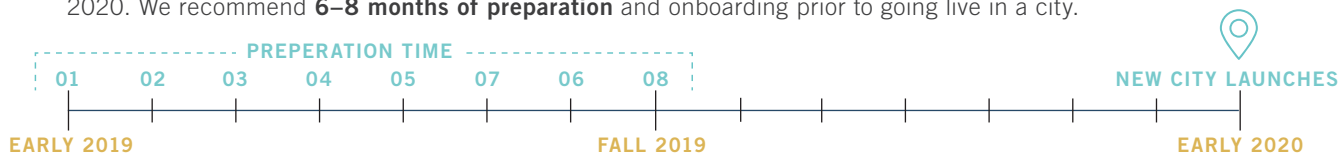
In Joining the Coalition, the Commitment is to:

TIMELINE

RoundTable is scheduled to launch in Memphis, TN in the fall of 2019 and Oklahoma City, OK in the spring of 2020. We plan to subsequently begin launching in new cities across the US starting in early 2020. We recommend **6–8 months of preparation** and onboarding prior to going live in a city.
