

In the 2014-2015 grant cycle, the Elmina B. Sewall Foundation awarded \$10,618,777 to 144 organizations in Healthy People Healthy Places, Animal Welfare, and Legacy program areas. In total, the Foundation considered 274 proposals requesting \$27,510,208.
