Profile of Asha Apte

Little did she know that this would lead to a favorite hobby called Bridge in the distant adult world. Later during her collegiate studies Asha Apte learned to play bridge from her mother (“a good player” says Asha). Speaking of collegiate studies, how would she have time to play much bridge with her pre-med program?

After her birth in Karachi (now Pakistan) Asha was raised in India; she attended Fergusson College and B.J. Medical College, both in Pune, India, where she met her husband, Vishwas in 1959. She graduated as an M.D. in 1962.

Genetics (perhaps) have played an instrumental role in the lives of their two daughters. Picture this: Two bright youngsters, Dipali and Rupali, now grown and practicing medicine, Rupali an eye specialist (M.D.) and Dipali, also specializing in the eyes (M.D. and PhD).

But wait, there’s more potential: a six year old grandson named Neeraj, born in San Francisco, is a “car-expert”; he can identify most any American car, and some foreign ones; he often tests Grandma Ashe’s knowledge every Friday when she is taking care of him. Asha Apte has thus far led a most extraordinary life and since her retirement has had much enjoyment with bridge. Picture this: You are sitting in Round One vs. Asha in first position; she starts to pick out the pass card from the box; you say, “Asha, you may have permission to say ‘no bid’.” It, perhaps, will conjure up some good memories for her.

Las Vegas Regional, Riviera Hotel and Casino, June 19–25

In the Thursday evening 299er pairs, **Charles & Ann Conrad** of Castro Valley placed fourth in strat B.

Earthquake Sectional, Odd Fellows Hall, Hollister, June 24–25

Chuck Wong made the trip to Hollister and came in first in his section's N–S direction and sixth overall in the Saturday morning stratified open pairs.

Palo Alto Firecracker Sectional, Hyatt Regency Hotel, Santa Clara, June 30–July 4

Wow, what a show! The Palo Alto unit's annual sectional, displaced from the now-closed Rickey's on El Camino Real, has landed squarely on its feet at another Hyatt property, the Regency in Santa Clara (formerly the Westin) and its adjacent Santa Clara Convention Center. This five-day tournament may someday rival the weeklong sectionals in Las Vegas in number of tables (occupied) and number of players, but for the nonce it need take back seat to no event in terms of fireworks. On several nights of the tournament—Saturday night, most spectacularly—play was interrupted for more than a quarter of an hour by the fireworks display at Great America Parkway, just a few stones' throw from the Hyatt. Some people even tried to play through the bursts, but oh, what they missed!

Chuck Wong (again!) had a big tournament, placing 3rd among the total masterpoint winners with 25.50 silver. He was on the team that claimed fourth in bracket 1 of the Friday–Saturday compact knockouts; on another team he tied for third in bracket 1 of the Saturday–Sunday KOs; on yet another team he claimed second in the consolation section of bracket 2 of the Monday compact KOs (**Margaret Halland** & your faithful correspondent were on the team that placed third). Finally, Chuck was on **Terry Terzian**'s team (with **Jim Kelsey**) in the Fourth of July A/X Swiss; they were first in the X strat and second overall (**Zac Cohen**'s team tied for fourth in X).

Bin Liang also had a successful long Fourth of July weekend: his team won the consolation section of bracket 1 of the Friday–Saturday compact KOs, and the same team was first in C, fourth in B, and tied for fifth OA in the Saturday evening Swiss; a slightly different team tied for second in B in the Sunday afternoon Swiss. With the same partner Bin also claimed second in strat B in the Saturday afternoon open pairs; with another partner he was second in B and fourth in C in the Sunday morning open pairs.

Other notable performers at the Firecracker Sectional included: **Gary Peck & Zac Cohen**: fourth OA in the Friday evening open pairs. **Charles & Ann Conrad**: first OA in the Saturday afternoon 199er pairs; **Kundan Mirchandani** was fourth in B and sixth OA. **Robert & Joanne Wegsten, Ivor Weller, & Judy Allrich**: tie for third in bracket 2 of the Saturday–Sunday KOs and first in the Monday compact KOs' consolation bracket 3 (**Jim Harper & Marty Holtz** were second in the latter). **Steve & Sarah Chen**: second in B and fifth OA in the Monday open pairs. In the open pairs on the tournament's final day (the Fourth), Fremont DBC manager **Sue Johnston** was fourth OA in the morning and second OA in the afternoon; **Bill Beeson** was third in C and fifth in B in the morning and second in C in the afternoon; **Amy Wu & Jim Harper** were fourth in C in the morning.

Santa Cruz 299er Sectional, Good Shepard School, July 8–9

Amy Wu & Jim Harper (didn't we just hear from them?) placed sixth overall in the 199er/299er pairs on Saturday morning of this new event exclusively for intermediate/newcomer players. They had very good things to say about it, including the venue and the refreshments.

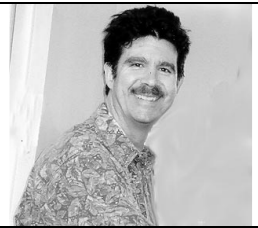
