STANDARD RATE SCHEDULE **Outdoor Lighting Directional** **Rate 520**

EFFECTIVE IN:

All areas served retail by the Cooperative.

AVAILABILITY:

Available, upon application, to members other than municipalities and municipal trusts in all territory served by retail distribution lines of the Cooperative.

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable only to outdoor lighting by ballast operated vapor lamp fixtures and poles conforming to Cooperative specifications. Service shall be rendered only at locations which, solely in the opinion of the Cooperative, are readily accessible for installation and maintenance.

MONTHLY RATE:

A. **BASE CHARGE:** The monthly rate for each lighting unit installed on an existing pole and using existing secondary circuits is as follows:

Overhead wiring is considered a span of 150 feet or less.

Underground wiring will be available at the above rate plus \$1.70 per month where the amount of required buried cable does not exceed, on the average, 150 feet per pole. The Member will be required to trench, bore and back-fill ditch for underground facilities. An amount payable in advance and without right of refund shall be charged equal to the average installed cost per foot of buried cable times the footage in excess of 150 feet per pole.

If a hand-set pole is required due to the inaccessibility of the pole location, an additional charge of \$150.00 will be required. This additional charge will only cover labor items, not material. If any additional trenching is required, due to the hand-set pole, the Member will be responsible for trenching.

ADDITIONAL FACILITIES:

If additional facilities other than listed above are required, the Member shall pay an additional monthly charge equal to 1.5 percent of the installed cost of such additional facilities.

Where an underground system is installed, and paving or other obstructions, such as rock, etc., exist, the Member shall be required to perform all trenching, install duct furnished by the Cooperative, back-fill, and replace the paving to the satisfaction of all parties concerned or pay an amount equal to this additional cost of construction to the Cooperative in advance and without right of refund. In lieu of such payment in advance and subject to approval by the Cooperative, the Member may elect to pay to the Cooperative a monthly charge equal to 1.5 percent of the additional cost of construction.

SPECIAL OR NON-STANDARD FACILITIES:

Whenever the Member requests the Cooperative to install special or non-standard facilities hereunder and there is no engineering, construction, safety, legal or practical reason which would, in the Cooperative's judgment, make such installation inadvisable, the Cooperative will make such installations provided the Member pays to the Cooperative, in advance and without right of refund, an amount equal to the difference between the installed cost of the special or non-standard facilities and the installed cost of comparable standard facilities. The monthly rate shall be as stated above for the comparable standard facilities.

BILLING ADJUSTMENTS:

Reference sheets nos. 1, 2 and 3.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

In accordance with 200-5 of the Terms and Conditions of Service of the Cooperative

FRANCHISE PAYMENT:

The above stated rates do not include any amount for franchise payments levied upon the Cooperative by a municipality.

When a municipality, by a franchise or other ordinance approved by the qualified electors of the municipality, levies or imposes upon the Cooperative franchise payments or fees (based upon a percent of gross revenues) to be paid by the Cooperative to the municipality, such franchise payment will be added as a percentage of charges for electric service to the bills of all Members receiving service for the Cooperative within the corporate limits of the municipality exacting said payment.

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
