Day 1-Wed, Nov 15

Arrival in Havana, Cuba. Meet your local hosts at the airport and head to your accommodations.

Check-in at charming, luxurious boutique hotel. Enjoy a light lunch, and take time to get settled in.

Sunset Convertible Cruise. Cruise Havana at Sunset in classic American cars. Enjoy the Havana seawall, the backstreets of Central Havana and the lush Havana Forest.

Welcome Dinner under the stars La Guarida, one of Havana's oldest and most prestigious paladares (private eateries). This was the setting for the groundbreaking film Strawberries and Chocolate (1993), which dealt with the taboo issue of homosexuality and pushed for changing mindsets. Rum and cigar tasting hosted by Big Freedia. A local expert will explain the qualities and traits of fine Cuban rum and cigars, pairing them together for the perfect match.



Day 2–Thur, Nov 16

Morning

Dat Way Hip Hop Dance Group. Enjoy a street dance performance by Cuba's top urban dance team, who will host us in their neighborhood, Central Havana.

21st Century Cuba: Discussion with Cuban from different sectors about entrepreneurs opportunities and challenges to doing business in Cuba, cultural trends amongst the Cuban youth and U.S.-Cuba relations.

Lunch

Lunch at Estudio 50, an abandoned warehouse converted into an art gallery and multimedia workspace. Finish off lunch with a performance by Habana Compas Dance, a dance and percussion group that celebrates African sounds, rhythms and movements in a one-of-a-kind performance.

Afternoon Youth Music Exchange with Big Freedia. Visit the Guillermo Tomas School of Music in the Guanabacoa neighborhood, known for its strong AfroCuban roots. Enjoy youth performances, instrument donations to the youth and a jam with Big Freedia and music students.



Day 2 – Thursday, Nov 16 (cont.)

Evening

Big Freedia Happy Hour at Pazillo Bar. Jam out to a mix of Big Freedia's classics and what's hot in Havana on the airwaves. Big Freedia's dance team will be offering twerking lessons to get folks ready for tomorrow evening's twerking competition. We'll be joined by Cuban creatives.

Dinner

Dinner under the stars at Havana Paladar. Paladares are privately run restaurants that were first allowed in the 1990s and have grown in size, food offerings and sophistication but continue to be run out of homes or former homes and run by small families.

Late Night

Havana Nights. Check out Cuba's cultural scene, LGBTQ+ nightlife and live music, hopping from spot to spot with Cuban friends.

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Day 4 –Sat, Nov 18

Morning Havana Driving Tour. Explore historical and culturally relevant spots in the city and wander down side-streets to get a better sense of Havana's culture, history and day-to-day life.

Lunch on your own

Afternoon LGBTQ+ panel discussion & Happy Hour. Roundtable discussion with members of Cuba's LGBTQ+ community, followed by a happy hour.

Evening Havana Rooftop Dinner at El Cocinero, housed in a former factory and home to Havana's hip, you might think you are in Soho or Madrid.

Enjoy art, music and the company of Cuban millennials at Fabrica de Arte Cubano. The brainchild of Afro-Cuban musician X-Alfonso, this is one of Havana's finest cultural projects, an intellectual and artistic nexus that draws Cuban and international visitors. Explore the multi-media gallery spaces and catch a live performance.

Seaside Brunch Marea. Enjoy a tasty lunch alongside (or in) the turquoise water of the Caribbean.


