Profile of Doug Burke



Hear ye! Hear ye!

Imagine a soft spoken, good-natured young man; he doesn't mince words but is civil and to the point when questioned at the bridge table. He is modest and thinks his 500 plus points are "peanuts." (Not to a greenie like me.) First person he played duplicate with was Mike Kessler, a very good player, "with whom I got along quite well," he states. I've just described **Mr. Doug Burke!**

Doug was born in Falmouth, MA and was raised by his parents with a brother who now lives in the state of Washington. While growing up he did a lot of traveling in the states, as his father was in the military, but has lived in Fremont for several years. He had a great interest in planes and once he discovered he had no need to attend college to become a pilot – off he went to get his pilot's license. As I said earlier, he's a man of a few words, thinks things through (like a good duplicate player) and then acts upon his thoughts. After receiving his Pilot's License, he "piloted people around" for several years, eventually becoming an Air Traffic Controller, which is his current profession.

Thirteen years ago, Doug had a friend with a father-in-law who was getting back into bridge. His friend invited him to participate to learn how to play. Doug's other hobbies and talents include golf, tennis, bowling, board games, card games, computers and video games. As to marital status, he says, "still looking!"

His favorite partners are Marv Griebrok, Jim Kelsey, Kevin Schoenfeld and, of course, Bill Hodges. (NNITO) Doug adds, "Actually my favorite partners are 'everyone', in that you can learn something from everyone you play with." Well spoken, Doug.

October is American Contract Bridge League's Club Appreciation month, and as in the past, I'm still trying to figure out in which direction the appreciation is supposed to be shown: by ACBL to clubs and players, or vice versa. One piece of evidence that it's the former is that ACBL allows clubs such as ours to hold special club championship games, for both pairs and teams. And at the FLEEC we'll be holding two this month, a pairs game (at which red masterpoints will be awarded) and a team game (at which both red and gold points will be awarded). Our Club Appreciation pairs game will be on October 9th, and our teams game will occur on October 16th.

On the other three Tuesday evenings in October, our club may be closed. Announcements about that will be forthcoming.

Last month (September) we were able to hold three North American 49er Pairs games, and at some of them (see results below) our players achieved very good scores—perhaps high enough to qualify for extra masterpoints when ACBL compiles results and lets us know how we fared against all the other clubs in our district (District 21) that participated in the month-long event.
