

Non-Aerosol Topical Sunscreen Use Student Form

In October 2018, the Pennsylvania School Code was amended to include a section on Sun Protection Measures for Students. Section 1414.10 states that a school entity shall allow the application of sunscreen during school hours, at a school-sponsored activity, or while under the supervision of school personnel. Parents/guardians may choose to supply their child with **non-aerosol topical sunscreen**, if it is approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

 A school may cancel or restrict the possession, application, or use of a non-aerosol topical sunscreen product by a student if any of the following occurs: The student fails to comply with school rules concerning the possession, application, or use of the non-aerosol topical sunscreen product. The student shows an unwillingness or inability to safeguard the non-aerosol topical sunscreen product from access by other students. If a school cancels or restricts the possession, application, or use of a non-aerosol topical sunscreen
product by a student, the school entity shall provide written notice of the cancelation or restriction to the student's parent or guardian.
