Great Western Holiday STaC XIV, December 5–11

Throughout the western United States early in December, duplicate bridge clubs in our district (21) of ACBL’s Western Conference, along with many, many more clubs in districts 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, and 23, participated in the 14th annual Holiday Sectional Tournaments at Clubs (STaC). The Western Conference advertises this as the largest silver point tournament in the world.

Among South County members who played in STaC week, top honors went to **Nancy Boyd** of San Ramon. Some of us know Nancy only as a director, at many sectional, regional, and national events, but she managed to find time on the Thursday morning of STaC week to play at the Ashland Bridge Club. There she and partner Jean Barry put together a 69.44% game, which earned them third place among the 395 pairs playing in open competition in the Western Conference that morning, and 9.53 silver masterpoints.

In addition to points won at the nine STaC games held in our unit and one outside our unit, the following South County members earned extra silver points within the Western Conference:

Unfortunately no players in four of our open pairs games (Redwood Bridge Club's Monday game, Marina Bridge Club's Tuesday morning game, Fremont Duplicate Bridge Center's Saturday afternoon game, and the Sunday afternoon [actually, morning] session of our Unit 500 STaC game at Redwood) posted high enough percent scores to qualify for extra silver points.

Please note that (according to the Western Conference folks who run the STaC) these results are not yet final. Nor do we have lists yet of the highest scoring players over the entire Holiday STaC week.

North American Bridge Championship, Adam's Mark Hotel, Denver, November 17–27

Only a handful of South County players made it to the fall nationals this year. **Chuck Wong** came away with another 13.04 masterpoints, gained mostly from a first place finish in consolation bracket 4 of the Grand Junction Unit 364 knockouts. **Andrew McAdam** of Castro Valley won 9.76 MPs, part of which came from a fifth place finish in strat B of the Ellis Tamales open pairs. Two Fremont residents, Steve Chen and Xiaodong Zhang, had a fine tournament, adding, respectively, 47.27 and 41.51 MPs to their totals.

Palm Springs Regional, Westin Mission Hills Resort, Rancho Mirage, December 12–18

Joanne and **Robert Wegsten** made it down to Rancho Mirage, and they made it pay off for themselves, too. In the Tuesday afternoon Swiss teams game, they won their strat C and came in second in strat B, earning themselves 5.12 red points. In the Friday afternoon Swiss, again teaming with regular South County player Jim Helt, they tied for fifth in C. That came on the heels of their playing in the Friday morning pairs side game; in that they not only came in first in their strat C *and* strat B but also won the whole darn thing, besting the 77 other pairs playing with a 63.45% game and pocketing another 7.43 MPs.

District 21 North American Pairs Flight B Regional Finals, Bayshore Bridge Club, Burlingame, December 17

A pair of Fremont residents and Unit 500 members, **Bin Liang** and **Song Wang**, represented South County in the recent two-session finals for flight B (up to 2,000 masterpoints) for District 21, held at the Bayshore Bridge Club in Burlingame. In the afternoon session Bin and Song had a 55.49% game, good enough for third N–S and 1.08 red points. They did even better in the evening session, posting a 60.42% game; this catapulted them into third place overall among the 24 pairs competing and brought them an additional 9 gold points. Nicely done!

Profile of Barbara Neu

Barbara Neu was born in Richmond, but grew up on a dairy farm in Oakdale, California. She later returned to this area where she attended UC Berkeley, studying pre-med. In the summer of 1954 she took a job at Shell Development, thus ending her college days.

Barbara and Frank have taken about 25 cruises reaching almost every port in the world. She includes Mexico, Canada, Alaska, Tahiti, Hawaii, Caribbean, Spain, Portugal, Turkey, France, Switzerland, Australia, New Zealand, on her list. Recently she organized a cruise for about twelve of her friends which included England, Scandinavia, Poland, Germany, Estonia, and Russia. Her eyes light up with anticipation when she describes their plans for a trip to Rome and surrounding areas in the spring. They have also traveled extensively within the United States, including most of the 50 states.

Barbara has enjoyed the game of Bridge over the years. She had played casually when her children were young, but took up the game seriously when, in 1995, she enrolled in Terry's lessons. She was part of an enthusiastic group that went through all of the Audrey Grant series and together they formed a "practice group" which met every Friday. Close friendships developed from this group.

When the group had finished only one set of lessons, Barbara remembers attending the NABC tournament in San Francisco. She played with long-time friend and partner, Eva Bochmann, although they didn't even know how to play duplicate bridge or how to score the hands! She and Eva even received a smidgen of a point; their very first. Since many from the novice class attended, everyone had a great time with many laughs amid the excitement of their first tournament experience.

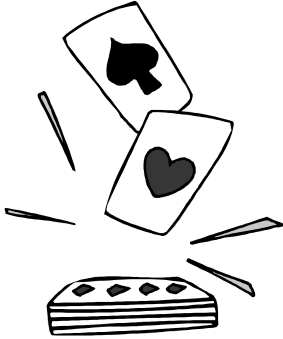
