### **Surf's Up Sectional, Harbor High School, Santa Cruz, September 23–24**

**Gary Peck** was on one of the teams that tied for second overall in the Sunday open Swiss, with a very impressive 97 victory points. He and his teammates each earned another 6.73 masterpoints. And the team that tied for fifth place in the B strat included **Norman Marks**, *père et fils*.

### **Sonora Fall Sectional, Tuolumne County Senior Center, October 15–16**

Director **Terry Terzian** went up to Gold Country and came away with what he was seeking (besides a good time): lots of silver. There were only three open events in this weekend sectional tournament, and guess what? Terry made a clean sweep of 'em! He came in first in both of the Saturday pairs events, the second with a blazing 68.91% game. (In the morning pairs, **Civia Rudman** placed third in the B strat.) Then, on Sunday, Terry's team crushed the opposition in the Swiss teams competition, racking up 112 victory points in seven rounds. Let's see, 7 rounds X 20 VP per round = 140 possible VP; 112 of 'em, well, that's the equivalent of an 80% game, isn't it? Wow! Terry came away from his sojourn richer by 17.17 silver points, and if I've got it right, he became a Gold Life Master. Excellent, Terry!

## **Profile of Monique and Stan Schonberger**

Care to read about "Un Pair Extra-Ordi-Nair"?

(Pardon my fractured French!) Read on! Monique was born in Paris, France, Stan in Council Bluffs, Iowa, moving to Omaha, Nebraska for grade and high schools, pre-med, med school and internship – a true Cornhusker. Interrupted by WWII, he served in the Army including the Normandy Landing and The Battle of the Bulge; he received a Bronze Star for his trouble!

After the war, Stan finished his surgical training at V.A. hospitals in San Francisco and Oakland and then stayed on at the Oakland V.A. as Assistant Chief of Surgery for twelve years.

During the busy years of WWII for Stan, Monique spent part of her childhood being hidden and "boarded" from the Nazi soldiers. After the war Monique attended college at a little known place in Paris called the Sorbonne, receiving her B.A., eventually working for a publishing house there. During this period she assisted the author-producer of the film, "Schindler's List."

In 1952 she was introduced to Stan by mutual friends in San Francisco, stating to me that she lived as a "not so gay bachelorette!" ("Gay" in the sense of "Our Hearts Were Young and Gay.") In January they will celebrate their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, having raised two sons and being the proud GPs of Alex and Ella Rose.

Stan was in private practice as a surgeon in Oakland and San Leandro for thirty years, retiring completely in 1996. He still attends medical meetings in order to keep up and meet with his colleagues.

After marrying and living in San Leandro, during Stan's busy practice (why do doctors always refer to practicing? – after all those years of "practicing", aren't they now doing the "real thing?") Monique volunteered for the Red Cross, held book reviews with friends (all spoken in French, of course) and raised her two sons.

Stan and Monique took bridge lessons from Terry, "enjoyed the mental stimulation and challenge of the game" and are "grateful for the many friends" they have made at the duplicate games. Stan's favorite partners are Monique and Jim Forsythe, Monique's are Stan and Fran McBride.

As for hobbies, they both are most fond of travel. Each year they have taken their children and grandchildren to spend time in France. Other countries to which they traveled: China, Cambodia, England, Kenya, Australia, Guatemala (and some I can't spell!) At age 65, Monique journeyed around the world all by herself, spending a lot of time in India and Africa. Both she and Stan enjoy Cal Performances at Zellerbach Hall, reading, their "nearly daily walks" – and enjoying each other's company.

Monique states that she is (not counting all of the extra ordinary adventures in her life) most proud of two things; that she is not a passive person AND watching Stan ride a camel in the Sahara Desert!

So we bid adieu to Unique Monique and Stan the Man and wish them well in future years. Stan says, "we recently celebrated my 90<sup>th</sup> birthday – and I hope for many more." - **jt** -
